







GUIDELINES for Submitting Your Photos

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING YOUR PHOTOS

We are reprinting the photo submission guidelines as we are receiving photos that do not meet the proper resolution AND image size for reproduction in print. We believe this may be due to the increase popularity/use of mobile devices. Please review the following and, in particular, the requirements for both resolution and image size.

Information to Include With Your Photo

Full name of dog, call name of dog, Sire X Dam, Breeder / Owner / Handler, Name of the Event / Date / Location the title was finished, add a little tidbit about the accomplishment too (limited to 250 words).

Members are entitled to submit one photo and short write-up, per dog, per issue. Multiple titles may be included. Send your photo and information to the appropriate contributing editor (see page 2 of the *Bulletin*).

NB: Only show photos submitted by the dog's owner or co-owner of record shall be published unless written permission has been received from the owner or co-owner of record for the use of a photo submitted from a non-owner prior to the submission deadline for the current issue.

For ALL Photo Submissions

If a photographer requires that you provide their name in order to publish their work, be certain to include a photo credit with your submission copy.



For "Hard Copy" Photo Submissions

- Send a good quality photo, preferably 8" x 10" size. Include an appropriate sized, self-addressed, stamped envelope if you would like your photo returned. Please do not send cash or check for return postage.
- Labeling on the back of the photo is very helpful.
- Include a small caption/write up. If possible send the caption via e-mail as well. That way it's just a cut and paste rather needing to be retyped for transmission to the editor.
- Please DO NOT submit digital photos that are printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer as all of the passes made by your print head will appear on the photo when scanned. Such scans are not useable.
- If you are not using a photo mailer, please include a cardboard backing to help prevent bending of the photo.
- If you haven't received a photo back after the *Bulletin* it appeared in comes out, please contact the CE that you sent it to.

For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions by E-Mail

- Send the photos as an ATTACHMENT, not in the body of the e-mail.
- Good quality photo images of 300dpi AND minimal image size of 5" x 7", preferably 8" x 10", are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*.
- Proper resolution and size will create a JPEG image file size of around 1 MB. If your file size is significantly smaller than 900 KB or 1 MB, then it probably is not 300 dpi or the correct image size and will not be usable.
- Check the settings on your camera / mobile device before taking pictures. There should be a settings feature allowing you to adjust the resolution/pixels; choose the highest setting for best print production. For example: 2400 x 3000 pixels/inch (converts to 300dpi for an 8" x 10" photo).
- Some digital cameras/devices create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. **This is OK.** Just send the unedited file as is. The larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.
- Please **DO NOT** crop or edit your images – that will be done for you. Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.
- If you are scanning a hard copy of a photo, please check your scanner settings for proper resolution and image size, and make certain that you clean your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning.

If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan.

Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.

First CBR to Rank in USDAA all breed Championship Top Ten

"Jill" ADCH MACH Rippling Waters Jill SACH GCH SCH-B JCH RCH TM-B MXB MJB XF T2B (CH Rippling Waters Purple Haze MH X CH Rippling Waters BB MH) finished 2012 with a USDAA Championship Top Ten award, ranking Eighth in Championship Snooker in national all-breed competition, the first CBR to do so since the Top Ten program began in 1999. Championship Top Ten points are earned from placements in the Championship classes and are based on number of dogs defeated. Jill rounded out our 2012/2013 agility competition season by completing five class Championships and her Bronze Tournament Master title. Her last competition before summer



break was the USDAA Southeast Regional Championships in Perry GA, where she celebrated her fourth birthday by earning a spot into the Finals of both the Steeplechase and Grand Prix Tournaments. Although she was the only non-border collie that made it into Open Finals, Jill finished Seventh in Steeplechase and Third in Grand Prix, winning a Bye into both semi-finals at the upcoming Cynosport World Games this Fall. She also placed Third in the Biathlon Tournament, a cumulative score from the Master Challenge Standard and Jumpers classes. What a thrill it is to step to the line with this amazing dog. Health Committee Report

Dear ACC Members:

In a recent conversation with an old friend of mine, they reminded me of an anecdotal treatment for Degenerative Myelopathy (DM). It is worth passing on to dog owners.

Approximately thirty years ago the University of Florida School of Veterinary Medicine came out with an antioxidant "cocktail" mixture for slowing down the progression of degenerative myelopathy in those dogs showing signs of this disease. Over the years the treatment has been changed slightly. In a breed like German Shepherd Dogs where DM is quite common, the owners highly subscribe to this combination of drugs and believe it helps to slow down the progression of the disease especially if started early in the disease.

The researchers at the University clearly state that this "cocktail" of drugs is a maintenance treatment that they feel can stabilize a dog with this disease but not cure it. There are those that believe that it can improve the signs of the disease especially when treated early.

