

BEST IN SHOW

BIS GCH CH Mud Creek Red Moose, CGC, THD, RN

We got Moose in late October 2007, after Larry returned home from his deployment in the Middle East with the U.S. Navy. While flying over the Chesapeake Bay on his flight to Virginia to redeploy into the United States, Larry thought it would be fun to surprise me with a Chessie puppy when he arrived home (we talked often about getting a Chesapeake as our next dog). Once his flight landed he started searching on the internet for Chessie puppies and came across a litter in Wisconsin. From the moment Larry saw the picture of the puppy with the red collar, he knew he was the dog for us. He called the breeder, Kathy White and confirmed that puppy was still available and arranged for us to drive up to Eau Claire, Wisconsin once he got back home to Illinois. We still joke about the fact that Larry's first phone call once he got home after being deployed for 9 months was to Kathy White, not me. Once he got home we drove up to Wisconsin to meet Kathy & Moose and knew it was meant to be.

With Kathy's gentle encouragement we decided to show Moose to get his CH title. We completed his CH in three short months and he received his first Sporting Group placement at just 8 months old. To date, Moose has received 79 Sporting Group placements. He was the number one ranked Chesapeake Bay Retriever in all-breed points in 2010 and 2012 and was ranked number

two in all-breed points in 2011. On November 25, 2012, Moose won the Sporting Group under Ms. Peggy Beisel-McIlwaine and went on to receive his first All-Breed Best in Show under Mr. Luc Boileau at Lake Shore Kennel Club in Chicago Heights, Illinois. He was shown by Holley Eldred. It was such a special day and one we will never forget.

Moose is the best dog either of us has ever had. He has volunteered as a Therapy dog at Lake Forest Hospital for the past few years and quickly became a favorite amongst the staff and patients. He is so patient and gentle with our 2 young sons, Charlie & Jack. He is already, without question, Charlie's best friend and protector. It is so sweet to watch the two of them play together. Our family would not be complete without Moose. We are so very blessed to have such a special dog.

We want to express our deepest gratitude to our breeder, Kathy White for producing such a



great dog and for being so incredibly kind and supportive. Our lives were forever changed when we got to bring Moose home with us that day in October 2007.

Health Committee Report

BITS OF KNOWLEDGE

The object of this health report is to give a few suggestions that may be helpful during the summertime or anytime for the good health of our dogs.

BLOAT

A recent research grant review concerned a project on bloat in dogs. As you would imagine it had many facets, one of which was education on the causes of bloat. We all assume people are informed but in fact this is not always the case. Bloat is a general term for distention of the stomach with gas that can be deadly. It has two common causes. The most frequent is a gastric torsion. In this case when the stomach is filled with food or water, it can swing as on a pendulum. The stomach can then easily rotate 360 degrees and cut off each end of the stomach. This cuts off circulation to the stomach and the release of gas. If this pressure is not released it can kill the dog in a few hours if not corrected. This type of bloat is very common in large, deep chested dogs such as all retrievers, Great Danes, Wolfhounds, etc. It is also seen in small dogs that have deep chests such as the Dachshund and Basset.

The best way to avoid this problem is to restrict heavy exercise just after the dog has eaten or drank a huge amount of water all at one time. If the stomach is empty, it is very unlikely to turn on itself. At least 4-5 hours of quiet time for a dog after a meal is a reasonable time to allow the stomach content to mostly move out of the stomach. Any training, jumping, running, frisbee or ball catching are all potential dangers for boat when the stomach is full.

The second problem that can cause bloat is spontaneous gas formation or slow emptying of the stomach with a meal that is easily fermentable. There is good reason to think this may have a genetic component to it that predisposes the dog to this type of bloat. Having multiple deaths with puppies from bloat with a usually reliable diet, would be a serious red flag.

LEPTOSPIROSIS

Leptospirosis (Lepto) is an increasingly emerging disease that should be on your vaccination list for your dog. In a recent presentation by the head veterinarian of small animal medicine at Tufts University, it was pointed out that seven different serotypes (strains) of Lepto now exist in the United States. The current vaccines cover the four most common types of Lepto strains and their genetic similarities probably give some protection from the less common types of Lepto strains.

It can be under diagnosed or misdiagnosed because it mimics organ failure that goes along with other diseases such as kidney failure and liver failure. Lepto can be shed by carrier animals with the disease such as dogs, rats, cats, cattle, pigs, deer, skunks, opossum, horses to mention a few. Infection can come directly from infected urine, and venereal excretion. It can come from bite wounds, or ingestion of infected tissue. Indirectly it can be spread by contaminated water, soil, food or bedding.

Considering the lifestyles of movement from place to place of our dogs, it certainly is worth advising the use of preventive vaccination.

SPORTS MEDICINE & REHABILITATION

This type of veterinary care has introduced an entirely new area to help heal and to prevent recurrent injuries in the performance athletic dog. The American College of Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation is the newest specialty board certified group of veterinarians recognized by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA). These veterinarians must pass extensive testing both in a written form and in a practical form of education. Their background must include expertise in orthopedics, anatomy, bio mechanics, exercise physiology, conditioning and retraining the athlete, rehabilitation, internal medicine, and complimentary therapy such as ultrasound, laser, magnets, swimming, acupuncture, etc.

The veterinarians working in this field of health medicine have been recognized with the title Diplomat of the American College of Veterinary Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation. They bring a new level of skill to healing our injured canine athletes. This is not a criticism of what we have done, but a notice of where the next level might take your dog and you for help in health issues.

Hopefully these are a few health comments that will be helpful during our active outdoor summer months with our dogs.

The MACH-2 requires a total of 40 DoubleQs (qualifying in both Master Standard and Jumpers classes on the same day), and 1500 points which represent the number of seconds under Standard Course Time for each qualifying run. Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince
- Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter – a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


