# On the Cover

## A Historical Discussion of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever

### The 1940'S - A Sharp Contrast

The 1940's were a sharp contrast to the glory days of the 1930's. World War II heavily curtailed dog activities. The rationing of gas and food made it difficult for all but the wealthy to breed and enter events.

All areas of competition were affected by the economic situation. The field trial scene suffered a big downturn. ACC held no field trials from 1942 - 1949. Many other field trial clubs also stopped holding trials. In conformation no specialty shows were held from 1942 - 1953 (exception 1945-no entries; 1946 a handful). Champions titled from 1940 to 1949 totaled 53. Obedience records show 20 titles were completed. Mrs. Allien Owens, Jr. made up the first Ch/CDX titleholder in her Ch Water Witch CDX. Mrs. Owens, Jr. was an avid obedience enthusiast-putting the first obedience title on a Chesapeake in 1937 (Bay Rum CD). Another woman later destined to make a significant impact on the breed put her first title on a CBR-Janet Horn (Eastern Waters) put a CD on her Gloriana II as the decade closed in 1949.

### Field Trials

While trials were very limited in number, 4 dogs titled during the 40's- FC Guess of Shagwong & FC Sodak's Rip (41 & 42); Bayle & Tiger of Clipper City in 1946. Chesacraft Baron made a last attempt to capture his needed second win in 1945 but came in second-thus failed to title. Of them, FC Tiger of Clipper City was the most spectacular-being high pt. Chesapeake from 1947 to 1949.

**FC Guess of Shagwong** "Guess" was named for his unusual coloration (he is pictured in a painting by Edwin Megargee). He was owned and bred by E. Monroe Osborne. A

grandson of Ed's FC Shagwong Gypsy and sired by Chesacraft Baron \*\*\*, his record in field trials is 19 open pts. He ran in and completed the 1941 National Open. He titled in 1941.

**FC Sodak's Rip** whelped April 1938 was a brown dog owned by and run by Earl K Ward. He was bred by William Gunn of Amarillo, TX. His

field record was 15 Open pts. He also ran in the 1941 National Open and completed; ran in 1944 National and broke in the 6<sup>th</sup> series.

**FC Tiger of Clipper** was smallish deadgrass bitch owned by Dr. Gardner often run by him or by her trainer Charles Morgan. She was the outstanding FT Chesapeake 1946 to 1949. Her forte was in the water-her handling ability in the water no matter how cold was superb. She won 5 all-breed open stakes and held the record for Open pts (32) until her son FC/AFC/CFC Nelgards Baron CD passed her in 1959. She ran in two Nationals-46 & 47-finishing 6 series each time.

**FC Bayle** was a long coated dog with an excellent marking ability owned by Vance Morris. He earned 17.5 pts in Open stakes and ran in and broke in the second series of the 1946 National.

### Other Notable Dogs

**Gunner II** Started the 1940's field trial scene as the upcoming competitor based on his 46 pt. derby career & Top Derby dog all-breeds in 1939. His Open career was cut short by the war ended with 9.5 pts with an all-breed win. He represented the breed at the 1942 National and went 8 series.

**Buddy Brown** owned by E. Monroe Osborne was another whose promising career was affected by the war. While Ed Osborne was away in the service, he was run by various friends. In 1944 he garnered 9 pts and an all-breed win. He ran in the 1944 National and went 5 series. After the war, Ed Osborne moved on to other interests and that ended "Brownie's " career.

Other notable performers in this era were Br \* Lakewood Ben \*\*\* who won the Long Island RC Nov 44 Open and also placed in the Sporting group at the Kennel Club Of Philadelphia in a time when the Chesapeake placing in group was a rarity. He was the first \*\*\* CBR to achieve a group placement.

