

Comments from the 2013 ACC NSS Best of Breed Owner

Four years ago I was on a mission to find a great duck dog and loyal companion with a can-do attitude. The result was a Chesapeake Bay Retriever. My Chesapeakes not only hunt with me, but they compete in AKC/UKC Hunt Tests, Obedience, Rally, and Conformation events. Having so much fun training, hunting and showing my other two Chesapeakes, Ruger and Beretta, I was hooked. When I found out Larry Heil was breeding GCH Spinnakers Nor Cal Star JH (Cali) to CH Safe Harbor Treasure Lake Geo MH WDQ (Tigger), I knew an addition to the family was in the works.

Aurora was special from the start: Doug Jensen, president of the Grand Island Kennel Club, evaluated the litter, and Aurora was pick puppy. I took Aurora home and started preparing her for the show ring. I was ecstatic, after two months of limited showing; my little girl was Champion Aurora (CH Rainwaters Valhallas Northern Lights JH). Hunt tests and dog shows would have to go to the back burner, as my military obligation conflicted. Sixteen months later, I drove Aurora all the way to Ohio to finish her Junior Hunter Title, with just a couple weeks to spare, before the 2013 American Chesapeake Club National Specialty Show in Pueblo, Colorado. At the 2013 National Specialty, my Chesapeakes competed in multiple venues, showcasing their true dual status reputation. Aurora went Best of Breed and earned her Working Dog Certificate. While Ruger earned his Working Dog Excellent Certificate, first place in Rally Novice and first place in Hunting Dog Class, Beretta earned her Working Dog Certificate and 4th place in Hunting Bitch Class. The National Specialty Show was a great opportunity to showcase their abilities.

Reflections from Ms. Dyane Baldwin

Judge for Dogs and Best of Breed

For a judge, the highest honor is to be invited to judge a National Specialty Show for one's breed. With this honor and privilege in mind, I focused on the qualities from the standard that are important to making our breed distinctive, create type and that are essential for its work. For me, proportions, substance and coat and balance of angles create the outline that defines the breed. Selections were based on this as much as was possible.

First I want to say thank-you to the exhibitors for the opportunity to evaluate their dogs. Your support with entries makes the show a valuable experience for all. Not everyone wins or gets a ribbon but the idea of a NSS is to show your fellow CBR lovers the dogs with their different backgrounds. Second, an air of good sportsmanship was very evident among the exhibitors and spectators. This is not always the case at Specialty shows not just in this breed but in many, so it was very nice to see. Third but not last or least, a big **Thank-You** to Renee Wolfe and her committee members for all their hard work in putting together and pulling off the show.

In general, bites and temperaments were very good. If anything some dogs were overly enthusiastic but none exhibited any undesirable behavior. Our

breed is not a "cookie cutter" breed with only one style that is preferred or fits the standard. Good coats of varying styles were consistently evident. Most dogs have sufficient length of muzzle so important for the retrieving work of the dogs. While there were still some big and lower set ears, there was an overall improvement in the ear set, size and shape. Most tails were carried in an acceptable manner-again a good sign. There were areas for improvement-proportion of height to length to body depth; length of loin; substance for size; shoulder and rear angulations. We have a wide size range for the various working conditions and with only a couple of exceptions, the entries were in the standard size ranges. The biggest area of concern to me was the leggy animals without enough substance or depth of body and long in proportion to height.

Best of Breed - Just a wonderful bitch in all aspects for me. She had correct proportion of height/length and depth. Her bone fit her. She has a good coat with undercoat and somewhat harsh outer coat with waving that was not excessive. She moved with ease, soundness and power. Congratulations to her breeder for producing such a lovely specimen. It was also great to see that she had her JH title (and later earned her WD) and that her sire is a Ch/MH/**! Not many other retriever breeds can find their NSS BOB bred as this.

