

Health Committee Report

There is an important health issue that needs to be pointed out—Canine Influenza. The initial signs are similar to Tracheobronchitis, commonly called Kennel Cough. The difference is critical, Kennel Cough is a troublesome infectious cough with little serious outcome. Canine Influenza can be deadly!

Canine Influenza will be called CIV (Canine Influenza Virus) can be mild but frequently “morphs” with lethargy, loss of appetite, low fever, nasal discharge and a dry or soft moist cough.

The nasal discharge, usually clear, quickly becomes thick and yellow as the disease worsens. Other critical signs are high fever (104deg – 106deg), increased respiratory rate, full blown pneumonia. The critical advance is probably due to secondary bacterial infection or mycoplasma infection. It is essential to start early with antibiotics to block this progression.

The most at risk are those in poor condition, those exposed to other diseases, the very young and very old.

Testing for diagnosis is being done at Iowa State University (The Veterinary School) free of charge to veterinarians who supply samples.

There is a vaccine available, given initially twice with a two week break in between doses. After this, it is once annually.


We also have a buccal swab to identify the “long hair” gene in Chesapeakes, it is on the market.

Cornell has a new test for hip dysplasia. They feel it is accurate at an earlier age than OFA and Penn Hip. The experts I have spoken with have reserved having a final opinion on its future as a diagnostic advance.

Service & Therapy Dog

First SAR-W Titled Chesapeakes

(L-R) “**Truffle**” Ch De Cocoa’s Chocolate Truffle Surprise, CGC, SAR-W (Ch Quail Ridge Ozark Mtn Daredvl & Ch De Cocoa’s Neverending Qwest) and “**Barry**” Ch De Cocoa’s Rumor Has It, CD, CGC, RN,R A, SAR-W (AM/Int RBIS Ch Calico Good Question & Ch De Cocoa’s Naughty Natalya) were awarded their Search & Rescue Wilderness (SAR-W) title in June 2013. Both K9’s are members of the Crook County Sheriff’s Search & Rescue K9 team. Handled by their breeder Karen Marcotte. Both K9’s have worked high profile cases as well as cold case. As recovery K9’s they are utilized as forensic cadaver K9’s who search for missing deceased persons as well as small trace evidence of the crime or weapons used in the crime. Cadaver K9’s have to recognize and find over 100 scent specific levels of decomposition. Barry has been requested out of the state of Oregon to WA, ID, MT & MN because of his expertise as a forensics K9. Truffle has always been my back-up K9 so that when working in dense & high elevation, I can swap out the K9s to give them a break. In 2007 we worked on a cold case (2 1/2 yr old) in Idaho’s Sawtooth mountains at elevations of 9014 ft. Barry’s alert less than 1/4 mile from the remains led the searchers to eventually find the decedent. The terrain just did not allow ground teams or K9’s to get to the remains. Highly skilled rope teams



repelled from the mountains crest into the area where the decedent was. Cadaver dogs are trained to disregard animal remains and only search for human remains. Barry’s last search & Truffles latest search located remains of a year old case which is still under investigation and positive I.D. of the decedent has been made. I recently lost Barry but as he crosses over the rainbow bridge I know he will be greeted by the lost, who he has found. - Karen Marcotte, DeCocoa Kennels “Bringing the lost home”

Wilderness SAR title (SAR-W): Effective June 1, 2013 the AKC began awarding titles to Wilderness Search & Rescue dogs that have participated in a minimum of five (5) actual wilderness SAR efforts and have been certified by an AKC recognized SAR organization. The owner must submit a completed application and attach a copy of the certificate which verifies the dog’s SAR certification and documentation that verifies the dog’s participation in five (5) wilderness SAR efforts along with a recording fee. The AKC will then place the title on the dog’s record and issue an AKC title certificate. The title will appear on AKC pedigrees. – Joanne Silver

2013 Swedish Annual Club Show, WD/X/Q Test & Masterclass

This year we were so lucky with the weather during the whole weekend. We had a lot of fun in a very relaxed atmosphere. WD and WDX was on Friday and judged by Jane Pappeler and Åke Engholm. They had an entry of 11 at the WD and 7 at the WDX. Saturday was the day for the show and it was judged by Kjell Svensson and had an entry of 48 dogs, from Norway, Germany, Austria, Netherlands, and Sweden. Sunday was the day for WDQ and the Master Class. Master Class is for the dogs that have passed the WDQ and is very exciting as it really tests the dog's skills on high score. This was also judged by Jane and Åke. All results listed down below. - Catharina Lindström

Comments from Judge - Kjell Svensson

I had been looking forward to Saturday, August 3, for a long time since I had the honor of judging the annual Chesapeake official show at Åstad farm in Halland. As a non-breed specialist, to get the opportunity to judge the club's special felt like a huge privilege. The Chesapeake is a challenging breed to judge and usually, you only see single dogs at exhibitions. To then be able to judge a little more than 40 is both a great challenge and a very valuable experience. Trying to learn as much as possible about them, in Sweden, numerically small breed is an exciting challenge that requires some work.

