

# Cover Story

## A Man and His Dog Long Forgotten

Buddy R. Noon & CNRC (1956) Dual Ch Bakers King: There's a story behind every achievement, every success realized, especially when it happens to a young man and his dog when it's never been done before or since.

Buddy Noon was a duck hunter who loved to hunt along the North Saskatchewan river right up until freeze up in November. A cold water retriever was essential for success. One of the top breeders of that kind of dog was Archie Baker of Edmonton, Alberta. Who was also involved in retriever trials. In the early 1950's retriever trials were attracting hunters all over western Canada as they began to see how training and competition could enhance the work of their dogs. Most hunters around Edmonton had labs so Buddy went to Archie Baker who was known as a reliable breeder of working retrievers and he bought a yellow lab.

That year, Buddy trained his pup along the banks of North Saskatchewan. The pup worked well all summer on land and water and Buddy had high hopes for the fall duck season. The pup made many great water retrieves until the cold weather arrived and then suddenly refused when the temperature fell.

No amount of persuasion or force could induce the lab to retrieve ducks from the cold North Saskatchewan. So Buddy sold him and went back to see Baker. Baker suggested a Chesapeake might work better for someone, like Buddy, who hunted late into the season when many people were getting ready for Christmas.

"We're going to have a Chesapeake litter in the Spring", said Archie "out of my bitch Chesaseal Happy Princess and Pat



St. Peter's dog, Conroy's Golden Arrow". Arrow had just become a field champion the previous year, 1952, only the second Chessie in Canada to have achieved that title.

Everyone called Arrow "Red" and he had a reputation for being animated, consistent and easy to train. "Don't need a lot of force with Red so maybe you'll get a pup like that" said Baker.

In June 1953 Bud headed over to Baker's Kennel to pick his pup. As it turned out, he didn't really pick King, the pup chose him.

Liz Lavoy, the breeder of F.T.Ch. Conroy's Golden Arrow, had a way of describing what she felt characterized the ideal Chesapeake. "There's no reason a Chesapeake can't be good looking and useful too" she would say. As it turned out, the square little red-brown pup that found Bud

that day in June 1953 turned out to be both handsome, athletic and useful.

"We were partners", says Bud, "he believed in me and I believed in him". "We had a relationship, where we trusted one another; so there was really no force training involved. I showed him what I wanted and he always did his best to please me".

Bud became involved in the Edmonton Sporting Dog Club. Training and trialing with many of those trainers and handlers who would go on to become well known as leaders in the sport. People like Monroe Coleman with Nelgard's Baron and Alf Gunns with Baron's Skipper Bob were in the process of making their Chesapeake's Canadian field champions at this time, along with several others. During the 1950's seven Chesapeake's became Canadian field champions, all but one coming out of the Edmonton area.

By 1956 King was placing in trials and Bud was involved in the Edmonton club when the National Retriever Club of Canada asked the Edmonton trialers to put on the seventh annual National trial. Bud was the Program Chairman for the trial, even though he was only 26 years old at the time.

Just 17 dogs qualified and Baker's King was one of them along with one Golden and 15 Labs. King had two 1st, one 2nd and one 3rd leading up to the National but the favorite was a Lab F.T.Ch Craigend Rock owned and handled by Jack Smyth of Maplewood, BC. Rock was a very stylish dog, an excellent marker and handling animal who most people felt was leading going into the final series. King, #3, was the first dog to go to line and Rock was #4 and the second to go to line. Bud had no idea of where he and King stood as they finished the last series; but a few minutes later as they retired from the line he heard a murmur of concern, as Craigend Rock broke, and opened the door to the remaining dogs.

Waiting for the judges' decision were Buddy (Edmonton, AB) & Dual Ch Baker's King, Ray Koskinen (Calgary, AB) & Dirk of Avandale, and George Mitchell (Edmonton, AB) & F.T.Ch. Brant of Bardonda. The three survivors at the end of the 10th series of the 1956 Canadian National Retriever trial.

As it turned out the judges T.A. Brown (Vancouver, BC), John Breckenbridge (Calgary, AB) and R.K. Moore (Port Credit, On.) awarded the Canadian National Championship to Dual Ch Baker's King.

