Missing ACC Perpetual FT Trophies!

For the past few years, I have been assisting FT Trophy Chairperson, Heidi Henningson, in the search for the eight Field Trial Perpetual Trophies. We are pleased to say that we know the location of five of them which, unfortunately, leaves three MIA. They are:

- DC AFC Mount Joy's Mallard trophy awarded to the top Amateur dog. It is a heavy silver-plated bowl and was first awarded in 1962. It is 12" long, 8" wide and 5" tall. It has two lions head handles and four flower designed feet.
- CH Strom Cloud II CD trophy that is awarded to the top Amateur dog in the West Coast and Idaho and was first awarded in 1956. The tray is round and measures 18' in diameter. It's name is engraved in the center of the tray.
- FC Tiger of Clipper City trophy is awarded to the top Qualifying Chesapeake and was first awarded in 1961. It is a large aluminum platter with a dimpled-textured pattern in it.

These are pieces of ACC history that are too important to lose and we would love to locate them. We need your help! Please check your mantles, trophy cases and even under your beds. If you find one of them – great! Or, if you have won any of them in the past and took possession, please let us know who you passed it on to. Bulletin Submission Changes

Changes Bulletin Submission Guidelines

The Board of Directors approved the following changes at their June meeting and they are effective immediately.

Commercial Advertisements:

- The ACC *Bulletin* does not accept commercial advertising from any member or non-member source or commercial vendor.
 - This applies to book reviews and excerpts from works that have been published elsewhere.
- Current ACC members in good standing may place classified advertising according to the guidelines printed in the *Bulletin*.

Obituary Submissions:

- Members are entitled to submit one photo and write-up, not to exceed 250 words.
 - Obituaries are printed on a "space available" basis.

Member Submissions:

- Photo, Full name of dog, Sire X Dam, Breeder/Owner /Handler, Name of the Event / date / Location the title was finished, add a little tidbit about the accomplishment too.
- Members are entitled to submit one photo and short write-up, per dog, per issue. Multiple titles may be included under a single heading.
- Limited to 250 words.
- Claims of national rankings **MUST** include the name of the publication in which the ranking appeared and the date it was published to be included (e.g. Dog News, June 5, 2007).
- That all reports or brags claiming titles (Conformation; Obedience; Field; Hunt Test; Rally; Agility; et al) – where those titles are not AKC titles and the title replicates an AKC title (e.g. CH – Champion; CD – Companion Dog; MH – Master Hunter; et al) – **MUST** list the registries under which they were won.
 - Examples: CKC CH; UKC CH; Int. CH; ASCA CD; CKC MH; CKC FC, etc. (*Note: NAHRA, et al, have their own hunting/field titles that do not replicate those of AKC*) If the same title is won under multiple registries it should appear as: AKC/CKC/Int. CH; et al.
- That all reports or brags claiming BIS, MBIS, MBISS, Group wins, Multiple Group wins, et al – where those wins are not AKC wins – **MUST** list the registries under which they were won.
 - Examples: Multiple Canadian (or CKC) BIS Winner; Multiple UKC BIS Winner; Int. BIS Winner; etc. If that same dog has also won AKC BIS, Group Placements, etc., then the listing should appear as: multiple AKC/CKC BIS Winner; et al.
 - If you have a question as to how to report a title or win, please contact the appropriate Contributing Editor for guidance.
- Submission must be made by the owner or co-owner who must be a current ACC member in good standing.

Show News Submissions:

- Show results:
 - Name of Show, Date, Judge, Entry, BOB, BOW, BOS, Select Dog, Select Bitch, WD, WB (include owner & handler names please) & RWD/RWB if possible. Please include the City & State where the show was held.
- Group Placements:
 - Dog's name, owner & handler of dog, show, date and judge's name.
- **Photos:**
 - Due to limited space, only New Champions, BIS, Group placements or Supported Entry wins will be published. If the dog has had several wins that you would like reported in the same Bulletin, please send in only one photo with text (250 word limit) that includes all accomplishments.

