Open Commentary

The Open started with thirty six dogs at 8:30 Tuesday morning. It was a beautiful morning, blue sky, 70 degrees. First series was a triple, one retired – left bird thrown first, middle gun thrown second then retired flyer shot on the right in the corner. The first bird down had a large electric tower near it that made it a challenge. The dogs did remarkably well and twenty seven were called back.

The second series was a land blind and it was run from the same mat as the first series. The line was over the retired middle gun, about 324 yards, up a slanted hill with a lot of cut strips, very challenging. This created a lot of havoc for the dogs, but the judges were very generous and called back twenty two dogs.

The third series water blind was run first thing Wednesday morning. It was a very challenging blind, run off a hill, through trees with sticks placed on line, over two points on the opposite shore. This separated the wheat from the chaff! Ten dogs were called back for the last test.

The fourth series was a triple with the long bird on the right down first about 360 yards, second bird thrown left to right, pinching the long bird about 238 yards. The flyer was shot from left. Long bird retired, middle bird had a piece of water between the line and the bird. A very challenging test, only 3 dogs did not handle. Thank you judges Ron Ainley and Dennis Bath for your time and congratulations to all the finishers!

Qualifying Commentary

The Qualifying started Tuesday morning with a strong field of 40 dogs. The judges, Mary Howley and Martha Blank, began the first series with a wide triple set-up in a field with heavy cover and scattered round hay bales. The field sloped down in the center and to the right. The first mark was the left bird thrown left to right between hay bales at 165 yards. The second mark was the center bird thrown right to left. The bird was thrown over a hay bale landing at 210 yards in a swallow area of the field, challenging most dogs. The third bird was a flyer that was thrown left to right, angling back and landing in heavy grass cover at 100 yards. Twenty seven dogs were called back.

The second series immediately followed the first series' marks and consisted of a land blind. The line to the blind was a slot blind off of a hill and through multiple hay bales with the bird placed directly in front of a bale at 175 yards. The challenge was keeping the dogs from behind the bales. Twenty dogs were called back.

The third series entailed a water blind that was set-up on a pond with a 35-yard slight angle entry and a 20-yard swim. Following this swim, the dog had to cross a point and re-enter for an addition 25-yard swim. The dog had to exit the water and push up on land for 35 yards crossing a strip of tall grass. The bird was placed at the edge of a cover change.

The fourth series was an indented triple with the left bird thrown first at 175 yards, right to left. The second bird was the middle and indented thrown right to left at 60-yards, landing on a point. The third bird was thrown right to left deep of the middle bird. This mark had three water entries if the correct line was taken. The first bird thrown was the most challenging because the dog had to swim by an area of an old fall, on the point.

Overall, the field was very strong with 15 dogs finishing all four series. Michael Moscovitz, and his dog Sam, performed the best over the 2-day trial awarding him first place.

The Amateur stake started (with 52 dogs running) in a large hay field bordered on the far left by cut corn. The judges, Phil Heye and Dick Dallasassee, began with a wide open triple. A long middle bird, 250 yards distant, was thrown angled back to the right. To the right, at 90 yards, a second gunner shot, threw sharply angled back to the left and then immediately retired. A live flyer, shot to the right into the corn at a distance of 175 yards, completed the test. Early dogs had some difficulty picking out gun stations and seeing birds. The requirement for the dogs to swing to the right and then back to the left also caused problems. In general, however, the dogs did well on this test, and 40 of the 50 starters were called back to the second series.

The second series test was a single land blind, run in the same general location as the first series marks. The bird was planted in the cut corn behind the flyer station at a distance of 250 yards. The dogs ran down a small hill, disappearing briefly. They were then required to negotiate a strip of cover which ran between a field road and large group of trees. Finally, they had to deal with the cut corn and nearby flyer station. This blind proved to be challenging for dogs and handlers alike. A good initial line was hard to obtain, and several dogs were lost when they disappeared into the trees. Other dogs had difficulty locating the bird in the corn, resulting in a rough ending. Twenty-nine dogs survived this series and were called back to the run the third series, a single water blind.

The water blind was run on a pond at north end of the grounds. The correct line angled into the water at a distance of 40 yards. Once in the water, dogs swam 60 yards to the tip of a point which protruded from the right. A lone gunner, sitting in a chair, was stationed on a second point which protruded from the left. After beaching on the right-hand point, the dogs were required to cast off and swim to a far shoreline. Although the total length of this blind was relatively modest (about 150 yards), it proved to be quite difficult. The gunner on the point tempted several dogs to avoid the water altogether. Other dogs entered "fat" requiring many early whistles. Several dogs made it to the point only to disappear around the backside, while others went out of control, perhaps because of accumulating drag-back scent. In all, 13 dogs were called to run the fourth series water marks.