### Nelgard Kennels

The field trial Chesapeake continuation owed much to the Nelgard kennel of Dr. George Gardner .The Nelgard kennel was located in Evanston, Illinois and was a joint venture of Dr. Gardner & his wife. Mrs. Gardner was the Labrador enthusiast but Dr. Gardner's interest was the Chesapeake. The basis of his kennel was formed on the

progeny of Chesacraft Baron \*\*\* & FC Sodak's Rip. His involvement with the Chesapeake started in 1946 when he acquired Tiger of Clipper City. Dr. Gardner's contribution to the Chesapeake was considerable as he bred FC/AFC Nelgards King Tut, FC/AFC Nelgard's Baron & Ch Nelgard's Rip Tide \*\*\*.

## Conformation Shows

Despite no ACC Specialty shows, Chesapeakes still competed in all-breed conformation shows. Robert Brown who later become known for his Mount Joy kennel and FT champions started in conformation with his 1947 Westminster BOB winner Ch Felt's Chesty. Phil Dater on Long Island NY was active in shows and breeding during the 1940's under the Napeague/Montauk name. He made up 7 champions in the early 40's the most famous being Ch Drive of Montauk & Ch Napeague Enchantress. Out West, Louis Trang was breeding under the Grizzly Island prefix and finished several champions-Ch Grizzly Zip just one of his titlists.

## Other Significant Kennels Of The Era

**Native Shore:** This kennel is indicative of the effects of WW II on the breeding of the Chesapeake. Mrs. Royce Spring of Easton, MD used this prefix on her breedings starting in the very late 30's and into the 1940's era. When WW II started she donated her current champion Ch Native Shore Wachapreague (pictured on the cover of the AKC Gazette, see next page) to the US K-9 Corps. Mrs. Spring was not a prolific breeder "In all, I only bred about 75 pups. A number of them I put down for I never kept or gave away any that were timid or below standard." Her first dog to title was Ch Bos'N's Best. In 1943, E.V.

Weems titled the last Spring bred champion Ch Native Shore Brant. Other champions produced by the kennel include Ch Native Shore Drake, Ch Native Shore Miss Lou \*\*\* & Ch Native Shore Brant.

**Wisconong:** Bill Hoard's kennel name was taken from Wisconsin (where he lived) and Koshkonog Lake where he hunted. He got his first Chesapeake in 1946-"Rink". His foundation bitch Willow Candace and Trigger from Phil Gagnon were also bought that year. He was the driving force in reviving the ACC in the 50's after the effects of WW II. He brought back the Chesapeake FT Specialty; encouraged the bench people to enter more shows to promote the breed. He started the ACC Bulletin to develop interest in the club-improving on the newsletter format of Arthur Storz. He served as president of the ACC for three terms.

He made a FC/AFC out of his Trigger-FC/AFC Deerwood Trigger, a deadgrass male rugged in build with a lovely disposition. Trigger was a tough competitor on the mid-west FT circuits. Today the traces back to Wisconong dogs have faded out except for the influence behind The Big Fellow \*\*\* of John Lundy.

## Keeping The Breed In The Public Eye

However, it was the efforts of two men in the 1940's who keep the CBR in the public eye- Ferdinand Bunte and Arthur C Storz. Both men were avid sportsman and well off business men who loved the breed. They promoted the Chesapeake to sportsman and often hunted together. They cherished the dogs for their natural hunting talent and bred them with this foremost in mind.

**Ferdinand Bunte** was the president of the ACC from 1947 to 1949. He and Art Storz were hunting partners living in the Mid-West. Bunte was a candy maker from the Chicago who loved all things to do with guns and dogs. The bulk of the kennel's breeding and fame was made in the 1940's. On his Springcrest farm in Genoa City, WI he bred Chesapeakes using "Cocoa" in the name of his dogs. He and his wife titled dogs in conformation but the sport of FT quickly grabbed his interest. His dog Ch The Second Cocoa \*\*\* , a son of Bunte's foundation bitch Lady King headed the kennel. "Coke" as he was called was a star performer in the field and was trained by Charles Morgan. William Brown considered him one of the retriever immortals. He was a consistent performer and often run by Mr. Bunte in Amateur stakes. A consistent performer, he won 2 all-breed Amateur stakes; 4 seconds and 2 fourths for a total of 23 amateur pts. Ferd Bunte was active in the Midwest FT club and formed the short lived Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club of the Central States.