Best of Opposite Sex - A fully mature male in tip top physical and coat condition, he moved easily and soundly. Different but acceptable head style. His bone fit him. Good depth of chest-below elbow and nicely sprung ribs. Tail carried well. Would make him a bit shorter in loin.

Select Dog - A handsome headed youngster who was beautifully presented. Eye catching on the move especially. Very good coat. Not as deep in body as the BOB or BOS but a well made dog. Liked his rear angles. Tail carriage was lovely to see.

Select Bitch - An old favorite. Gorgeous coat, with that elusive correct proportions of depth, length and height. Bone fit her. Proper angles. Strong top line even as a veteran. Age was showing a bit in her rear muscling but still moved with power and ground covering stride.

Award of Merits - All the dogs here showed the proportions & substance that the standard asks for; had pleasing heads of various styles; moved well and had good balanced angles.

Best of Winners / Winners Dog - His outline was outstanding-correct proportion ratios; substance; good angles that were balanced; correct underline; good tail carriage; short loin;

coat had a harsh outer jacket with plentiful undercoat-waving appropriate. Pleasing head piece with small and nicely set ears. For me perhaps a tad less stop. Wonderful dog and a real credit to his breeders.

Reserve Winners Dog -Lovely dog with good bone and balanced angles. Moved with power and carried his tail well. Head not as clean in the lip as the winner. A bit longer in loin than ideal.

First Puppy Dog 6 – 9 Months -Pleasing eye and nicely made head. Correct length of body and well coated. Moved with power from the rear and soundness all the way around. On standing he presents a straighter look in angle when stacked but better angles when relaxed & moving.

Second - A bit longer in proportion than #1 in class. Longer through the loin. Not as powerful when moving especially off the rear. Pleasing head and quality coat. Would like more bone to him.

Third - Good bone and coat. Needs to learn to show himself to his advantage as his inexperience on the lead gives him a roached top line and hard to really evaluate gait.

First Puppy Dog 9 – 12 Months -Overall a nice package. Good headpiece-would like smaller ears. Liked his second thigh. Front could have more development but when he moved, he moved well with good reach and drive off his rear. Held his top-line.

Second - Fabulous coat here. Again, I would like smaller ears and better set. Very nice dog. Nicely ribbed. Not as trained on his feet as the dog that won the class.

Third - Lovely front piece on this dog. Head has the best ears and set of the class. Moved with power on side. Great coat. Strong top line. Right now though moving too close in the rear which cost him a higher placement.



Fourth - Again a super coat on this pup. At this age he is a bit long in the loin. I would like a bit more in the front on this dog. Nice headpiece and good ears. When moved he covered ground.

First Bred By Exhibitor Dog - Ideal proportions for me of height/length and depth. Balanced front to rear in correct angulations. Excellent coat depth and texture. Masculine head without coarseness, not overdone and proper lip. Loved his size. Bone fit him. Good movement and in BOB his front and rear extension was clearly evident. BEST OF WINNERS/WINNERS DOG

Second -A slower to mature dog. Excellent movement coming and going and on the side. Correct proportion of leg length to body length but differently cast in style than the class winner. Good front and rear angles. Coat was the shorter type with good undercoat and correct texture. Proper ears in size and set.

Third -Head a bit too strong for me and lippy. Good bone. Proportions not as correct as the two dogs ahead of him. Good coat. Powerful picture when moving. Tail carried properly.

Fourth - Not in his best coat. Pleasing angles. A bit long through the loin. The high tail carriage spoiled his overall picture.

First Open Dog -Very typical in outline-correct proportions, desired angles and good bone. Proper coat. For me head a bit heavy and I would like smaller ears. Covered ground with power especially from the rear. Correct tail carriage. Took the 1st place on his better tail carriage. RESERVE WINNERS DOG

Second - Very much the kind of dog I like. Like #1 in class, he had correct proportions; was well coated and proper angles. Good length of loin. Very pleasing and nicely shaped head piece. He has the small ear that was set correctly. Moved soundly and with power. The high tail carriage cost him this first place.

