

Five Chesapeakes Compete in the 2014 AKC Agility Invitational

On December 12-14 2014, five Chesapeake Bay Retrievers and their handlers met in Orlando FL to represent CBRs at the ninth annual AKC Agility Invitational, held in conjunction with the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship and the AKC National Obedience Invitational. The Agility Invitational competition consists of four preliminary rounds with the highest cumulative scoring dogs competing in a final round for the Championship. All Chesapeake representatives competed with 136 all-breed competitors in the 24" jump height. This year's ACC sponsored high score medallion went to "Jill" and handler Ann Williscroft.

Jack's Journey Home

Jack's Journey Home: A Story of Survival and Perseverance

My husband Jim and I have had Chesapeakes since 1998. To better understand Jack, I'd like to tell you a little about him leading up to December 27, 2014.

Jack was the 8th puppy of 11 born on May 1, 2002. He stood out from the very beginning, the darkest brown pup in a sea of dead grass and light brown. As we watched them grow, we noticed number 8 had a little more "attitude" than the other pups. When people came to pick their pups, #8 would come out, be friendly and then he'd disappear. His brothers and sisters found their new homes and Jack had found us.

After a brief stint in the conformation ring, we realized Jack needed more purpose and he was sent off for hunt training. His trainers, Cole Fertig and Jean Bates told us Jack approached learning seriously and loved to work. Jack had found his niche. We ran him in UKC and AKC tests, getting his SHR and JH with 4 straight passes and his WDX at the NSS in Ohio.

Jack was Jim's buddy, they were always together. They would go quail hunting at a local preserve, but no duck hunting. This is Florida and I'm afraid of the gators. So I'd put my foot down and Jack would stay home. For several years, Jim and our good friend, Rich Schaffer talked about taking Jack duck hunting. Rich knows the Okeechobee area very well and hunted safely with his Chessie, Diesel. Jack wasn't getting any younger and Jim wanted to give him the opportunity to go on a "real" duck hunt. So they planned this for December 27, 2014. Jack was now 12 ½ and it had been about 3 years since he was around gunfire.

It was a beautiful mild day. Jim and Rich put Rich's boat in at a marina on the Kissimmee River. With Jack in the bow, they headed towards the swampy area of Okeechobee called "The Mounds". Jack was having a good time basking in the warm Florida sun. They settled in the marshes when Rich spotted a duck and took his shot. Startled by the unexpected gunfire, Jack took off into the dense mounds of cat tails. He was in the Fright and Flight mode and didn't respond to Jim's calls and whistles. They tried following but the boat couldn't go into that area. So Jim and Rich

jumped into the water. The water roots pulled Jim under, when he surfaced, Jack had disappeared. They searched the area around the mounds until they ran out of daylight and gas. Devastated they returned to the marina and Jim had the difficult task of telling me that Jack was lost.

For the next few days we had airboats going out to the area where Jack was last seen. We distributed flyers everywhere. We placed ads in newspapers, on the local radio station, visited shelters, talked to local rescues and posted on social media. A dear friend and fellow Chessie person, Mclane Evans, who is a trained wildlife surveyor, had hired a plane to search the area. There was no sign of Jack, nothing. We were beginning to lose all hope.

On the evening of the 4th day, feeling desperate, I called Jacque Riker, an animal communicator. A friend had suggested Jacque to me, but I was skeptical about her abilities. Jacque asked about Jack and was given a picture. She then told us we needed to stop thinking negative thoughts and what

could be happening to him. Instead we needed to be positive and think about how much we loved him and wanted him home. The next morning, New Year's Eve, at about 7:45am, Jacque called saying she had reached out to Jack. He wasn't too far from where he was lost, he could hear people, but he was stuck and couldn't move. He was afraid and cold and ready to give up. Jacque told Jack there were people looking for him, that he was loved and he needed to try to get out. If he couldn't get out, he needed to make himself heard. After hanging up from this call, I was confused: should we believe this?


