As I sit here thinking of this young dog's accomplishments all I can come up with is "Wow" and I get to go to line with her! Tom Ivey and I have, again, been blessed with a wonderful animal who loves the game as much as we do.

Comet comes from a litter of high achievers so, although she may be the first field titled dog of the litter, I don't think she'll be the last one. She and her litter sister, Julie Cole's Ruddy, are both qualified for the 2013 National Amateur.

She ties with DC AFC Tigers Cub for the youngest DC AFC, both finished at the Sagehens spring trial 43 years apart & both still 4 years old! She finished her AFC in September, her bench championship (thanks to Ellen Cottingham) in November, vacationed for 8 weeks, and then returned to finish her FC in February.

Comet is a physically tough, mentally sound, adrenaline junky with a huge, loving heart, and she says she'll keep me for a while since we still have lots to do! (And she needs a driver.)

There are many thank yous owed by Ms Comet. Thanks to Julie Cole for her name . . . yes, she named Yakity and now has named Comet . . . and for the great training and travels we've shared. To the Knapps for allowing me to use "Benny Boy." To Jerry and Jane Patopeas for their great training program and their belief in Comet. The Chesapeake Bench and Field Trophy was donated by Lorraine Berg, for Chesapeake Bay Retrievers earning a Bench Championship and a Field Champion, Amateur Field Champion or Master Hunter title.



The original trophy, a wood duck drake decoy carved and painted by Lorraine Berg, was lost in 1994. The replacement trophy (1999) is a wood plaque with a mallard duck carved into the front. This Trophy was lost in 2007, but was found again in 2012. The Board of Directors decided to officially retire this trophy in 2012 due to the fact that it had been lost for so many years, plus the addition of the new Dual Awards that were awarded retroactive to 2000.

The Chesapeake Trophy will be at the Field Trial and Bench National Specialty's for the next three years for those that would like to view it.

#### WHAT IS A DUAL CHAMPION (DC)

A dual champion in the retriever world refers to a dog who has received both a conformation championship (CH) and a field trial championship (FC)

Field Trial Champion (FC)	Conformation Champion (CH)
Win a National Championship Stake or Win 10 points, with at least 5 points and 1 first place in: Open, Limited, Special, or Restricted All-Age Stakes. <i>No more than 5 points may be obtained in trials not open to all breeds of retrievers</i>	Dogs must acquire a total of 15 points, including 2 majors won under different judges (a win of 3 points or more is considered a major); and at least one point under a third different judge.

## **Eye Certification Registries (OFA and CERF)**

The question that was discussed is OFA's new Eye Certification Registry and the sharing of information by OFA and CERF. This is done to get important statistics regarding disease prevalence and progression by breed to one site/registry, i.e., OFA. The eye exam requirements by both CERF and OFA are the same. Both eye evaluations are good for one year. In order for CERF results to appear on the OFA site dogs must have: (1) an existing OFA record, (2) a current CERF exam, and (3) identical registration names and numbers with each organization. OFA will accept only normal CERF results directly from CERF. Owner submissions will only be accepted on abnormal results that the owner wishes to be published on the OFA web site. We have included, in this Bulletin, answers to some of the commonly asked questions to help clarify concerns.

## **Bilateral Laryngeal Paralysis**

This inspiratory airway obstruction of the larynx is most common in the older dog and particularly in the Labrador Retriever breed. It may be more prevalent than just in Labradors. I personally think that this may be a retriever problem. In conversing with retriever people in my own world of agility performance dogs, I have had recent reports back of three Flat Coat Retrievers and two Chesapeake Bay Retrievers with this problem as older dogs. I'm seriously concerned about missed or incorrect diagnosis of this disease that may become an emergency situation if left untreated. For years the corrective surgery for this disease was a disaster most of the time. Conservative management did not work well. Thanks to Dr. Bryden Stanley and her group working on this disease at Michigan State Veterinary School, the surgery is now very successful and the aftercare management of the patient is very successful. I only suggest careful consideration of this as a diagnosis with any upper

airway obstructions in the older Chesapeake. I fear some cases have resulted in the euthanasia of the older dog by assuming it to be an "old dog" problem that cannot be successfully treated or corrected.

## **PKP1 Gene Mutation In the Chesapeake Bay Retriever**

There has been a recent diagnosis of a rare skin sloughing disease in Chesapeake Bay Retrievers. This is the only published report of this disease in animals other than humans. It is a gene mutation (PKP1) resulting in an autosomal recessive mode of inheritance in the Chesapeake Bay Retriever. Four different Chesapeake Bay Retriever litters of puppies produced nine affected puppies from eight closely related clinically normal parents. Signs of the skin sloughing are apparent at birth. A litter can produce affected pups, normal appearing carriers of the gene and non carrier normal puppies. There is now gene testing that can be done at the University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School. This test can identify the carriers. Dr. Margaret Casal in the section of Medical Genetics at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine could advise of the testing procedure and cost. The first report of this new disease was published by veterinarians on staff at the North Carolina State Veterinary School and the University of PA Veterinary School. The report of this disease was first received for publication in June of 2011 and published in February of 2012. At no time in the report were the owners of the dogs or the dogs themselves identified. The identification of those involved as carriers must be left to the principles themselves. If any other definitive information becomes available on this subject, it will be passed on to the members of our Club.