Third - Beautiful coat texture and undercoat. Would like a bit more length of upper arm. Good rear angle. Used himself to his advantage when moving. Bone fit him. Good proportions. Again a high tail carriage spoiled the overall picture.

Fourth - A dog with very good coat, bone for his size and well angled. Moved a bit wide coming at you but he was not comfortable moving with his handler. Powerful gait on side. Good tail carriage.

Comments from Mr. Sam Houston McDonald

Judge for 4-6 Month Beginner Puppies, Bitches, Non-Regular Classes, and Junior Showmanship

Judging a National Specialty is always an honor and so for me, being asked to judge at the National a second time, is an even greater honor. I wish to express my sincere thanks to the club and its membership.

Arriving on Friday afternoon I was greeted by Ellie Domek, Co-Chairperson, who saw me safely to the hotel and made sure that I had everything I needed. That evening I was treated to a wonderful dinner at a local restaurant and spent time with Show Chairperson, Renee Wolfe, and her husband Fred, two of the other judges, my ring steward Carol Brown, as well as two committee members. It was a very nice evening with good conversation and great food.

Friday, Ellie transported me to the show site and I met Renee for lunch and then began judging around 12:30. The facility was most adequate with great flooring allowing for good footing for the dogs. Lighting was good and the exhibitors and attendees were in great spirits. Good sportsmanship was abundant, and I applaud everyone as you all are an example of what should take place at every dog show.

I began the day with the Junior Showmanship Competition. These two young ladies had a good handle on their exhibits and should be commended for a job well done. Novice Junior was Asia Renee Thompson and Haily Sorensen was in the Open Junior Class. Miss Sorensen was awarded Best Junior Handler.

Beginning with the 4 to 6 month old puppies was a delight and got everything off on the right footing. All five puppies had very good quality, showing correct shape, good coats for their age, all pleasing dispositions. Best 4-6 puppy was Chestnut Hills Epic Brew and Opposite was Canamonda's Copper Classic. These two stood out for me on the day with their correct shape, beautiful return of upper arm and lay back of shoulder and presence in the ring. It was a pleasure to judge this class.

As to the older classes, beginning with 6 to 9 bitches, I prefer to make general comments. Each of you knows what my decisions were based on the placements but I would like to



share my thoughts as I went through each class. I began by looking at the overall shape and make of each bitch. This gives me a first impression based on their form, asking myself, can they do the job they are intended to do. My hands confirm what I think I see as well as checking for correct coat, topline and other breed specific characteristics. Gaiting then reconfirms what I determined they have structurally, hoping it all carries over to function when the dogs are placed in a working situation. I do this for each exhibit in my ring and finally allow for that inward quality to shine; that which I call heart, that extra special addition that tends to get them that first place ribbon on the day.

I found that based on my entry, your breed is in "good shape". Most exhibits were of true quality with correct double coats, topline, and balance between front and rear angulation. There were some exhibits with their front assembly set on too far forward and I caution you to not let this compound itself. Front assembly is important on all sporting dogs and paramount in your breed.

Mud Creek's Mocha Macchiato was award Winners Bitch from the Amateur Owner Handler Class. I found this bitch on the day to be balanced, with a correct topline, good coat and capable of making those multiple retrieves on any given day. This was also true of my Reserve Winners Bitch, Treasure Lake Jon's Arctic Seal, with my decision coming down to the winners bitch being a little better angulated in the front assembly. I was pleased to stand back and admire my winners bitch class. As I looked across the ring I had that feeling that I had found consistency throughout the classes. One other class I would like to mention is the 9 to 12 Puppy

Class. Both my first and second place winners were lovely young bitches who I look forward to seeing in the future as they develop.

Hunting Dog Class and the Hunting Bitch Class all had exhibits in hard working condition. This should be the case with all exhibits but certainly a judge should find these qualities as he examines the dog in these classes.

