



Obedience, Rally & Tracking News

NW2 Title (National Association of Canine Scent Work, NACSW)

"Sky" CH* Riverdel's Red Sky at Night, RN, NW2, CGC achieved his NW2 title through the NACSW at their trial held in Stroudsburg, PA on May 2, 2015. The searches in NW2 are increasingly difficult and include a 2nd odor, Anise, along with Birch used in NW1. Each of the 4 search elements can have multiple hides and the source can be inaccessible. The container search in NW2 introduces major challenges of hidden distractions (food or toys), and ANY type container can be used. The interior search area increases to 2-rooms, and there can be up to 4-vehicles. Our last search of the day was containers, our nemesis! We were given 2.5mins to find 2-hides amongst the various pieces of luggage, we did it in 45secs! Sky alerted on both odors hard and fast and never paused at the distractions. We later learned there were 3 distractions: Breakfast sandwich, donut, and 3 tennis balls! We received a "pronounced" designation for this search for his commitment and enthusiasm. He also received "pronounced" for his Exterior search. Judges' comments from the day included "good motivation", "loved his enthusiasm", "good odor obedience", and "nice search"! Sky's combined time for all 5 of his search areas was 4.14mins, placing him 6th overall of 34 dogs entered and only 1 of 14 dogs that qualified. He is only the 3rd Chesapeake to be awarded the NW2 title. Sky is 12+years old and loves this game! Sky is bred, owned, trained and loved by Marty Smith (NJ).





same as regular Novice EXCEPT that there are no Group Stays.

Instead, the judge specifies that the handler "walk around the ring"

while the dog either does a Sit Stay or a Down Stay - usually in the

center of the ring (similar to Beginner Novice). WooHoo and RooRoo!



Attention Chesapeake Dog Owners New Clinical Trial for Dogs With Chronic Gastrointestinal Problems

The University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School is accepting dogs into a new clinical study on dogs that have chronic gastrointestinal problems such as diarrhea and/or vomiting, weight loss or has been diagnosed with inflammatory bowel disease.

The diagnostic work up and early treatments will be within a 2-8 week time span depending on the results and findings. They are all free of charge to the owner which is quite a valuable package including board certified veterinary specialists in the field of canine GI problems investigating your dog's problem.

The goals of this trial are to find both diagnostic and therapeutic applications to those dogs suffering this chronic disease process.

New Wilderness SAR Chessie in Germany

Redlion's Don't Hit Sir Edward (Redlion's Hit It Rich x Pond Hollows Legos Point)

On June 20, 2015, we passed the Wilderness Search and Rescue Test. The Wilderness SAR test starts with a theory test (25 questions).

The first test which needs to be shown by the dog is a very simple indication, a person lying visible 50 meters away and the dog has to show a correct indication. (My dog shows a bark indication). Next test is the obedience part, including heelwork, compatibility with other dogs and people and obedience over distance (similar to blinds and sending the dog towards the blinds in typical Retriever work).

The last and most important test is the search, roundabout 325000 square foot needs to be searched in 20 minutes, usually two people are hidden, the dog needs to show a correct indication and the handler needs to do the orientation in the field and first aid. This is the most important part and things like how the dog is working in the area, obedience over the distances, the drive and many other points are reviewed. My great boy Redlion's Don't Hit sir Edward, youngest dog tested that day, achieved the best results, every remit tested he got first grade. I'm more than just proud!

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.



CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

AKC Delegate's Report June 2015

The debate over "territory" for Dog Shows continues. While it is recognized that clubs need a means to protect their dates and venue there is also the reality of a shortage of suitable facilities. The proposed rule change was sent back to the Dog Show Committee for language clarification regarding a club's appeal process and how to incorporate these changes into both the conformation and performance competitions that are held at these events.

A proposed rule change was made to "allow the awarding of CM points to puppy classes". Dogs would be awarded one point towards its championship under this proposal. This was met some opposition based on various breed height requirements and the current point schedule.

The AKC's Performance Committee has met with the Master National Retriever Club (MNRC) regarding the management of the Master National. The AKC is concerned about the size of the event and how the entry could be better controlled. At present the MNRC's bylaws do not allow for changes without a 2/3 majority vote. A recent proposed changes of requiring 6 of 8 was rejected by MNRC member clubs.

Julian Prager provided an update of the Animal Welfare Act. There are still only 120 inspectors nationwide. This means we remain a very low priority. Two areas that are of some concern is the interstate transport of pets between shelters and the resale or imports of dogs. The only restriction on importing dogs is the Center for Disease Control restriction that prohibits the

import of dogs under 4 months of age due to inadequate rabies protection. A dog under 4 months CAN be imported as long as you agree to confine the puppy and sign a confinement agreement and get the vaccine at the appropriate age. As a final note there is an effort to register dog brokers so that future regulations can be better aimed at the commercial and not the breeder communities.
