On Friday, September 21, 2012 I had the privilege to judge the Sweepstakes at the National Specialty Show in San Antonio, TX.

The original entry was nine dogs and twelve bitches along with two dogs and four bitches in the veteran classes. There were six absentees in the Puppy Sweepstakes and none in the Veterans.

It was a beautiful sunshiny morning and the ring was large. I was pleased with the Puppy Sweepstakes entry. Overall, I was very pleased with the coats. Most of the young dogs had good coats. Although there was quite a bit of variety in type, size did not seem to be an issue. The dogs were neither too large or coarse nor too small or slight. The males were more substantial than the bitches, as it should be. The most notable problem was the lack of good angles and movement that produce the reach and drive for which we are all looking. My Best in Sweepstakes was a beautiful sedge bitch from the Junior Bitch, 15 months and under 18 months. She had great layback of the shoulder, rear angulation and wonderfully sound movement. Her coat was superb and she was very feminine. My Best of Opposite to the Best in Sweepstakes was a solid brown male from the puppy dog 9-12 month class. He had type and soundness. He and his brother were very similar but there was just a little bit more to him.

Nothing was more fun than to see the veterans come in the ring. They were in great physical condition. The true test of good conformation is the Veterans class. All of the dogs were sound and still carried the great coats. My Best in Veteran Sweeps was a nine year old male. He moved freely and soundly, had a great coat and great Chesapeake type. My Best of Opposite to the Best in Veteran Sweepstakes was a brown bitch, ten years old. Her conditioning was superb. Overall, I was pleased with the entry and enjoyed the experience.



## American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

### JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

**CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB**

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

**I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS**

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

**II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG** (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).