Next were the Veterans classes which always tend to tug at my heart strings. There were dogs and bitches of great quality in these classes exhibiting correct breed traits throughout. I must single out one exhibit who received first place in the 8 to 10 Veteran Bitch Class. I was most taken with her and found her to be the best of the day: GCH Chestnut Hills Watermark. This bitch had it all. Head, coat, topline, balance, movement and most of all heart! I was honored to have had her to judge on that day.

Last and certainly not least were the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes. I always say that at the time these classes are being judged, all good breeders or potential breeders should be standing ring side. This is an educational time to see what stud dogs are throwing in the way of quality pups or to see how a certain stud blends with a quality bitch. I had both in my ring on this day and I thank you all for bringing them into my ring.

Once again I thank you for the opportunity to judge your National Specialty. I had a great time and enjoyed my last morning in Colorado with a fun group of people toasting the sunrise. My thanks to the entire committee and I look forward to continuing to judge this great breed.


Judge for Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes

Allow me to begin by saying what a terrific event the 2013 ACC NSS was - my only regret is that due to a previous commitment back in Ohio, I was not able to spend the entire weekend. The show committee did an exemplary job and the show site could not have been better. I have judged other national specialties and this was as well done as any of the others that I have been privileged to officiate.

The sweepstakes entry was large and of very good quality and most classes exhibited a sufficient depth so that in several cases the top placement could have gone to any one of a number of exhibits. This is a good omen for the breed. The Best in Sweepstakes is a beautiful and correct young dog in fantastic condition, and excellently presented. The same comment applies to the Best of Opposite. Of the many attributes of both dogs, I would like to mention the great proportions and the ease in which they carried themselves around the ring. It demonstrated both the strength and power of the dogs along with a beautiful movement.

As I mentioned above, the overall quality of the exhibits was quite good, but I would be remiss in my observations if I fail to add words of caution about movement and bites. There were several entries that although attractive when stationary failed to live up to the standard's description of "When the Chesapeake is moving away from you, there should be no sign of cowhockness from the rear. As speed increases, the feet tend to converge toward a center line of gravity" With respect to bites, there were several that were pushing the limit of a level bite ("Bite--Scissors is preferred, but a level bite is acceptable"). Keep an eye on the teeth!

In closing I would like to thank the ACC members, exhibitors and breeders for the privilege of judging your dogs. It is your involvement that has made the breed what it is today.



Chesapeake Bay Retriever Named to Retriever Hall of Fame

"**Jessie**" DUAL CH & AFC JJ's Jessie CD (FC AFC CFC CAF C Chesdale Chippewa Chief (HOF) X Dual CH Fireweeds Jasmine). DOB 09/20/1982. Breeder: Carol Andersen. Owners Linda and Jennifer Jaynes-Patterson

When viewing Jessie's 2013 Retriever Hall of Fame enshrinement please consider the following. Jessie's numbers and accomplishments within the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed are easily Hall of Fame worthy. Mere points just don't tell the entire story of this great Chesapeake . . .

Jessie was the FIRST female Chesapeake Bay Retriever in the history of the bred to hold the AKC titles of Dual Champion (Dual CH) - Field Champion (FC) plus Conformation Champion (CH) along with the titles of Amateur Field Champion (AFC), plus the obedience title (CD) – and she was also a certified therapy dog. Jessie was the daughter of a second breeding with fellow Retriever Hall-of-Famer FC AFC CFC CAF C Chesdale Chippewa Chief X Dual CH Fireweeds Jasmine.

Linda chose Jessie at three weeks old as a pet for our daughter Jenni (hence the name JJ's) but Jessie spent her life as Linda's constant partner and best friend. Jessie's formal training began as a two year old with Mike Lardy, Handjem Retrievers.

Jessie earned 64 All-Age Field Trial points along with 20+ conformation championship points and qualified for the seven National Open and/or Amateur Championships, 1987 thru 1992 including 1990, 1991, and 1992 when Jessie competed with her daughter DUAL CH & AFC JJ's Chi-Town Blizzard CD MH, making history as the only mother daughter Dual Champion Chesapeakes ever to compete together at the National Retriever Championship level. Jessie was the Top Chesapeake Field Trial Bitch in the country six times – until her daughter Lizzy took over!