## **Podcasts Communication from the AKC Canine Health Foundation (CHF)**

Periodically the CHF has sent out "Podcasts" on health issues. The videos can be found under the CHF website. They seem to be of varying value to readers. You may be inter-

ested in seeing for yourself and make your own conclusions.

## **Parent Club Partnership Program**

The Purina Partnership Club (PPCP) is a program that offers rewards to parent clubs, like the ACC, by having the members in the name of the Club send in Purina weight circles that are on all bags of Purina dry food. Purina will return to the parent club, 10% of the cash value of the circular labels in rewards to the club. These rewards can be used to benefit health related projects for the good of our dogs. Here are the steps to sign up for this program.

- (1) Apply to [PurinaProClub.com](http://PurinaProClub.com) or call 1-877-ProClub or 1-877-776-2582.
- (2) Declare your participation in the Parent Club Partnership Program (PPCP) and identify the American Chesapeake Club to receive your Purina Points.
- (3) Save your Purina weight circles from eligible food such as Purina Pro Plan, ProPlan Selects, Purina Dog Chow, Purina Puppy Chow, Purina One, etc.
- (4) Submit your accumulated weight circles to PurinaProClub 2-3 times a year if you wish.

This is a great way to fund significant health research projects that benefit our breed at no direct cost. See web site for more details.

# Health Committee Report

## Frequently Asked Questions Regarding the New OFA Eye Certification Registry

### Is the OFA Eye Certification Registry (ECR) replacing CERF? Is CERF going away?

The OFA and CERF have always had a collaborative working relationship. However, we are two distinct organizations. The OFA cannot speak for CERF. The American College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists (ACVO) has designated the OFA's Eye Certification Registry as their endorsed registry as of November 1, 2012. ACVO diplomates (veterinary ophthalmologists) will be receiving OFA eye examination forms in mid-October, and the ACVO is encouraging their use and registration of results with the OFA going forward.

### How will this transition affect those breeds including CERF as one of their CHIC requirements?

The key element of the requirement is the exam itself, not the organization registering the result. There are no differences in the eye examination protocol whether the intent is to register with CERF or the OFA. The exam protocol and the resulting interpretation and classifications are the same. Prior to the transition date, all CHIC requirements that currently include CERF eye exams will automatically be updated. The new criteria will read, "Eye examination by an ACVO Ophthalmologist with the results registered with either the OFA or CERF". Going forward, both OFA and CERF registrations will meet the CHIC eye exam criteria.

### Will the OFA continue to display CERF results on their website?

All public domain data that CERF has previously shared with the OFA will be archived and will continue to be displayed on the OFA website.

### Are there any differences between the OFA's Eye Certification Registry and CERF?

For the average dog owner, there are no significant differences. The exam protocol, interpretation of results, and fees are all the same. Eye exam results registered with the OFA will continue to generate certification numbers, and these will be forwarded to the AKC and displayed on the OFA website.

### Since there are no significant differences in registering results with the OFA or CERF, what are the benefits of one over the other?

The primary benefits of the new ACVO and OFA joint Eye Certification Registry are on the backend. The OFA has committed to more frequent and enhanced reporting of aggregate statistics regarding disease prevalence and progression by breed. Enhanced reporting will be available for ACVO diplomates and for parent breed clubs. Regularly updated aggregate statistics will be made available to the public via the OFA's website. The OFA is also establishing a Clinical Database of Ophthalmic Diagnoses to capture data from ACVO diplomates on canine eye exams in an institutional or practice setting where the dog is presenting for reasons other than a certification exam. The inclusion of this data will greatly enhance disease monitoring. As a not-for-profit organization, the OFA will be sharing a negotiated percent-

age of all eye registrations with the ACVO [Vision for Animals Foundation](#) to support research leading to the treatment and elimination of ocular disease. Submission of eye exams to the OFA will support all of these efforts and will maximize the value of data in a single central database.

### Can I submit a CERF exam form to the OFA's Eye Certification Registry?

Since the exam data is the same, the OFA will accept submissions recorded on CERF exam forms. However, so the owner's intent is clear, the OFA will require a signed note from the owner or authorized agent indicating they would like the exam results entered into the OFA Eye Certification Registry, and accompanying payment must be made to the OFA. If a submission includes a check payable to CERF, the application will be returned.