Buddy was asked what it was about King that allowed him to succeed. Buddy feels it was the fact King was so consistent in his work! He was not stylish as the top retrievers but he marked and handled as if Buddy was in his head! They spent so much time together hunting and in their daily lives that training was simply an extension of how they lived. It was really an ideal partnership between a dog and a young man who lived his life with him!

### ***Post Script and Baker's King General Information***

Doing what they loved was the secret to their success! King lived as Buddy's best friend for almost 13 years; hunting and just chumming around.

Trialers looked to King's litter mate Baker's Brown Boy II when they wanted a pup to trial. King's brother was a faster more stylish retriever owned by Sid Webb of Edmonton. He wasn't as consistent or dependable as King, but there are still a good number of Canadian Chesapeakes whose blood lines go back to King through

his less famous brother! Today we are just thankful that we still have a hale and hearty 83 year old Buddy Noon with us to tell us the story of C.N.R.C Dual Ch. Bakers King, the 1<sup>st</sup>, and to this point only, National Champion Chesapeake Bay Retriever!!!!

### ***Epilogue:***

David visited with Ray Koskinen, who is 91 years old, and the only other person alive that ran with Buddy Noon in the 1956 National! He felt that Buddy was correct that it was King's consistency that allowed him to win the 1956 Canadian National !! Ray added "I've always said if you don't have a close rapport with your dog you should never go to line." Ray ran the Amateur National in Canada this year and completed 5 series and has a young dog running Qualifying in 2014.





## New Companion Dog (CD)

For the 4th consecutive year, we will celebrate the versatility of our breed with the Triple Crown Versatility Challenge. Dogs who meet the Triple Crown Challenge will receive a special commemorative award and be noted on the 2014 NSS Website and in the ACC Bulletin. All prizes will be presented at the banquet or the WD/X/Q ribbon ceremony (depending on when the dog meets the challenge). Prizes will be presented to each dog's owner of record, if present; otherwise the awards will go to the handler.

### Qualifications for the Triple Crown Versatility Challenge

*(Qualify and/or place in any three classes, across a minimum of two NSS Events)*

**(Please note the following change: This year, for the purposes of this Challenge, Obedience & Rally = 1 event.)**

**Tracking:** Qualifying score in tracking.

**Agility:** Qualifying score in any agility class offered.

**Obedience/Rally:** Qualifying score in any obedience and/or rally class offered.

**Conformation:** Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog/Bitch, a Judge's Award of Merit or by making the cut in the Best of Breed competition, Placement in any regular or non-regular conformation class (please note: in Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes, placements are awarded only to the parent dog, not to any of the representative offspring). Placement in any Puppy or Veteran Sweepstakes class also qualifies.

**Field:** Qualifying score in any Working Dog Test (WD, WDX, WDQ).

**Example 1:** "Fido" is entered in Rally Novice A, Rally Advanced A, Open Dog in conformation, and the WD for field. Fido qualified in Rally Novice A and placed third in Rally Advanced A. In Open Dog, he did not get a placement. Since his first two "goals" were both in Rally, and he failed to get a placement in Conformation, he does not meet the Triple Crown Challenge until the field, when he passes the WD.

**Example 2:** "Ripple" is entered in Veteran Obedience, 8+ Year-Old Bitch in Veteran Sweeps, Veteran Bitch 8-10 Years in Conformation, and the WD for field. She qualifies in obedience, is second in her Sweeps class, and goes first in her Veteran conformation class. She's already met the Triple Crown Versatility Challenge before she hits the field!

# Health Committee Report

Many ACC members are aware that the Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) has asked for any information the ACC can give concerning problems in our breed similar to the Newfoundland Forelimb Anomaly (NFA). Hopefully this commentary will give definition to what NFA is and why some similarity does not equal duplication.

The basis for this interest by NCA in Chesapeakes is in my opinion weak at best. NFA should have frequent dwarfism bilateral deformity of the forelimbs primarily emanating from damage to the growth plates of the radius and ulna. The end result of this deformity is displacement of the elbow. All of these results are not always present but should be a frequent finding.

The significance of the radius and ulna is because of the multiple growth plates in both and the fact these bones eventually fuse. Large dogs (Newfoundlands) and very active dogs can easily damage these growth plates and cause irregular growth and deformity. The point is the damage is because of use and size, not genetic mutation.