Jessie produced Dual CH & AFC JJ's Chi-Town Blizzard CD MH, CFC CAF C When Harry Met Jessie plus - many qualified All-Age dogs, dogs with All-Age wins and Master Hunter titles.



Health Committee Report

Spotlight on Leptospirosis

The Beginning

A recent letter from Lynda Barber-Wiltse reported a Leptospirosis infection in her dog which is significant to many of our Chesapeake owners. It pointed out the need to associate liver disease with Leptospirosis. It shows the acute titers do not show the disease, a second titer is needed. Early treatment with the appropriate antibiotic based on insight to the problem may save your dog's life. The incubation period is about 2 weeks. You must be aware of where you have been and the dangers that you have been exposed to.

All of these facts prompted me to write the extensive report that follows. Please note websites that will allow you to follow the location of the disease state by state as reports accumulate.

Medical Update for all Field Trial, Bench, and Traveling Exhibitors

The status of Leptospirosis as a threat to the health and lives of our dogs appears to have changed. Leptospirosis was not considered a broad threat to our dogs' lives and in diagnostics it was related more to the kidney than liver. This has all changed.

My information on this problem was late but I felt urgent. My sources are high quality but limited in number. Dr. Mark Kimsey is the Associate Director for pet vaccines at Boehringer Ingelheim Vetmedica to be referred to as BRI and Dr. Alex Hamburg is a pathologist for the University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School and soon to be a pathologist for the State of Pennsylvania.

Diagnostics make this fact important. Leptospirosis has a history of attacking the kidney. Dr. Hamburg stated the only animal frequently having liver disease from Leptospirosis is the dog. A lack of recognition of this fact is critical because early diagnosis and treatment is critical to saving your animal.

Leptospirosis was once credited to cattle (farm ponds) and rats (inner city) but no longer! The wild population deer, raccoons, skunks, opossums, and squirrels have been driven in contact with where our dogs compete, perform and live. Lepto is the #1 infectious cause of kidney failure in dogs. It is also a frequent cause of liver damage.

Everyone should understand how you contract Leptospirosis. According to BRI dogs are infected when they have contact from fresh urine from infected animals. Infection can come when wading or drinking from contaminated sources. Bacteria can enter through a cut in the skin or mucous membranes such as the eye, nose or the mouth. Consider the risk of a retrieve in the wrong water.

High level contaminations with Leptospirosis are predominately in warm, wet climates with standing water. Fresh water areas are also at risk and soil can also be contaminated by fresh urine.

BRI has established a number of websites for information, they include www.Leptoninfo.com and www.DuramuneLepto.com. This lists a map of the USA showing Lepto Reports of disease. All of the states have not reported. A "O" presence probably is a "O" report not a "O" presence but please note these current (January 1) reports. Pennsylvania 70 cases from 36 veterinarians, South Carolina 22 cases from 34 veterinarians. Please note these are sites of our 2013 Field Trials Specialty (FTSP) and our 2014 Show Specialty. Other reports (C=cases, V=vets reporting). Nebraska 60 C / 16 V, New Hampshire 59 C / 9 V, Alabama 6 C / 3 V, Virginia 29 C / 12 V, Tennessee 13 C / 14 V. These are very under-reported.

The only protections are your vaccines. Boehringer Ingelheim has a new vaccine of reduced volume (only 1/2ml) to reduce local reaction.

Duo Becomes South Carolina

HOPE Animal Assisted Crisis Response Team

Michele Pyle of Wagener, SC and her Chesapeake Retriever “Cocky” have become the newest South Carolina Animal Assisted Crisis Response Team in the state.