Puppy/Stud/Older Dog Submissions:

- **Please use the following format for your submission:**
 - **(your 2-letter state abbreviation) YOUR DOG'S NAME**, health clearances, (Sire [sire's health clearances] x Dam [dam's health clearances]). Your pertinent information for this advertisement. Your Name, [optional kennel name], address, City, State, Zip+4. E-mail: *your-address@your-ISP.com* Phone: (Area Code) 555-1212. Web: *your-web-address.com*
 - Make Checks payable to: **"American Chesapeake Club"**.
 - Payment for Puppy, Stud Dog, Older Dog ads **MUST** be received with the ad submittal via regular mail. No phone or e-mail ads will be accepted! Please limit ads to necessary information as space is limited.
 - Ads **MUST** be typed and are **ONLY** accepted from ACC Members in good standing.

Photo Submissions:


Only show photos submitted by the dog's owner or co-owner of record shall be published unless written permission has been received from the owner or co-owner of record for the use of a photo submitted from a non-owner, prior to the submission deadline for the current issue.

- **For ALL Photo Submissions:**
 - If a photographer requires that you provide their name in order to publish their work, be certain to include a photo credit with your submission copy.
- **For "Hard Copy" Photo Submissions:**
 - Good quality photo, information concerning the dog (owner, handler & breeder and a short write up).
 - Please DO NOT submit digital photos that are printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer as all of the passes made by your print head will appear on the photo when scanned. Such scans are not useable.
 - If you are not using a photo mailer, please include a cardboard backing to help prevent bending by the U.S. Postal Service personnel.
 - If you haven't received a photo back after the *Bulletin* it appeared in comes out, please contact the CE that you sent it to.
 - You must include a **"self-addressed, stamped envelope"** in order for them to be returned.
- Labeling on the back of the photo is very helpful.
 - Please **DO NOT** send cash or a check for return postage.
- Stamps or metered postage that can be attached to the envelope that the photo was sent in are acceptable.
- For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions:
 - Good quality photos scanned in at 300 dpi are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*. Please do not send anything scanned at less than 300 dpi, or you will be asked to resubmit the photo at the correct dpi.
 - Please make certain that you clean all smudges, dust and hair from your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning your photos.
 - If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan.
 - Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.
 - Please **DO NOT** crop or edit your photos – that will be done for you.
 - Photo cropping will be done to best suit the composition of the original photo.
 - Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.

If it is Tuesday morning and you are visiting Gales Ferry, CT Elementary School, you will most certainly see a moving sight. Down the long hallway you will spot a man walking his large dog with a little child walking alongside. The child has a smile on her face as she lovingly pets the dog.

Peter Kallan of Gales Ferry is a certified animal therapist through the Pet Partners Program of the Delta Society. Using his therapy dog Mocha, a 7 year-Old Chesapeake Bay retriever, Peter works to brighten the lives of schoolchildren.

"I started working for the Pet Partners Program just over two years ago," states Peter: "Before that we took our dogs for almost five years for basic and advanced obedience classes. - Photos scanned at 300 dpi can create large file sizes. Typically, an 8" x 10" show photo, scanned at 300 dpi, will create a JPEG image file size of around 1 MB.
 - If your scanned file size is significantly smaller than 1 MB, then it probably is not scanned at 300 dpi and will not be usable.
- Some digital cameras create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. **This is OK.** Just send the unedited file as is. The

larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.

- If you have professional, studio quality photos done of your dog, those image files will generally be somewhere in the 12 MB range. Please send those photos on a disk or use one of the **FREE** Internet file transfer services such as **SendThisFile.com** so you do not overwhelm a Contributing Editor's email service.

- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

CODE OF ETHICS - AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the Code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a) Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Club Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b) Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c) Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d) Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of others or their dogs.
- e) Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f) Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse, or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a) Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b) Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c) Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence of genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d) Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) / in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e) Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life.)
- f) Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as available.
- g) Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA / CERF / PRA clearances be used for breeding.)


