Judges Commentary Mr. Jeffrey G. Pepper (FL) Dogs & Intersex

There is no greater honor for a judge than to be asked to judge a National Specialty. Judging the Chesapeake Bay Retriever National Specialty in September is an experience I will savor for a long time. My thanks to the American Chesapeake Club for inviting me to judge Dogs and Intersex competition in Lancaster this year. Special thanks to my very competent stewards who were a great help in keeping the classes organized for me. They made my job much easier. Thanks also to the show committee, especially Marty Smith, who was easily one of the most organized show chairs I have ever dealt with in nearly 30 years of judging. She made my time in Lancaster just perfect!



Over the years, I have judged the National Specialties of 4 of the 6 Retriever breeds. I can honestly say that the depth of quality in nearly all of the classes I judged over the two days was superior to that presently found in most of the other Retriever breeds. Presentation was uniformly good. Dogs were, with few exceptions, very well socialized and in true Retriever style willing to please. Coats were almost always harsh and oily, with many still having undercoat despite the time of year. Of course, being late September, there were some who were in the midst of shedding and left small deposits in the ring! These days, so many breeds are "fluffed and puffed" when shown, something I dislike intensely. This was certainly not the case in Lancaster. In the end, given that there is no perfect dog, decisions

were made on points that might well be considered minor at most shows. I was forced to send dogs out of the ring in my cuts that I would have been very happy to have in my ring at an all breed show.

Movement, in many cases, was good with strong backlines and balanced reach and drive, something missing in some of the Retriever



breeds being shown today. As dogs that retrieve in water, Chessies need strong well conditioned muscles with good length of leg. Some of the dogs in the ring were very well conditioned, others were soft, and perhaps a bit too fond of the kitchen! Unfortunately, there were some dogs with short legs that were noticeably less than half the height of the dog from elbow to ground as called for in the breed standard. This is a trend in other Retriever breeds and one to be avoided, especially in dogs that need to work. Remember, good movement is not determined by how fast the legs move nor by how high in the air they fly. Rather, good movement is determined by how much ground is covered with each stride with as little wasted energy as possible. This means there is little lift of the legs once they have pushed off the ground (which, of course, is where the power of propulsion comes from). Short legs flying in the air may look flashy, but its still incorrect movement.

In reviewing the catalog after I returned home, I noticed that there were a number of relatives that received placements in the various classes. It's wonderful to have enough good dogs that this kind of consistency is possible. Thanks to all exhibitors. I had two great days.

Again, my thanks to the committee, the exhibitors and my stewards. Together you made my weekend one to remember.

Judges Commentary Mrs. Pluis Davern (CA) Bitches & Junior Show

First of all my thanks to the American Chesapeake Club for bestowing the honor of inviting me to judge your bitches at the 2014 National Specialty. I was and still am thrilled by this opportunity.

My overall impression was of consistent breed type in all the classes. Your standard stresses balance, power and agility and I found many of the exhibits with just those qualities.

Coat quality and density was varied but given the time of year not unexpected . . . even the Chesapeake Bay in summer does not demand the coat it would require of the dogs during duck hunting season!?!)

There were several different 'styles' within the exhibits, some with more angles, more substance, and broader heads and some with less, but none that fell outside the parameters of your standard.

A few bitches approached a longer, lower cast like so many of our other retrievers and I sincerely hope Chessie breeders will lead the way in rectifying this unhappy trend.

My class winners all gave the impression of a single piece, everything flowing together seamlessly and no one part clamoring for attention. They filled the eye. In exhibits where the front assembly was straighter the rear angles matched and while not ideal, the balance was there.

Movement by and large was good with good foot timing, and reach and drive without exaggeration.



Wonderfully, with a few exceptions, the girls exhibited a measure of power, and athleticism, the look of a dog that could go all day no matter what the conditions. As an avid hunter myself they made my heart sing!

Where I would like to offer a word of advice especially to the predominantly owner handlers of this wonderful breed, "Socialize" your girls. Puppies, inside a building for the first time may exhibit reluctance, nervousness etc but older girls should be steadier, more accepting of a strange environment, and a stranger going over them!

Again thank you for showing me your great girls. I had a wonderful time.

Judges Commentary Ms. Diane Baker (IL) Puppy & Veteran Sweepstakes

For a breeder, being asked to judge sweeps at the National is the highest honor. I looked forward to it with great anticipation. This year's entry did not let me down. I had plenty of lovely puppies and veterans to choose from.

I was very, very pleased that with only one exception the babies were relaxed and happy. It



was great to see that temperaments are in such good shape. I think we have come a long way.

Bites were good. Coats and coat texture were pretty good for the most part. Over all breed type seems to be fine. While I was able to find plenty of nice puppies to work with, I would like to see some work on soundness. On the down and back there were several in need of improvement. I might caution breeders to pay some additional attention to their rears.

In the end I was very happy with the representatives I had for Best In Sweeps. They appear to be youngsters with a bright future and in true Chessie Spirit, they appear to be dogs who were built to get the job done.