For the past three years Michele and her two Chesapeakes, Cocky and Seamus, have provided therapy visits to the Dorn VA Hospital, “stress” relief during finals to USC students and participated in Bite Prevention clinics for grade school children.

After an intense screening and workshop which included traveling on public transportation, navigating airport security, locating adequate seating on an airline to accommodate both handler and dog, and attending clinics in the benefits, both physical and psychological, of animal assisted response the team is ready to respond when called. Shelly is certified in human and animal CPR and first aid, and will complete continuing education courses with FEMA to become familiar with the Federal Emergency Management systems.

HOPE AACR is an all-volunteer, non-profit, crisis response organization with specially trained handlers (psychological, first aid, incident command, etc.). They first responded in 2001 to the 9-11 crisis at ground zero and over the past 10+ years have continued to respond to disasters such as, forest fires, train derailments, downed planes, school shootings, hurricanes, tornadoes and most recently the Naval Station shooting. The teams work in concert with FEMA, the Red Cross, Salvation Army and other relief organizations to bring comfort to those in need. Shelly's husband, Chuck, will join her in 2014 as a team leader with the organization.

While Canine Good Citizen tests are simulations of real world skills, (e.g., dog/handler walks through a “crowd” of evaluators in a ring), the goal of AKC Community Canine is to test the dog's skills in a natural setting. There are also combo vaccines that have 4 strains of Lepto with a mix of distemper, adenovirus, Parva, Corona, if you want a mix.

I repeat this is not a Boehringer ad. I sought their information because of previous contact and knowing they are a great company. I'm sure there are other fine choices, but I felt significant prompt information was essential in this report.



2013 AKC MASTER NATIONAL

September 21-29, 2013, Flint Oak Lodge, in Fall River, Kansas was the site of the 2013 Master National Hunting Test. Flint Oak Lodge is a premier shooting resort with over 5,500 acres of vast native prairie property. Of the 669 dogs entered, seven males and seven females represented our breed as the event began. Over the course of eight days, each of the four flights ran five of the eight tests that had been setup by all of the judges, prior to the start of the event. Each of these tests had a minimum of a triple, with a blind. Several tests had a triple, walk up, double blind, poison bird and honor. Every test offered its own unique challenges for dogs and handlers. At the end of the week, 303 dogs had qualified, 45% of the starters, with four Chesapeakes having accomplished this task. Health Committee

During 2013 we had an active and hopefully productive year. We gave specific health reports in the ACC Bulletin regarding the following: Canine Influenza, the PKP gene and Bilateral Laryngeal Paralysis with the inclusion of references to more contact sources of detailed information.

We submitted recommendations to the ACC Health Trust for funding a new Lymphoma vaccine study, a Bloat study, and a Histoplasmosis study. We also supported a Theriogenology study. All of the above received some financial support.

We directly addressed requests for information on specific problems that the ACC members had when it was within the scope and knowledge of our Committee. Hopefully this will provide a basis for more and better work in 2014. Many thanks to my Committee members and Diane Mazy for her insight and support during the year. - Jim Stewart V.M.D., Chair

December 2013 Report of AKC Delegate Meeting

The hot topics of the December 2013 AKC Delegate meeting were:

- 1) Recently enacted USDA/APHIS breeder regulations,
- 2) AKC Disaster Trailer,
- 3) Amendment to give clubs more options in delegate selection,
- 4) Proposed change of Field Trial Rules to Regulations, and
- 5) AKC's public exposure.

The APHIS regulations regarding which breeders needs license is in effect as of November 18, 2013. AKC is currently working with the USDA to clarify the meaning of

several terms which are contradictory within the law. The USDA uses language such as "business model", "breeding female", "purpose of sale", "buyer vs. ultimate owner" etc. While the law has been passed its implementation is still in question. At present the USDA has told the AKC that it will take a "significant amount of time" to enact the law. Enactment will be initiated by a complaint, followed by a letter and a response (by the breeder) as to the need for a license and steps toward compliance. No immediate fines or punishment. This law has created many unforeseen problems including foster/rescue care and placement. For specific questions: Dr. Gerald Rushin @ USDA 301-851-3751.