About 5 minutes later we got our answer. Jason, the airboat guide Jim had hired called telling us his friend, Bob Stafford had found Jack!! While setting out decoys, Bob had heard a dog barking! He knew about Jack, followed his barks and with his airboat found him about 100 yards from the area he had been lost. Jack's rear legs were tangled in the veins and roots and he couldn't free himself. Bob had to jump into the water and cut Jack free. He then took him to a local bait shop to wait for us to arrive. On our way I called Lisa Stark, a local canine rescue volunteer and she went to the bait

shop with blankets to keep Jack warm. We raced the 100+ miles and with Lisa's help took Jack to the Okeechobee Veterinary Hospital and Dr. Harvey. Jack was suffering from dehydration and hypothermia. His admitting temperature was 98.3. Dr. Harvey didn't give us much hope, he told us it would be touch and go considering his age and how long he had been in the water. Jack was put on a warming blanket and given IV fluids, and had blood work drawn. That was all they could do, the rest was up to Jack. By the next day he was awake and that afternoon he was able to get up and walk outside. He was wagging his tail the next time we visited. After spending two nights under the constant care of Dr. Harvey and his Tech, Megan, Jack was able to come home.

Jack has had a few setbacks, but he is steadily improving. He has the perseverance and the will to survive for which the breed is known, as well as the bond of love he has for us, his family.

We want to thank everyone for their prayers and well wishes Jack received and are continuing to receive. The Chesapeake and dog family is truly amazing. Words cannot adequately express how we feel. We especially want to thank Dr. Harvey and Megan, Mclane Evans for her support and generosity, Lisa Sparks for being there for Jack at the bait shop. Jacque Riker for reaching out and hearing Jack and renewing my hope that Jack would be found. Most of all our heartfelt thanks go to Bob Stafford, Air Boat Guide extraordinaire, for finding our boy and bringing him back to us! God Bless you!

Health Committee Report

Update on Degenerative Myelopathy Testing and Research

This update on Degenerative Myelopathy (DM) in Chesapeake Bay Retrievers (CBRs) is a compilation of published results from University of Missouri's, College of Veterinary Medicine's (UMC) ongoing collaborative work, and a written summary of the results to the ACC Charitable Trust and ACC Health Committee. It has been almost 9 years since this research began and during this time, interest has increased since DM in dogs closely resembles Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (a.k.a. A.L.S./ Lou Gehrig's Disease) in humans. The following is a summary of the research that has been done so far and the direction that current studies in the area of DM are headed.

In 2009 the first published results (in 5 canine breeds including CBRs) identified a gene mutation (SOD1) which is now known to be present in animals who develop DM. The researchers at the UMC wanted to take the opportunity to thank the ACC, the Charitable Trust, and all of those owners (and dogs) who have participated in the studies that allowed discovery of the SOD1 gene mutation. In addition, additional thanks goes to all owners who have had and will continue to have dogs tested for the SOD1 gene, and those who continue to support the ongoing research in canine DM.

A recent article in the *Journal of Veterinary Internal Medicine* (2014) by the UMC researchers identified the various breeds that have a portion of a gene identified as *SOD1:c.118A* (SOD1) that has been associated with canine DM. These include over 124 different breeds including the Chesapeake Bay Retriever. It is thought that dogs that develop DM have two genes with the genetic mutation. The study reports that across breeds thus far there are only a few "carrier" dogs (dogs that have only one copy of the SOD1 gene) that have developed confirmed DM. But the researchers at UMC importantly point out that larger sample sizes are needed. In order to confirm a case of DM, microscopic examination of the spinal cord tissue is critical. These tissues are collected after euthanasia during a post-mortem examination. Many of the dogs that have been tested to be "at risk" or "carrier" are still living so correlation between the genetic testing and actual microscopic results are still ongoing. Donations from organizations like the

ACC Charitable Trust and concerned owners of dogs that develop DM make this continuing research possible.