When I think of the Chesapeake, the first word that comes to mind is "strength." And I mean strength both mentally and physically. Mentally, all dogs were good with two exceptions. I do not expect that a Chesapeake should be ingratiating like a flat coated retriever, but I expect it to accept handling without problems. With physical strength I do not mean a rough and heavy dog, but a strong, flexible and reliable dog that does not yield with its back, front or hindquarters, and that has good chest volume and strong bones.



Show Scene

I thought the quality was consistently a bit varied, just as one would expect at this type of breed meeting. The males were better than the females, which is a bit unusual. On the plus side, I want to mention the size and proportions. In most cases they had good heads. What I perceived as negative was that several dogs had excessive fat, which is surprising in such cheerful and active breed. Some had chests that were too thin and quite a few with hardly angled front legs. The coat is of course a problem this time of year, but even if many of the dogs had shed their fur I made the assessment that the fur quality was good, at least with the dogs that still had enough fur left.

Among the puppies, I was particularly impressed with the female puppy from class 6-9 months, Pond Hollow Vibrant, which I think will have a bright future in the rings. It was a very interesting experience to go through the 11 champion males. I gave them all excellent, and 6 of them were also awarded CK. The four ranked from the champion class were also the four who were placed in best male class. It speaks volumes about the quality of the class compared to other classes. It was a difficult decision to choose between the winner Pond Hollow Double Coat Icebreaker and runner up Mischief Maker's Valley Forge. What finally made the winner was the better condition of the coat and a little more powerful step. Certificate of males went to the winner of the open class, Double Coat's Storm, who also made Swedish show champion. Congratulations on that!

Among females, it was a little more sparsely between the really good dogs. I was very impressed with my best female Redlion's Doublecoat Betty Boop, who won the intermediate class and has just the strength that I appreciate so much in the breed. Second best female was a very well built veteran. Third and four were number one and number two from the champion class, which were very different from each other but each one had several distinct advantages. In the competition for best of breed, a female pulled the longest straw with her strength and tightness in motion.

I had the pleasure of staying at the Saturday dinner followed by the auction and was able to see some of the dogs at the Working Dog test on Sunday morning before I headed back home. On the way home, I noted that it had been an equally enjoyable and educational weekend, just as I had hoped for. I would like to recommend anyone who has any interest in the Chesapeake to make a visit to the Chesapeake meetings in the future.


Hunt Test Headlines

Big Step Towards the Future of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever in Germany!

Dear fellow Chesapeake enthusiasts, a quick note from overseas.

Here in Germany, we have one club for all the Retriever breeds, the German Retriever Club (DRC). The common Retriever breeds have their own board of breeders and annual breeder meetings, not so – you guessed it – the Chesapeakes, who share one board and one meeting with the Curly Coated and the Toller.

Since in the last couple of years, most of the Chesapeake people we talked to, wanted an independent platform within the club, we finally put this wish in words this year, invited every Chesapeake breeder and owner to join the petition and sent the petition to the club.

The Chesapeake community is growing in Germany. In order to give our issues the time and place to be properly addressed, we strived to get our own breeder meeting and board. Plus, it would give our breed its own vote in the club's Board of Directors, instead of just one third of a vote.

The Toller and Curly people joined in with their own petition and so we stood pretty united at the DRC club meeting in June 2013. We were overwhelmed by the support from the huge majority of Chesapeake people and the rest of the Retriever community. Lots of supporters without a Chesapeake came to the meeting especially to support our breed!

In the end we got the majority, but unfortunately we would have needed a majority of two thirds of the votes in order to change the club charter, and for that we lacked one vote. Lucky for us, the Toller petition did get a two-third majority, so at least they get their own breeder meeting and board! This is a victory for the Chesapeakes, too, since we now remain in a breeder meeting and board with only the Curly Coated.

The first step is done but the journey isn't over yet. In our opinion our wonderful breed deserves its own voice and its own breeder meeting and board. We will keep working on it for our Chesapeakes!

Diane Hankin

May 22, 1941 - August 18, 2013



Diane was a longtime ACC member and once served as our club's Vice President. She began breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers in 1975 and became one of the most respected dog breeders in the United States. Her puppies have found homes in virtually every state and many foreign countries. Her dogs have done well in the show ring and are also much sought after by water fowl hunters. Diane led a rich full life and will be sorely missed by those who knew her.