There is another breeder regulation in the Federal pipeline (H.847/S.395) "PUPS" that would apply to owners and co-owners that produce 50 or more dogs in 12 months. This has not advanced to committee.

The first of the AKC disaster trailers has been delivered along the North Carolina coast. Six more trailers have been ordered. The AKC currently has \$250,000 to spend over the next 2 years on this project. Clubs and individuals are

encouraged to donate to this fund and/or directly work with local emergency teams to buy and maintain a trailer. AKC as well as club logo can be placed on the trailer.

Doug Ljungren, VP Companion and Performance, presented to the Field Trial and Hunt Test Event Committee a proposal to change Field Trial rules to Regulations. The rationale for this change would be to streamline rule changes by removing Delegate approval. This topic was also on the agenda of the By-Laws Committee. While there initially seemed to be support for this change



objections raised by the ACC and supported by the Golden Retriever Club has placed this issue on the March agenda for further discussion.

The Performance division is also proposing a new Qualified All-Age title, QA2. This suffix title could be applied for when a dog has any combination of 2 all-age JAM or placements or Qualifying 1st or 2nd. This new title has not been approved.

In 2013, AKC reports a decline in registrations and entries in all event categories, except Agility. This resulting loss of revenue has been offset via a combination of increased registration fee, decrease staff cost, improved investment performance and the advent of Companion events. The AKC hopes the popularity of these events will increase public interest in the AKC resulting in more entries and registrations.

Keep Pets *in Mind* When

PREPARING for an *Emergency*

The best way to protect your family from the effects of a disaster is to have a disaster plan. If you are a pet owner, that plan should include your pets.

Before a disaster ask friends, relatives, or others outside your area if they could shelter you and your dogs in an event of an emergency. If you have more than one pet, they may be more comfortable together; but be prepared to house you and your dogs separately.

Have a list handy of names family, friends, hotels & Motels (that take dogs), boarding facilities, veterinarians who could shelter animals in an emergency. Include 24 hour and mobile phone numbers.

Prepare a list of pet and human supplies in your preparedness kit.

Create a Disaster Kit for your Dog/pets

In the event of an emergency you may have to leave your home quickly. Your dog relies on you to take care of them. Assemble a kit now.

- Medications and medical records in a water proof container
- Sturdy leashes and crates
- A three day supply of food, water and bowls
- A photo of your dogs with their chip numbers in case you get separated
- Information of their feeding, medical requirements and behavioral issues
- Dog beds and toys

Make sure all dogs are wearing collars that are securely fastened (no choke collars) and have their ID tags containing up to date information. Also attach to the collar the second name of a friend or relative in case they cannot reach you.

During a disaster

Bring your dogs inside immediately. Animals have instincts about severe weather changes and will either alert you or isolate themselves if they are afraid. Bringing them inside will keep them from running away or stressing. NEVER leave a dog outside or tied up during a severe storm.

If you are not home when severe weather suddenly appears, have available an alternate plan or contact a neighbor, relative or friend to bring your dog in and put it in a safe place such as a crate.

Place a notice outside the home advising there are dogs/pets in the house and where they are located. Provide a phone number where you can be reached as well as the second contact person if they cannot reach you.

After a Disaster

In the first few days or weeks after a disaster, keep your dogs on leash when they go outside. Familiar scent and landmarks and your fencing could have been altered your dogs can become confused and flee.

If a potentially catastrophic storm is approaching or there is a hazmat emergency, pet owners will be asked to leave their homes with little or no notice. Split-second decisions are made on what is most important to take with them: maybe their photos, but definitely their family and pets. What plans are in place to accommodate our pets in these situations? Or without warning, a tornado, earthquake or explosion happens and animals seen wandering and lost after disasters are not strays or abandoned, they are our pets. They are lost, scared, possibly injured and in need of help.