**Arthur C Storz** owned a brewery in Omaha Nebraska- Storz beer. He often used his dogs in his beer advertisements. In 1949 he became president of the ACC. Like Bunte his real love was hunting. His Ducklore Lodge on the North Platte was one of the best waterfowl places in the Mid-West. Many well-known person spent a week or more hunting at his lodge. He promoted the breed as a hunting dog and never competed in FT or conformation events. He saw the Chesapeake's hunting instincts as its strongest asset. He started a newsletter which in the 50's under Bill Hoard, Jr. became the ACC Bulletin.

# ACC Bulletin Guidelines

## General Information

- Send **ALL** submissions to the appropriate Contributing Editor (CE) listed on the inside cover of the Bulletin. They will compile, edit, and send your material to the Managing Editor.
- Submissions are preferred by e-mail if possible but are also accepted by postal services.
  - **ALL** submissions **MUST** be typed.
  - When typing your submission – keep it simple. **DO NOT** add extra spaces between sentences, or use the “Tab” key to create columns, or add special formatting or characters to your text.
- When sending Express Mail, Federal Express, UPS, DHL, etc., make certain that you check the waive the signature required box.

## Calendar of Events Submission Deadlines

- Please think ahead when submitting an event to appear in the *Bulletin* Calendar of Events. While your event can be added to the ACC website almost immediately, the print schedule for the *Bulletin* is quite different and requires a minimum 2-month lead time, ideally 4-months is preferred.

## Material Submission Deadlines

## Obituary Submissions

- Members are entitled to submit one photo and write-up, not to exceed 250 words. Obituaries are printed on a “space available” basis.

## New Title Submissions

- Members are entitled to submit one photo and short write-up, limited to 250 words, per dog, per issue. Multiple new titles may be included under a single heading. The only exception will be if the multiple new titles are earned across at least two or more disciplines. For example a new title is earned in conformation, hunting, and agility. In this case, two photos may be accepted and word limit is increased to 350.
- Submissions should include: a Photo, Full name of dog, Sire X Dam, Breeder/Owner /Handler, Name of the Event / Date / Location the Title was finished, add a little tidbit about the accomplishment too.
- Claims of national rankings **MUST** include the name of the publication in which the ranking appeared and the date it was published to be included (e.g. Dog News, June 5, 2007).
- All reports or brags claiming titles where those titles are not AKC titles and the title replicates an AKC title (e.g. CH – Champion; CD – Companion Dog; MH – Master Hunter, etc. ) – **MUST** list the registries under which they were won. For example: CKC CH; UKC CH; Int. CH; ASCA CD; CKC MH; CKC FC, etc. If the same title is won under multiple registries it should appear as: AKC/CKC/Int. CH.
- All reports or brags claiming BIS, MBIS, MBISS, Group wins, Multiple Group wins, etc. where those wins are not AKC wins – **MUST** list the registries under which they were won. Examples: Multiple Canadian (or CKC) BIS Winner; Multiple UKC BIS Winner; Int. BIS Winner; etc. If that same dog has also won AKC BIS, Group Placements, etc., then the listing should appear as: multiple AKC/CKC BIS Winner; et al.
- If you have a question how to report a title or win, please contact the appropriate CE for guidance.
- Submission must be made by the owner, co-owner, or breeder who must be a current ACC member in good standing. Submissions by breeders who are not owners of record must include the owner’s written permission.

## Supported Entry and Event Result Submissions

- Supported Entry or Event results should include:
  - Name of Show/Event, Date(s), City and State (and/or Country), Judge(s), and Actual Entry numbers.
  - For Supported Entry Show News, results should include wins: BOB, BOW, BOS, Select Dog, Select Bitch, WD, WB, RWD, and RWB, and if offered, Best Veteran and Best Opposite Veteran.
  - For any other ACC sponsored events (agility, tracking, WDXQ, hunt tests, field trials, CAT, etc.) include only passing or qualifying results for Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
  - All major wins, passes, or qualifiers should include dog's full registered name, call name, owner names, and breeder or handler names if available.
  - Event chair write up/summaries should be limited to 500 words.