The old guys never cease to impress. Having attended plenty of Specialties for other breeds, I can confidently say Chessie Veterans Rock!! Most of them look as good as they did in the peak of their career. These were some of my toughest decisions. My Veteran dog and Veteran bitch were very powerful animals that covered ground with efficiency and ease. It makes me really appreciate the longevity of our breed. These old guys and gals looked great!

Before I close, I'd like to mention the show committee and the volunteers. They did a wonderful job! They made a tough task look easy. This show ran very smoothly and everyone seemed to have a good time. A BIG THANK YOU to my stewards who did an outstanding job! They were organized and efficient and kept things moving very smoothly.

I could not have it without them. The whole show committee made this a great experience for judges and exhibitors. Thank you.

Lastly, I would like to thank the breeders and exhibitors who brought me a very nice entry. It was a real pleasure to see dogs of such fine quality. I will be excited to see some of these babies grow and I'll be looking for them when I sit ringside in the future. Good Luck to everyone and Thank you.



Comments from Jane Pappler and Gina Downin WDXQ Test Chairs

Planning for any national event starts at least a year in advance and usually longer. Such was the beginning for setting up to hold the WDXQ along with the PA Show Specialty. These days grounds for holding most field events is limited so we were lucky to be able to rent the Rebel Ridge Farm in Elkton, MD. Many judges are also competing on these weekends with their own dogs in hunt tests or field trials so that is another hurdle we had to get over---finding available judges. I knew we would have a very large entry so I planned in advance for this by securing six judges instead of the normal two or in some cases we have used four. We had a record entry of 87! In recent years there have been very few WD Stakes being held so this is why we had such a big turnout.

We posted all info on the ACC website well in advance. After a late worker cancellation, Chris Beste stepped up and filled the vacancy for the Field Supervisor. We could not have done this without him, his expertise in working hunt tests and all the equipment he secured for us... thanks so much Chris!

By 5:30 am we were out of the hotel and drove the 1 hr+ from Lancaster to the MD grounds. Darren Sausser directed traffic and Gina Downin had a check-in table ready. Handlers gathered at the WD area for a talk given by myself about the basic rules for the WD and tips on handling and line procedures. Questions were answered by the judges. The WD started at 9am with back to back singles setup by land judges Dora Heffelfinger and Kaj Lindstrom. Many dogs were reluctant to pick up the bird or to bring it back to the handler so there was a larger than normal "fall out" on the land marks. For those who were successful on land they then took their judging sheet and went down the hill where the water work was waiting with judges Ronnie Thomas and Tom Cooper. Running the land and water at the same time gave us the extra hours we need to get through all three stakes in one day. In the back fields, the WDQ started at 9:30am with Tim Carrion and Gary Boyce presiding. Close to noon there was a short lunch break before the WDX got under way. We made use of our same judges from the WD for the WDX. A few dogs weren't quite steady, a few had some obedience problems and again some did not pickup the birds. Owners tend to forget that obedience is a big part of doing a test and plays a part in whether or not the dog and handler are successful.

Lots of thanks goes to our contestants. We had at least 46 people volunteer to help pop & throw, marshal, bag birds or shoot. Amy Wernecke made cookies for the 55 lunches that we served to judges and all our workers! Thanks to Ann Law our #1 gopher for picking up 8 bags of ice, the lunches and helping distribute them. We can't forget Joe Quinn who helped with equipment, shooting and whatever was needed. I called several guys across several states to come and shoot for us and they did - Pat Baughman, NE, Bill Spano and Bill Ramsey from NY. Catharina Lindstrom, Sweden and Gerlinde Boross from Austria marshaled or bagged birds all day long! Working together is what makes events possible and successful. Gina and I could not have accomplished this task without the contestants and the workers. Thanks everyone for making this day a success for the Chesapeakes and the ACC.

Tazzy was born January 2006 in the family room of my house, one of six pups. This was approximately at the same time as the news regarding Tiger (DC AFC Distagon MH) and DM exploded into the consciousness of the Chesapeake world. Tazzy’s father, Tundra, had a similar breeding as Tiger, so I was concerned but information was still scarce at that point. When Tazzy was approximately 9 months old, a full blooded older sister came down with DM. Now, I was really worried, so I put no time into Tazzy’s training. I did not want to invest the necessary gobs of effort and time to train the dog only to have the dog die at 6 of this horrible disease. When Tazzy was 3, the test for DM became available and I immediately tested her, and luck of the draw, she was normal/normal (the parents, as it turned out, were both carriers). At this point, despite missing those first 3 years which are so critical, I started to train her. That early neglect and the fact that in Alaska we get about 3 months of training a year, hindered us, but we persevered. The fact that she accomplished the AKC and NAHRA masters’ titles despite these obstacles was uniquely rewarding.

Tazzy is totally amateur trained by her owner (me) and is my hunter extraordinaire. She is an excellent marker who possesses an extremely keen nose and knows how to use it. With her talent and unbridled passion for birds, she has won a competitive upland event, the Chukar Challenge, put on by the Arctic Bird Dog Association, beating all the pointers, setters, and spaniels at their own game (*ACC Bulletin Nov/ Dec 2011, p. 11*).