### What will be the OFA's policy regarding posting of eye exam results on the OFA website?

The OFA will follow its existing policy for posting of exam results. All normal/passing results are considered public domain information and will post and display on the OFA's website. Dogs with observable, but passing conditions (currently known as Breeder Option Codes) will have their results posted and released into the public domain, including the specific notation. There is no option to keep a passing observable breeder option code condition confidential while releasing the passing certification number. Non-passing results will only be posted and released if the owner authorizes disclosure.


## 2012 AKC Agility / Obedience National Invitationals & AKC Eukanuba National Championship

### AKC National AGILITY Invitational (NAI)

#### Four Chesapeakes Compete in the 2012 AKC Agility National Invitational

On December 15-16 2012, four Chesapeake Bay Retrievers and their handlers met in Orlando FL to represent CBRs at the seventh annual AKC National Agility Invitational (NAI), held in conjunction with the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship and the AKC National Obedience Invitational (NOI). Three agility competition rings with sod were setup in the Orange County Convention Center. The Agility Invitational competition consists of four preliminary rounds with the highest cumulative scoring dogs competing in a final round for the Championship. Total all-breed competitors in the 20" and 24" jump height groups were 102 and 122, respectively. Congratulations to all four participants for representing Chesapeake Bay Retrievers so well.



In 2010, in Long Beach (finished 79th out of 94); 2011 was in Orlando (finished 12th out of 100, making it into the Final Round where we finished 6th out of 11); and this year, as a 10+ year old, we finished 15th out of 102 with 4 clean runs and earned the Highest in Breed Award! Inde also competed in the National Obedience Invitational (NOI). In 2011, the NAI and NOI were in adjacent rooms; however, in 2012 they were on opposite ends of the event; just walking between them at a good pace without stopping took 3-4 minutes! 

- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

### JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

**FC AFC CFC Nelgard's Baron CD Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake of an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. Walter S. Heller and was first awarded in 1963. **Winner: Fireweed's Glory Daze** owned by Lorraine & Larry Sarek.

**DC AFC Mount Joy's Mallard Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Amateur competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. E. C. Fleishman and was first awarded in 1962. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll** owned by Linda Harger & Tom Ivey.

**CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll** owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

**DC AFC Tigers' Cub CD Memorial Trophy:** Awarded annually to the amateur handler whose Chesapeake earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open and Amateur competition. (The Open points must be earned by an amateur handler.) The trophy was donated to the ACC by Eloise Cherry in 1979 in memory of her dog Tiger's Cub. **Winner: Linda Harger.**

**FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner: Delmarva's Alakazam** owned by Tom & Mary Cox.

**FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner: CH Frosty Hill's Seacoast Bullrush MH** owned by Andrew & Tanya Kenneally.

**The Louis Traung Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.) **Winner: Not awarded in 2012.**

**FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa Chief Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Derby competition in the Central and Eastern Time zones. The trophy was donated by Alex Spear in memory of his dog Chip. **Winner: CH Frosty Hills Seacoast Bullrush MH** owned by Andrew & Tanya Kenneally.

## New Tracking Dog Excellent (TDX)



## New AKC Coursing Ability title (CA)

My wild and wonderful girl, "Violet," earned her Coursing Ability (CA) title over the weekend of 15-16 September 2012. She earned the title going 3 for 3 and was the sixth Chesapeake to obtain the title.



She picked up her first two legs at the Greyhound Association of North Georgia (GANG) tests in Chattanooga, TN on 15 September, and then her third and titling leg the morning of 16 September. Violet then ran again on the 16th in the afternoon test and picked up her fourth leg which goes toward earning her Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) title which takes ten 'passing' runs. Coursing is the newest all-breed venue offered by the AKC. It is a pass/fail venue where the dogs chase the 'lure' (a white garbage bag!) around a 600+ yard course that has several turns (no turns sharper than 90 degrees). Dogs have to be 12 months old to compete and have to be 'checked for soundness' before they can run the course. Dogs have to run the course in less than 2 minutes (Violet averages under 30 seconds on her runs!) and must not stop or veer off the course. Whiskey Creek's Purple Mountain Majesty CA- "Violet" (CH Clipper's Frozen Asset's\*\* X U-RO3, U-SJCH, U-AGI, U-CD, U-BISS, U-Grand CH\*\*, Am CH Whiskey Creek's Greenbrier CAA, RAE, OA, AXJ, NF, SJ-N, TT, CGC) is bred, owned, and handled by Kathy Case (Pisgah Forest, NC).

The MACH requires 20 DoubleQs (qualifying in both Master Standard and Jumpers classes on the same day), and 750 points which represent the number of seconds under SCT for each qualifying run. Jill also finished both Bronze level AKC Lifetime Achievement Awards, the Master Bronze Agility (MXB) and Master Bronze Jumpers (MJB), requiring 25 qualifications each in their respective Master Standard and Jumpers courses.