As of December 2014, Dr. Joan Coates, a neurologist at UMC reports that 2835 CBR's have been tested for the SOD1 gene mutation. Of those CBR's 1193 dogs were normal (carrying no copies of the SOD1 gene mutation), 1248 dogs were considered to be "carriers" (having one copy of the SOD1 gene mutation), and 394 dogs were considered "at risk" (having two copies of the SOD1 gene mutation – one from each parent). In addition they have been able to do post-mortem exams on CBR's who died with symptoms of DM. Of these dogs 11 were confirmed to have DM, and of those 11 dogs, 7 of them were in the "at risk" category, and the other 4 were "carrier" dogs. This means that 4 cases of documented DM were in "carrier" dogs; dogs that were heterozygous for the SOD1 mutation rather than being in the "at risk" category with two copies of the gene mutation.

Out of the many breeds studied and tested for DM, researchers found more "carriers" that have actually developed documented DM among CBR's than they found with any other breed. At this time, it is unknown how to interpret this data. More data in the form of a larger sampling of DM affected dogs is needed to confirm that this finding is more than simply random and not the norm., but researchers suggest that CBR's may develop signs of DM than most other breeds. This is important information in order to ensure the utmost health in our breed. The ACC Charitable Trust has recently donated additional funds to this ongoing study in hopes of further characterizing genetic factors that might influence the progression of the DM symptoms. The research will focus on trying to identify more specific DNA markers (DNA tests of sorts) so that the DM status of "carrier" dogs can be specified. This needs to be accomplished so that the CBR gene pool is not drastically reduced by simply saying any "carrier" dog (at least one copy of the mutation) is at risk. In addition, identifying genetic factors in SOD1-carrying animals that influence the susceptibility to DM may help researchers develop novel therapies to combat DM in animals that are affected.

Late last year the ACC Health Committee and the ACC Charitable Trust requested that the researchers give CBR owners an update on how to interpret the DNA test results and research at this time. Past advice was that only "at risk" dogs who had two copies of the SOD1 gene mutation (homozygous for SOD1) would be at risk for developing DM, and that it was okay to breed a "carrier" or "affected" dog to a dog that was "normal". Though this is still general advice to CBR owners/breeders, the researchers want owners to be aware that there is some preliminary evidence that CBR "carrier" dogs may be more susceptible to developing DM than other breeds. They are not advising more stringent restrictions on breeding until more research and more samples from CBR's who develop DM can be collected and analyzed.

Based on this information and the recommendations from the most recent DM studies, the ACC Health Committee stands by the recommendations set after the original DM studies that "breeding to avoid the production of dogs that may result in animals with two copies of the SOD1 gene mutation is a rational strategy". At this time it is important to spread the word that CBR's with only one copy of the gene ("carriers") may be more susceptible to DM than other breeds with the same gene mutation. We restrain from making any suggestions affecting breeding until more information is gathered and will report back when more information is available.

In conclusion, the UMC researchers and the ACC Health Committee hope that the results of the studies and the advances that have been made will encourage owners to continue to support the research for the benefit of our great American breed. We hope that owners will continue to reach out to the ACC Health Committee (Dr. Briedi Gillespie: b.gillespie@usu.edu) or contact the University of Missouri if you have a dog that shows any signs of DM so that we may learn even more about this debilitating disease.

Sophie and I are off to Martha Pond on the Oswego. I'm wearing everything I own as the temperature in the pre dawn light is a more than frosty 16 degrees. It is with low expectations that I set out half a dozen mallard stools and Mr. Mojo Duck. I think he spooks more birds than not, but in this small pocket in the cedars I need something to attract the attention of unseen birds as I have a very limited view of the sky.

Dawn breaks slowly with not a breath of wind in the air but the decoys are swinging nicely in the flowing river. All is still and I'm not even hearing any shots in the distance. I'm thinking it is going to be another of those birdless mornings when I hear a roar of wings coming over my shoulder. About 10 mallards are attempting to light, going from left to right as I take aim at the closest drake and splash him with the first shot. Sophie holds her ground as I turn and fire at another of the rapidly departing flock. The second bird goes down and I'm happy with what for me is a pretty rare double. I send Sophie to the first bird down. Although it is stone dead, it's heading quickly away in the river current. She proudly returns with the drake and although she marked the fall of the second bird nicely, it has floated



a good distance from where it went down. I line her and tell her "dead bird" and send her on her way. She has to hunt a bit but she is becoming quite the pro and soon is back at my side with her prize.