## Show News Photos

- Due to limited space, only New Titles, BIS, Group placements or Supported Entry wins (as listed above) will be published. If the dog has had several wins that you would like reported in the same Bulletin, please send in only one photo with text (250 word limit) that includes all accomplishments.

## Puppy / Stud / Older Dog Submissions

Current ACC members in good standing may place classified advertising according to the Classified Ad guidelines printed in the *Bulletin*.

- Please use the following format for your submission:
  - (**your 2-letter state abbreviation**) **YOUR DOG'S NAME**, health clearances, (Sire [sire's health clearances] x Dam [dam's health clearances]). Web: *your-web-address.com*
  - Ads **MUST** be typed and are **ONLY** accepted from ACC Members in good standing.
  - Payment for Puppy, Stud Dog, Older Dog ads **MUST** be received with the ad submittal. Please limit ads to necessary information as space is limited.
  - Please make all check or money orders payable to the American Chesapeake Club. Do not send cash. All payments must be made in U.S. funds.

## Photo Submissions

Only photos submitted by the owner(s), co-owner(s), or breeder(s) who are current ACC members in good standing shall be published. Submissions by breeders who are not owners of record must include permission from the owner or co-owner of record prior to the submission deadline for the current issue.

- **For ALL Photo Submissions** - If a photographer requires that you provide their name in order to publish their work, be certain to include a photo credit with your submission copy.

## For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions by E-Mail

- Send the photos as an ATTACHMENT, not in the body of the e-mail or other document.
- Good quality photo images of 300dpi AND minimal image size of 8" x 10", are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*.
- Proper resolution and size will create a JPEG image file size of greater than 1 MB. If your file size is significantly smaller than 900 KB or 1 MB, then it probably is not 300 dpi or the correct image size and will not be usable.
- Check the settings on your camera / mobile device before taking pictures. There should be a settings feature allowing you to adjust the resolution/pixels; choose the highest setting for best print production. For example: 2400 x 3000 pixels/inch (converts to 300dpi for an 8" x 10" photo).
- Some digital cameras/devices create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. **This is OK.** Just send the unedited file as is. The larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.
- Please **DO NOT** crop or edit your images – that will be done for you. Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.
- If you are scanning a hard copy of a photo, please check your scanner settings for proper resolution and image size, and make certain that you clean your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning.

If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan.

Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.

## For "Hard Copy" Photo Submissions

- Send a good quality photo, preferably 8" x 10" size. Include an appropriate sized, self-addressed, stamped envelope if you would like your photo returned. Please do not send cash or check for return postage.
- Labeling on the back of the photo is very helpful.
- Include a typed small caption/write up. If possible send the caption via e-mail as well. That way it's just a cut and paste rather needing to be retyped for transmission to the editor.
- Please DO NOT submit digital photos that are printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer as all of the passes made by your print head will appear on the photo when scanned. Such scans are not useable.
- If you are not using a photo mailer, please include a cardboard backing to help prevent bending of the photo.
- If you haven't received a photo back after the *Bulletin* it appeared in comes out, please contact the CE that you sent it to.

On December 1<sup>st</sup> the AKC will be changing the Obedience rules and regulations. New classes and titles will be offered and the "pre" classes will now be the "preferred" classes. ## Health Database Update Information Is Your Dog Listed?

Make sure your dog is included in our new Health Database! The Electronics Communications Committee (ECC) has started organizing some out-dated existing Health Databases and we need your help. The ACC already receives quarterly reports from OFA which contain results of tests that CBR owners have submitted (with a fee) to be published on the OFA website. The OFA certifies Hips, Elbows, Cardiac, Thyroid, Shoulder, Patella, OFA Eye Registry and are now including Degenerative Myelopathy (DM) and they list CERF. Our other Databases that we are compiling will include Collapse (EIC), Long Coat (LC), and Progressive Retinal Atrophy (PRA). Two of these tests, EDSF and LC, are newer so we are just starting our lists for these.