What will happen to our displaced animal companions? Thankfully, regardless of the size or budget of a community, laws now require our local municipalities to prepare and care for its citizens and their pets in the event of a disaster. AKC Pet Disaster Relief can help our local Emergency Management be prepared.

What is AKC Pet Disaster Relief?

AKC Pet Disaster Relief helps local Emergency Management provide animal care services during the first 72 hours following a disaster... the critical time before FEMA support and services are deployed. Deployment of these trailers will help put an end to post-disaster tragedies which have historically affected pet owners, such as: putting themselves in harm's way to save a beloved pet, or even losing a family pet during a disaster.

We want every community to be prepared to help people and their pets for any disaster and its aftermath. That is why AKC Reunite is partnering with local AKC Clubs and their affiliates to raise funds to help supply AKC Pet Disaster Relief trailers to local Emergency Management.

AKC Pet Disaster Relief trailers are stocked with essential, nonperishable necessities for sheltering pets. The supplies can be used to create a safe, temporary home-base for displaced animals and can be used to create one of two types of animal shelters:

- Co-location Shelters: A shelter that houses both humans and their animal companions. The people housed at the shelter are responsible for their animal's general care.
- Lost and Found Pet Shelters: Displaced animals are housed in what often becomes a pop-up reunion center as people and animals are reunited. Approved volunteers and shelter staff provide animal care.

With AKC Pet Disaster Relief, our ultimate hopes are for:

- Better community preparedness
- More successful local disaster response
- Heightened awareness of the importance of disaster preparedness for their pets
- Peace of mind for pet owners—Safe, healthy sheltering environment that includes their pets— Happy reunions for separated animals and their human companions despite the chaos around them
- Lives will be saved

How Does it Work?

The AKC Pet Disaster Relief trailer is stocked with essential supplies to house at least 65 pets the first 72 hours after a disaster is declared. The trailer has lighting and is wired for electricity, to run off either a generator or 110v power supply. Its contents are supplied based on North Carolina's State Animal Response Team expertise in handling hurricanes, floods, fires and tornados.

Following is a sampling of typical contents:

- Administrative Supplies: Log books, Volunteer registration forms, wrist/collar bands, check-in materials
- Maintenance Equipment: Batteries, Gas Can, Duct Tape
- Animal Care: Crates packed on rolling dollies for easy set-up, cat carriers,; litter, microchips and scanner, bowls, collars and leashes
- Equipment: Fans, Generator, Lighting, Hose
- Cleaning Supplies: Mop, trash can, tarps, litter boxes, disinfectants
- Access to training materials: Turnkey implementation of Co-Located Shelters and Pop-up Reunion Centers, Volunteer Mobilization, Decontamination and Replenishment

Program Resources

Regardless of the size or budget of a community, local Emergency Management is now required by law to prepare and care for its citizens – including plans to accommodate people with their pets in the event of a disaster. To successfully meet these newer legal requirements, government organizations cannot alone meet the challenges posed by a catastrophe. AKC Pet Disaster Relief can be a key component to your local Emergency Management's disaster planning efforts.

Introducing AKC Pet Disaster Relief to your local Emergency Management is a powerful way to demonstrate your organization's concern for all pets and build meaningful grassroots relationships. If you do not know who to contact, FEMA.gov has a State Directory of Emergency Managers. You can also do a web search with your State's name and "local Emergency Management", oftentimes states have online directories at the regional or county level. American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is not an annual award. The awards selection committee may decide not to make any awards selection in a given year or may decide to bestow multiple awards. The number / frequency of award selection is strictly at the discretion of the awards selection committee.

Nominations may be submitted by organizations or individuals, including the nominees themselves.

AWARDS CRITERIA

Nominees are judged by the originality, vision, breadth, / impact of the entire body of their work. Candidate selection must go beyond mere name recognition / reputation. A nominee's work is evaluated in such areas as:

- A strong / well-documented commitment to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed.
- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaupes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