Water droplets quickly turn to ice on my double coated Chessie. She is so well insulated that her body heat does not escape to melt the crystals. She eyes my backpack knowing that her Tasty Cake reward is waiting there. She wolfs that down and then we take a celebratory jog to get my blood back flowing. We hunker back down for another couple hours but never hear or see another bird. Not exactly a limit of birds but it's been another memorable morning spent with my treasured brown dog.



The trophy was donated by Mrs. Walter S. Heller and was first awarded in 1963. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll** owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner: Prairie Sky Patterson** owned by Jonathan Butler.

DC AFC Mount Joy's Mallard Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Amateur competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. E. C. Fleishman and was first awarded in 1962. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll** owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

The Louis Traung Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.) **Winners: Las Baulinas Colors of The Wind** owned by Ron & Joyce Foley and **Crackshot Rice Rocket** owned by Jennifer Matteoli & Julie Cole.

CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966. **Winner: AFC Yakity's Crackshot Ruddy Duck** owned by Julie & Mike Cole.

FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa Chief Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Derby competition in the Central and Eastern Time zones. The trophy was donated by Alex Spear in memory of his dog Chip. **Winner: Prairie Sky Patterson** owned by Jonathan Butler.

FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner: Crossfire Empire Builder** owned by Paul Gilmore.



AKC Offers New Qualified All Age 2 Title!!!!

Any dog that on TWO occasions has met the qualifications to become Qualified All Age is eligible to earn the title "Qualified All Age 2" (QA2). (The dog must either earn a ribbon in an Open or Amateur or have placed 1st or 2nd in a Qualifying.) To apply for this title, the owner must fill out a form and submit a \$20 recording fee. Upon verification, the QA2 title will appear on the dog's record and a title certificate will be issued. The AKC will recognize qualifying performances back to January 1, 2000.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.

Updates from the Electronics Communications Committee (ECC)

Database Updates - The ECC has started organization of some out-dated existing Health Databases and need your help. The ACC gets quarterly reports from OFA that are sent to our Health Database person Deb Rivas. OFA sends results of tests they have certified as well as any results of tests that CBR owners have submitted (with a fee) to be published on the OFA website. The OFA certifies Hips, Elbows, Cardiac, Thyroid, Shoulder, Patella, OFA Eye Registry and are now including Degenerative Myelopathy (DM) and they list Cerf. Our other Databases we are compiling will include Ectodermal Dysplasia (EDSF), Exercise Induced Collapse (EIC), Long Coat (LC), and Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA). Two of these tests, EDSF and LC, are newer so we are just starting our lists for these.

What we are asking for is the results for all CBRs of the above tests, along with certification of some sort, to be sent (via email preferred), to Deb Rivas at HealthClearances@amchessieclub.org. Send ONLY those results that are NOT on the OFA database as those we have. Any tests done by other companies (not OFA) in the US and other countries is what are needed so we have complete info. It is important for our breed to have as many results compiled as possible to track these diseases/clearances for safeguarding our breed and for better breeding decisions to be made. This is a huge undertaking by myself and the ECC and will take some time to compile. Please email any info/questions to Deb Rivas. All of the completed Databases will be made available to ACC members in the future on the ACC Website. David Berry of the ECC is working on that project now too. – Jane Pappler, Chairman, ECC

ACC Website - Things are routinely added to different sections of the web. This winter we applied several fixes regarding Membership updates. When a change is needed for personal member info, go to the Membership Page and click on “Send updates by email to the Data Coordinator”. Next on the dropdown menu select Data Coordinator, fill in your info required, click send. The response says, “your email is being sent” then you have to **click** again where it asks you to. This opens up an email right from your own web server

and you send the message directly to the data coordinator. Also, take time to check the Events page for upcoming Chesapeake functions and the newly updated list of BOD, Project and Committee Members. – Jane Pappler, ACC Website Manager

Improving Our Email Communication Efforts with Members - As we come to the end of another membership renewal season I'd like to address emails not being received by members. Of course the number one action a member can take is to make sure we have your current email address. Many members have no email address on file, and in some cases no phone contact, we urge you to add these contacts so you don't miss out on important notices.