She is very well built and that, in combination with her talent and desire, has served us extremely well in our pursuit of many different species. She regularly hunts pheasants, quail, grouse, partridge, and waterfowl. Last year, she was responsible for the flush and retrieve of 50 wild rooster pheasants and that number does not include an embarrassing number of roosters flushed that were sadly, missed(not the dog’s fault). Tazzy has actually developed a point, and will hold that point, she is a pointing Chessie!

I will share one hunting exploit, as hunting is why I have Chesapeakes. Up until 2010, we always went down to Idaho to hunt with an old Chessie man named James Mauney (which we still do). We chased pheasants, chukars,

partridge and quail across the steep miserable terrain that is the Snake River Breaks. In 2010, in seeking better hunting and more benign terrain, we finally made the very long trek to North Dakota. During that 1st trip, 4 sharptail grouse flushed and flew across to an old creek bed that had thick cover. Tazzy and I hot footed it over to where I saw the sharptails land. I am ready with my 20 ga. over /under and send in Tazzy. However, instead of sharptails, out comes a cackling rooster pheasant. He is flying away and I shoot and rock him but he does not go down. He is still flying, but fairly low to the ground. Tazzy

sees this and takes off in hot pursuit. Now, Tazzy is very fast and this bird is giving it his all as is Tazzy. The bird and pursuing Chessie are rapidly covering ground going over a harvested pea field and away from me. The chase continues with the bird staying just out in front of the dog and then they go over the horizon out of sight. So there I am standing by the side of a pea field worrying and fretting if I’ll ever see my dog again, I don’t know long it was, seemed like an eternity and finally, I spot her in the distance, just a small dot and there she is, on the run back. It took awhile but I could finally make her out and it looks like she has something in her mouth, by God, she has the frigging bird!!!! (still alive) Good girl, really really good girl. Just an epic, epic retrieve. A defining moment, a moment that I will never forget. I have no idea whether she was able to get close enough to leap up and grab the rooster out of the air or the pheasant went for some cover, he had no tail feathers left, so it is my guess that there were a number of attempts at snatching the rooster out of the air before there was success, but the bottom line was that she was determined to bring me back the bird and she did. She earned my respect which is not easy given, given the standards that were set by her most beloved mother, Katmai (CH Katmai Chugach Splendor MH QA2).

Tazzy’s show career was brief due to success. Her build, coat, and enthusiasm all worked in her favor. She had 3 straight majors and was done very quickly. She was shown by Ms. Crystal Beam whom she liked working with. Crystal did a great job and deserves all the credit for this.

Next up for Tazzy is hunting season. We may pursue the MHu title if and when AKC approves Chessies for it.





Health Committee Report

Health Report: Ebola and Our Dogs

In this environment of no information and misinformation, I thought our membership should have as much factual information as is available.

There have been at least 2 major outbreaks in West Africa with large surrounding dog populations that have had substantive scientific surveys of the canine populations.

In 2001-2002 there was a major outbreak of Ebola in Gabon. Blood tests showed 25% of the tested population had antibodies to Ebola. This shows exposure to the disease. None had the virus present, none showed signs of disease, none had died. This shows complete resistance to the disease and no ability to pass on the disease.

In 2005 a survey was taken in African villages having a history of Ebola outbreaks. They all had a feral dog population. Once again a high number of dogs had antibody to the disease. None had the presence of the virus, none had signs of the disease, none died.

In short it seems the canine immune system intercepts the virus, stops canine cells from being penetrated and stops the virus from replicating in the dog. In short, the dogs do not acquire or carry the disease.

This is very reassuring to dog owners. The problem lies with two mammalian species that do form reservoirs (a reservoir is a host for the disease that carries the virus, is asymptomatic-shows no sign of the disease and transmits the disease to humans or other animals). They are fruit bats (not present in North America) and certain primates including monkeys and apes. The fact that these mammals are susceptible raises the fear that at some point the virus could mutate (change) enough to penetrate the canine immune system.

The obvious conclusion is to watch for mutation of the virus and react accordingly. There is no history that suggests dogs having been tested in the heart of the greatest exposure represents any present danger to man.

The second area of concern is the future and past of DM research. The January-February ACC Bulletin will have an extensive report from Dr. Joan Coates, the "point" person on the DM project answering most if not all questions on the DM findings, changes, questions, answers, obstacles and future research.

A long list is being submitted and reviewed by Dr. Coates and is growing and changing as this is being written. It will cover everything from autopsies (are they still helpful), to using present information on DM in breeding programs, to present and future gene mutation and how that will be handled.

Lastly, there is not yet a set date for the release of the CD from Dr. Chris Zink's presentation at the NSS. It will be forth coming and it will be well advertised. For any who did not see it, it is outstanding. It is something that is well worth having as a reference.

Report of Treasurer

The Treasurer provided a handout with the following information: BB&T Checking and Savings Accounts total \$149,473.37 (as of 8/11/14) and Huntington total \$6,960.69 (as of 8/6/14).