A search for factual medical reports rather than recollections provided little. The library of the University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School had (3) search engines specific for medical information. There was no reference involving Chesapeake Bay Retrievers and Chondroplasia and Dyschondroplasia in Medline, Agricola and CAB Abstracts. It was also not present in the medical or science section in Google.

Dr. Danica Bannish was a source listed by NFA. She had an AKC Canine Health Foundation grant in 2004-2005 titled:

*"A Candidate Gene Approach for Skeletal Dysplasia in the Newfoundland, Chesapeake Bay Retriever and Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever/AKC Canine Health Foundation."*

The NCA said they had a problem reaching Dr. Bannish. I did not, she both called and emailed me. This quote is from her email:

*"To answer your question there are some Chesapeake Bay Retrievers with a form*

*of skeletal dysplasia. We have not worked on this in awhile but we did not identify causative mutations at this time. I don't think it is very common in the breed but I would have no way of knowing for sure. When we are working on it we tried to find other affected dogs and did not."*

She clearly distinguishes between NFA and a "skeletal dysplasia" that could have a number of causes other than genetic. The NCA in a brief NFA history said under their category of genetics.

*"The breed predilection (to date only Newfoundlands and Duck Tolling retrievers) provides prima facie evidence of a strong genetic component, but this has yet to be verified with more refined methods."*

In short, no one has connected a bilateral or unilateral forelimb malformation that is clearly free of trauma, associated with dwarfism and having only a genetic cause. The NCA

says they anticipate further research on the problem. If this happens we can revisit their findings. For now I believe we should pursue problems that are at hand.

The next topic was suggested by an ACC member who felt a reminder of CERF closing was in order. Here is a copy of CERF's goodbye.

*"After nearly 30 years of working towards the elimination of heritable eye disease in dogs, The Canine Eye Registration Foundation will stop accepting new registrations for the CERF registry on June 15, 2014. Our on-line registry will continue to be available for approximately the next year after which CERF records will be able via the OFA website. CERF would like to thank all of our breeders and dog lovers for the continued support over these many years. Please direct any questions and/or concerns that you may have to [CERF@vmdb.org](mailto:CERF@vmdb.org).*

*CERF was founded by a group of concerned purebred owners and breeders with the goal of eliminating heritable eye diseases in purebred dogs through registration, research and education. <http://web.vmdb.org/home/> "*

For those who want more details on the closing of CERF, I refer you to the ACC Bulletin March/April 2013 page 5 in the Health Report under Eye Certification Registries and page 6 which has ¾ of a page answering questions by OFA on their eye registry.

Lastly a final reminder of the seminar by Dr. Chris Zink on exercise and injury in our performing dogs. She will discuss conformation and the roll it could play in injury. She will discuss types of exercise and how it could potentiate injury when mixed with certain conformations. Dr. Zink is considered a world class expert on sports medicine. This is paid for by the ACC Charitable Trust, arranged by the NSS and fully endorsed by the ACC Health Committee. Please set aside Thursday, September 18 2014 from 7:00pm – 9:00pm. It is free to ACC Members, register early seating will be very desirable.

## American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

### OBJECTIVE

### ELIGIBILITY

### JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

## AKC Delegate's Report

The AKC is not real efficient in getting out final reports. Here is what is official from the June 2014 meetings:

The Delegate body gave the final approval for the creation of a new suffix field trial title, "Q2A". This title may be REQUESTED by the owner of a dog that has met the requirements of being a Qualified All-Age dog twice. The AKC Performance Committee will be establishing a retroactive date to allow dogs that have already achieved this level to be recognized. This date will most likely go back several years.

The AKC Board wishes to expand the National Owner Handler Series (NOHS). Currently NOHS is a required Special Attraction "IF" All-Breed or Group Clubs choose to have any competitive Special Attractions. It is not the Board's intent to include Specialty Clubs or to mandate this attraction.

The Board also voted to modify their policy pertaining to "Clusters" conformation shows to exclude National Specialties. The new policy is:

"Approval of more than 4 days of unique AKC conformation events is contingent upon exceptional site capabilities, Executive Field Staff recommendation and subsequent approval by Event Plans. There is a checklist for site inspection. 