The University of Florida School of Veterinary Medicine lists on their web page that Westlab Pharmacy is a source for the treatment regime brought about by studies done by Dr. R. M. Clemmon, (D.V.M., PhD) who is a neurologist on the staff at the University of Florida School of Veterinary Medicine. If you are interested in finding out about the drugs, check the web site for Westlab Pharmacy. www.westlabpharmacy.com

Owners and veterinarians are invited to call the Pharmacy to discuss the disease/ treatment medications for DM with an experienced pharmacist by calling Westlab Pharmacy 1-800-493-7852.

The ACC Health Committee is also thrilled to pass on that the ACC Health Trust has agreed with recommendations from the Health Committee to financially support research studies on a possible vaccine for the prevention and treatment of lymphoma in dogs, research on Histoplasmosis infection in dogs, and a comprehensive study on bloat. We are one of many breed clubs supporting these research efforts, but we should be

proud to know that our funds are doing something to control diseases that can and do affect our dogs. Hopefully this is only a beginning of more action by our Club to help find cures through research money donations.



I thought she was very typey and showed beautiful movement. She was my best in sweeps and it was very gratifying to me when she went on to take winners bitch!

Breed Judge - Marjorie Martorella

First I want to tell you how much I enjoyed judging your supported entry at the Trenton show yesterday. I have been asked to write some thoughts about the assignment and I certainly hope these comments will be taken in a positive vein.

My overall opinion of the entry was that the most quality was in the Veteran Dog Class. This class had the most depth of quality in any class up to that point. If I were a Chesapeake breeder, that would make me a bit concerned. What needs to be done to recapture the quality

of the veterans? A couple of years ago, I went on record saying that your breed was in the best shape in the Sporting Group. I found myself rewarding Chessies in the Group throughout the country and giving numerous dogs Group Ones.

Yesterday I felt one area that needed improvement is head type. I realize your breed is not a "head breed", however, a good Chessie head is very pleasing to the eye. Some of the heads I saw were too narrow, lacking strength of muzzle. Considering what your breed is bred to do, this is not an asset. Additionally, I felt that the coat texture on some of the entries could be better than it was. Again, this is extremely important for your breeds function. Some of the dogs were also restricted on the move.

When I judge Chessies as well as other breeds, I look first for overall balance. No parts should stand out, such as a neck too long or too short, over angulated rears, a long and soft back. Symmetry of the parts is essential. I then look at the head and the coat texture. When you find a dog that pleases your eye, it should move properly. I want to see a Chessie with a powerful gait, covering ground effortlessly with good reach and drive.

On the day my Best of Breed winner fit the profile I was looking for. The icing on the cake was that at 12 years of age he still could do what he was bred to do!

Again, thank you for the opportunity to judge your dogs and also for the thoughtful gift.

Thank you so much to all of you that helped and thank you so much for your generosity. We could not have done it without You.



Chesapeake Fun Day, Cheney WA

On Saturday, May 11th, several Chesapeake enthusiasts and their canine companions met at host Clayton Evans' house in Cheney, WA for a day of fun and information. A great time was had by all!

The day began with a demonstration of strengthening exercises for the dogs, which involved balance work on rubber "doughnuts," "peanuts," discs, etc. Experienced dogs illustrated how core muscles can be improved, how dogs can stand on their back legs on the equipment and balance, and how different exercises work different groups of muscles. Then the inexperienced dogs got to try, and found that it wasn't easy! But the consensus of the group was that a muscle strengthening program would be an ideal way of keeping our dogs fit during the winter season!



Next, we moved on to conformation. Copies of the Official Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever were passed around, and a discussion ensued. Once again, an experienced dog led off the segment, illustrating gaiting, stacking, etc. A young, new to conformation dog followed, concentrating on her free stack.

Conformation was followed by a fun agility demonstration, presented by an agility instructor. Many attempted- and mastered- the tunnel, and kept coming back for more.

Field work was last on the list. Clayton demonstrated pattern blinds with his Master level dog, who did an impressive job. Then a puppy was used to show very beginning handling. Clayton discussed the natural progression from pup to Master Hunter, and touched on many training techniques.


Lynda Barber Wiltse and Larry Wiltse (Breeders). It seems to have taken a long time to get this title. Now he

American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

OBJECTIVE

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is given to an individual who has made significant contributions to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed / the people who own them through outstanding leadership / advancement of knowledge / understanding.

ELIGIBILITY

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes personal achievement / its positive impact on the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed. The award may be given to any individual independent of specific institutional affiliation with the American Chesapeake Club or other organizations.

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is not an annual award. The awards selection committee may decide not to make any awards selection in a given year or may decide to bestow multiple awards. The number / frequency of award selection is strictly at the discretion of the awards selection committee.

Nominations may be submitted by organizations or individuals, including the nominees themselves.

AWARDS CRITERIA

Nominees are judged by the originality, vision, breadth, / impact of the entire body of their work. Candidate selection must go beyond mere name recognition / reputation. A nominee's work is evaluated in such areas as:

- A strong / well-documented commitment to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed.
- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

It features the Chesapeake "greats" Dual CH Sodak's Gypsy Prince and his grand-daughter FC Shagwong Gypsy. All Proceeds are donated to ACC Health and Rescue.

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter – a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