I first met Diane at a match in Ithaca, back in the Dark Ages. We were both just starting out with Chesapeakes, at a time when the dogs were still mostly owner-handled and conformation folks had to scramble a bit to find shows with majors. Much has changed since then, but one thing never did. Diane remained constant in her devotion to our breed, and produced many fine dogs (my foundation bitch was linebred on some of her dogs). She was a good breeder and a good friend, and she will be greatly missed. – Sue Keroack

My first recollection of meeting Diane Hankin was when she bred to my first stud dog "JJ". She had some problems getting some of her girls bred and I told her not to worry. That litter produced her wonderful boy Ch Rockruns Kahlua Kobi CD WD. We kept in touch and talked dogs many hours on the phone over the years. I went to Canada usually twice a year and would cross at the Thousand Island Bridge so going up Rt 81 through NY was perfect for visiting Diane. Her home was 3 mailboxes off the thruway exit! I never missed a chance to stop for an hour and chat and see her dogs. In June this year I did my usual and stopped to see her with a surprise visit. She was so excited and kept thanking me for thinking of her. We had a great chat about "old timers" in the breed, where they were and what dogs they had now. I hugged her and told her I would stop again on my next trip...but it wasn't to be. I enjoyed knowing Diane, had respect for her, and am glad I could call her my Friend. – Jane Pappler

Many years ago a friend and I decided to enter shows near Binghamton, NY. My friend knew Diane Hankin well and she invited us to stay at her home. I found Diane's home (I arrived first) but I had no idea who she was or what she looked like. A woman came to the door and I asked if Diane was there. The moment I entered you would have sworn we knew each other for a lifetime. She was down to earth, talkative and had a wonderful laugh. We remained friends since then. Her health was not the best and I showed some Chesapeakes for her. I finished her Bahama Breeze and pointed some others. Last year I was showing in Binghamton and visited her. She wanted to see the dogs I was showing. A few days later I received a letter from Diane thanking me for coming to visit and for showing my dogs to her. She told me how nice the dogs were that I had with me and that I could be proud of what I was breeding and how I was doing it right. Diane will be missed and I was glad I got to meet her and enjoy her friendship through the years. – Marie Stump

Remembering Diane Hankin

Diane Hankin has been my friend for 30 years. We met in the 80's when I had a Chesapeake female which was indirectly from Rockrun. I later had a beautiful female from Diane, Ch. Rockrun Magic Moment, who was one of the foundation bitches of the current Cal-I-Co dogs. Diane's dogs appear in the background of many modern pedigrees. Dogs such as Ch. Rockruns Penny Popcorn, Ch. Rockruns Mighty Capt. Crunch, Ch. Rockruns Kahlua Kobi, and Ch. Rockruns Magic Marker. Although Diane's health kept her close to home in recent years, she and I spoke regularly. She was always eager to hear news of old friends and to discuss various dogs she'd heard about. Diane was a unique woman and a real individual. I will truly miss my good friend from Rockrun. – JoAnn Colvin

I met Diane in 1983, soon after I got my first Chesapeake. Her farm was only 20 minutes from my house and I always managed to find some excuse to visit her. "My puppy needs to learn to swim" - so we had some play dates at her pond. "I need someone to throw birds" - so we did some work in her back fields. "I want to show in conformation" - so she showed me the ropes. She was wickedly funny, smart, full of surprises, and always interesting. Health issues kept her from the show ring these past few years. A pity, since many who have come to the breed recently never got the opportunity to know her. I imagine her now surrounded by all the wonderful dogs she had in her kennels in the early days - Popcorn, Cappy, Tule, Magic - wearing her lucky show dress - happy and content. I miss you Diane! – Jan Estes

The first time I met Diane I had been looking for my first Chesapeake. I called her and she said "c'mon down". She had a litter due soon so I headed out. The litter was Rockrun Sierra Storm bred to Pond Hollow Remington. Diane talked to me for 2 hours about everything from who's who in Chesapeake's to what to look for in a dog. I told her I wanted a good hunting dog and did not plan on much else. Maybe breed a litter once. She said "No I see it in your face. You are going to become a breeder." That was over 20 years ago and she was right in her prediction. Over the years we would chat and I would visit quite a bit in the early days. Her health was never superb and it saddened me how unable she was to her enjoy her dogs for the last few years. But I will never forget her prediction and how she would be right about me continuing to breed. – Robyn Haskin

Many years ago...back in 1985 I bred to one of Diane Hankin's dogs - Ch. Rockruns Mighty Capt. Crunch. I had seen him at a dog show and liked him. He had an attractive head, good outline, harsh coat, and was a handsome sedge color. I bred Cadi (Ch. Eastern Waters' Cadence Am/Can CD to him. The litter was born September 12, 1985. We had 12 pups that have always been referred to as the "dirty dozen". One of these pups went to Lynda Barber-Wiltse. It was her first Chesapeake. "Shemya" went on to become a CH/UD in the US/Canada, Ch. Eastern Waters' Sanderling OP, UD, and earned many titles for Lynda. Another pup was purchased by Janet Billups - "Sailboat" officially Ch. Eastern Waters' Topsail JH, WDX. When I lived in NJ a group of us would make the trip to Canadian shows and several times I stopped off Rt. 81 to talk with Diane. Diane served as VP for awhile....she will be missed. We are losing way too many as the years go by much too fast. – Betsy Horn Humer

It features the Chesapeake "greats" Dual CH Sodak's Gypsy Prince and his grand-daughter FC Shagwong Gypsy. All Proceeds are donated to ACC Health and Rescue.

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesapecakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter – a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