What we would like to receive are the results for all CBRs of the above tests, along with certification of some sort, to be sent (email preferred) to Deb Rivas, at HealthClearances@amchessieclub.org. Send ONLY those results that are NOT on the OFA database as those we already have. Any tests done by other companies (not OFA) in the US and other countries is what are needed so we have complete information. It is important for our breed to have as many results compiled as possible to track these diseases/clearances for safeguarding our breed and for better breeding decisions to be made. This is a huge undertaking by the ECC and it will take some time to compile. Please email any information/questions to Deb Rivas. All of the completed Databases will be made available to ACC members in the future on the ACC Website. Thank you for your assistance in keeping our databases as up to date as possible.


## Canadian Master Hunter

## “Goose” Flying D's Aleutian Goose (New Hope's Blazing Sun X Yakity's





## **Karen Anderson (CA) & Her Wonderful Rescue Chesapeake, Sweet Pea**

Karen became interested in Chesapeakes from talking to friends and learning the breed attributes, loyal, intelligent, active, and water dogs. She is a water person. She then researched the breed. She felt strongly about animals in shelters and decided to rescue one instead of buying a puppy. She found the American Chesapeake Club rescue site and there was Sweet Pea smiling at her. Love at first sight. BUT Karen couldn't get a dog until she retired. She tried not to think about Sweet Pea all that time, sure that the pup would be adopted before Karen was ready. Then the day came to find a dog. And there was Sweet Pea waiting for her. Sweet Pea's foster mother, Ann Haley, was very particular about who was going to get this dear three-legged dog.

Sweet Pea was found abandoned in the woods in Colorado. After surviving the winter she weighed only 30 lbs. and had a severe injury to her right front leg. Sweet Pea was to be euthanized before American Chesapeake Charitable Trust and Ann Haley stepped in to take on the medical expenses. The vet tried to save the leg, but finally had to amputate it. Ann nursed Sweet Pea back to health while she and her son helped Sweet Pea learn to trust humans again. Karen adopted a three legged Chesapeake that had been badly abused and was terrified of strangers. Karen brought her home to San Diego, California and began her rehabilitation, by taking her everywhere and having everyone give her treats. Sweet Pea was very defensive with other dogs, and totally petrified of the water. She would only look at the lapping surf, refusing all attempts to get her in. Karen began taking her to Fiesta Island, a large dog friendly park, surrounded by water, where Sweet Pea began to make dog friends and learned she could play with these new buddies without getting hurt.

One day, while in a game of chase, she totally forgot her fear of the water and ran in the shallow bay. She leaped out when she realized what she had done. But, the fear was conquered. She began leaping in the water and enjoying it, even going into the ocean waves at Coronado Island. After all, she is a Chesapeake. Sweet Pea still won't go in over her head, but a dog with three legs has a disadvantage. Karen is thrilled that her dog had made such giant progress.

Karen alternates her activities to balance her physical abilities. One day, she runs, another at Dog Beach, a play day with a friend, throwing the ball in the yard with one or two days off. Sweet Pea knows herself when she needs to stop and rest. She needs to keep her good leg strong by working it.

Sweet Pea has begun a fairly new dog sport, Nose Work. This is much like the search dogs who find drugs and bombs, but with odors of birch, anise and clove. The perfect sport for a dog with three legs, and she loves it. This is one area she can compete with all the four legged canines.

Karen has to challenge Sweet Pea's brain as well as her body. She works her with Rally signs and obedience commands. As Sweet Pea becomes more comfortable with strangers, and has more control of her fears, Karen plans to see if she could become a therapy dog in the future.

From death row, to a happy giving Chesapeake, Sweet Pea has found a forever home with Karen Anderson.

It features the Chesapeake "greats" Dual CH Sodak's Gypsy Prince and his grand-daughter FC Shagwong Gypsy. All Proceeds are donated to ACC Health and Rescue.

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacroft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacroft Baron \*\*\*.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