Spam is a growing problem and there is a huge industry built around detecting spam and likewise, there is a huge marketing sector that needs to craft emails to get past the spam software. Your ISP (internet service provider) may also be taking a position where they totally block email originating from ISP's who do not conform to their policy.

Whatever the cause of our email not being seen by you, you can configure your mail preferences with your ISP to allow any email being sent to you from - amchessieclub.org - to bypass any spam detecting software and deliver it to your Inbox. Please read the following explanation (reprinted off the internet) and take the necessary action. Thank you.

It's getting stuck somewhere...

We are not receiving “bounce-back” or “undeliverable mail” messages, so we have to assume that most (if not all) of these messages ARE being received by the email servers at your ISP. They seem to be getting “lost” or “filtered out” between the ISP and you. Possibly because of overly-aggressive junk mail filters (**filters that you may not even know that you have**) may be interpreting it as unsolicited and stopping you from seeing it.

So, what can be done?

- The first thing to do is look in your regular “junk” folder.
- If our email is there, then mark it as “not junk” and
- make use of the other options of “adding this email address to your address book, or your “safe” list” (whatever your email

program suggests). This should make sure that any other emails from us will not suffer the same fate.

If you use a “webmail” service *exclusively* (where you go on to the internet, and log-in to a particular website to check your email) this may be all you need to do.

Desktop email software users

But if you have a desktop email program (such as Outlook, Outlook Express, Windows Mail, Thunderbird, Entourage, Mail for Mac etc) these “missing emails” quite often aren’t in the junk folder that is part of that software.

You see, all ISPs also have junk mail filters, which are regularly “beefed-up”, supposedly keeping ahead of spammers, and “catching more spam”. Undoubtedly some legitimate emails are also being caught in these filters. And if they are caught by these filters, **you may never see these messages at all and so will never know that you were even sent them!**

This happened to me, with my own sympatico account and I can tell you what I had to do to fix it; something similar is probably happening with your mail program, and many other ISPs.

Check your webmail

If you have never checked the “webmail” service (that all ISPs have, but that you may not know how to access) that should be your next stop.

- If you don’t know the webpage to log-in, start with the home page of your email company (or ISP) e.g. <http://www.sympatico.ca>, <http://www.rogers.com>, <http://www.videotron.ca> etc
- From that page you will almost certainly find a link to “webmail”, or “check my email” or something similar.
- You will need to know your login (usually your email address) and your password. Your password may be hard to find if you use a desktop program exclusively, as the software usually remembers the password for you so you probably don’t need to remember it on a day-to-day basis. If you really can’t find it you may need to call your ISPs “help” desk...
- Once you are “in”, you should check the junk mail folder that will probably be there. Again, if you find our email there, mark it as “not junk” and “add the email address to your address book, or “safe” list”. (Who

knows, maybe you’ll find other legit email at the same time that you can rescue).

- At this time, I would suggest checking the “security” settings, or the “junk mail” settings - I set mine to only catch the most obvious junk mail.

With any luck, you will now get our emails in the future.

If this all sounds like a lot of hassle, we agree - it sure is. It’s a real drag. But we can’t think of any other way to ensure that you get our emails for sure, **and if you are dealing with us by email, you do need to get our emails!**

As an example for Gmail users, follow these steps and add @amchessieclub.org where it says to whitelist

To make sure Gmail never filters as spam mail from a certain contact or domain:

- Click the *Show search options* downward-pointing triangle in your Gmail’s main search field.
- Type the desired email address under *From*.
 - To whitelist an entire domain (all mail from an address ending in “amchessieclub.org”, for example), type the just the domain name or the domain name preceded by ‘@’. To whitelist “amchessieclub.org”, for instance, type “@amchessieclub.org” (not including the quotation marks).
- Follow the *Create filter with this search* » link at the bottom of the search sheet.
- Make sure *Never send it to Spam* is checked.
- Click *Create filter*.

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter – a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


