

**HRCH Rippling Waters Mo Sprite MH MNH4** (CH Johnson's Cur San Tag MH X CH HRCH Rippling Waters Sea Sprite CD MH MNR), bred, owned, trained, and handled by Kathleen and Alan Luthy. In her very last hunt test before retiring "Mo" achieved her fourth Master National pass at the 2011 AKC Master National to earn AKC's MNH4 title. This pass also made Kathleen the first woman handling a Chesapeake to earn the Master National Retriever Club Women's Challenge Trophy (for women earning three MN passes with the same dog). Mo's four MN passes are the most outright by a Chessie bitch and she is tied with one male Chessie for most in the breed. Mo earned her MN passes in four consecutive years (and also an HRC International Grand pass along the way) after not running tests or even training for nearly four years following completion of her Master Hunter title. Alan started training her again for something to do while Kathleen was away at a hunt test one weekend. We can only wonder what Mo might have achieved if she had not been out of the game for so long in her prime.



## NEW MASTER HUNTERS

**Grand Oaks Aint Just Blowin Smoke MH.** "Smoke" was bred, owned, trained and handled by Tom and Dawn Lind. When we bred our Magnum MH to our Kodi MH, we were hoping to get Magnum's drive and focus with Kodi's steadiness and eagerness to please and that is just what we got with Smoke. She was easy to train and has proven to be a great upland and waterfowl hunting dog. She went 5 for 5 in the AKC Senior Hunt Tests and received her Senior Hunt Test Title on July 30, 2011. 4 days later, she completed her first and only Field Trial at the Chesapeake National Specialty where she took 1st place in the Derby. On July 14, 2012 she ran and passed her first Master test and 5 weeks later titled on August 18 after passing 5 for 5.



## HR Hope Springs Hush Hush WDC MH. "Usher's" title journey,

unlike the glowing brags often on these pages, was neither smooth nor perfect. Rather, it was a journey of faith, patience and perseverance. After 4 different homes in his first 4 years, Usher had uncanny marking ability and a nose that he trusted more than most humans, along with some attitude from previous poor handling. But he loved birds and Neil Selby, a pro from Remington, VA., who titled dozens of Labs, Golden Retrievers and an Irish Water Spaniel, took on the challenge. "I've trained Chesapeakes as gun dogs, but I'd never titled one, he said. He clicked with Usher immediately and had enough faith in the big ash dog that he signed on as a co-owner with breeder Julie Reardon when she doubted he'd ever overcome his accumulation of baggage. Usher showed flashes of brilliance – and a genius for heartbreaking failures in the last series. It was just as apt to happen at an easy test as a tough technical one.



While Selby gained Usher's trust quickly, reschooling the opinionated pupil took a bit longer. "He's a good dog, a lot of natural talent, but he just had a lot of bad breaks," said Selby. Usher almost never had to be handled on a mark, but getting him to trust the handler on blinds took longer. "It was a rough, rocky road for him," said Selby. "But everyone who saw him run loved him. And he's a big, pretty dog – fast and stylish." Selby now has one of Usher's sons in for training. Usher (Southern Md's Dances with Wolves MH\*\* X CH Puffin II JH CD WDX) is the second pup from his litter to title, and third MH from Reardon's Hope Springs Farm in Orlean, VA. "Now I have to learn to run him myself," she said.