Derby Commentary

The Derby started with seventeen dogs Wednesday late morning after the completion of the Qualifying. Judges Mary Howley and Martha Blank set up a nice land double next to the water where the Qualifying completed their 4th series. The memory bird was thrown 170 yards out. The go bird was a live flyer along a woods line at 100+yds. Most dogs did well, although many hooked the memory bird. Fourteen dogs were called back to the second series.

Series two had a long bird across a pond and a shorter bird thrown onto a point half the distance of the long memory bird. A few fast young dogs blew over the point and ended up in trouble. Others caved back into the point on the way to the memory bird. Ten dogs were called back to the 3rd series.

Series three started 8:00 AM Thursday morning in a hilly, tall grass field. The first bird was thrown up a hill at 175 yards. The dogs ran down hill through tall grass disappearing in a ravine before reappearing and running up the hill. The go bird was 110 yards out thrown from the woods into tall grass. Several dogs had long hunts on one or both birds. Seven dogs were called back to the 4th series.

The fourth series began with a bird thrown directly across a large pond on a hillside in heavy cover. The go bird was 90 degrees to the left and most dogs did not have a problem with it. Several dogs caved into an island which was to the left of the line on the way across the pond to the long memory bird. Other dogs ran straight to the gunner after exiting the pond and then had some longer hunts. Six dogs completed the test.

The land series consisted of back to back singles. First mark had the gunner straight ahead about 50 yards in a mowed hay field. The bird was thrown from left to right and landed behind a very thin strip of cover. The second mark found the gunner at right angle to the first mark. It was about 75 yards and was thrown left to right and landed in short grass.

Then the action moved to the water with another set of back to back singles. For the first mark, the gunner sat on left hand shore throwing left to right. The bird landed out in water giving the pups a 50 yard swim. For the second mark, the gunner on point straight ahead. The bird was thrown right to left and landed in water 75 yards from the line.

All five puppies completed their marks and were awarded ribbons. We look forward to seeing these youngsters as they grow up and run with the big dogs!!

The water marks were thrown in the same pond used for the water blind. The test consisted of a triple, with a long retired "punch" bird and shot flyer. The retired bird on the left side of the test was thrown sharply angled back to the left at a distance of nearly 300 yards. This was

followed by a dead bird in the middle of the test, thrown flat and to the right at 250 yards. The flyer was positioned on the right side of the test and was shot to the right at a distance of 175 yards. The test was relatively wide open, but the distances, terrain, and water provided numerous challenges. The retired bird, which concluded with a long (about 150 yards) swim across open

water, was especially difficult and resulted in several handles. A number of dogs had large hunts on one or more birds, including the flyer. All were required to honor the next working dog, raising the stakes for those who had completed the test. In the end, 12 dogs successfully completed this demanding series of tests and were awarded a placement or JAM.

Working Dog Test – Aug 29, 2015 - Tappernøje mDenmark

The test was held in an area also used in earlier years for WD/X/Q tests and we are very happy that Iver S. Hansen let us use his hunting ground. We had 25 dogs entered in all three classes. 19 starters in WD with 13 passing. 17 starters in WDX with 6 passes. 3 starters in WDQ with 0 passed. The area, which we have used before was a bit different this year, because of heavy rain and high temperatures the last 3 weeks before the test, the grass had been growing a bit high on the WDX and WDQ area, so this years test was not an easy task for the dogs... which also the results for the WDX and Q shows. A Legend in the Breed

November 2, 1940 – October 2, 2015

Legendary as an Obedience Competitor, Coach, and Chesapeake Mentor... Sue was a long-time member of the ACC and actively participated in many club functions, committees and trials. She earned the AKC's Outstanding Sportsmanship award in 2008. She was active on the ACC Health Committee. She was also the club's liaison to the National Animal Interest Alliance, and she worked tirelessly on legislative issues.

Over a period of 40 years, she served on the Board of Directors, the ACC Show Committee, the Companion Events Committee, and was obedience chair or co-chair at numerous National Specialties. She put bench and field titles on several of her dogs. In 1974 she purchased her first Chesapeake, CH Eastern Waters' Betsy Ross, UD. Her real love was obedience. Sue earned the first OTCH in the breed and went on to earn a total of 4 OTCHs—a record that stands today. And until her health got the better of her, she was training her last Chesapeake, Hannah — UOCH UUDX Longmeadow Susquehanna UDX3 OM4 VER.

Remembering Sue Cone

It's hard to put into words what a wonderful person Sue Cone was. The first time I met her we became instant friends, and she immediately took me under her wing. That's the type of person Sue was. She was always there to reach out and help people. She was one of the most giving persons I have ever met. If it wasn't for Sue I would have never gotten into competition obedience or performance events or have volunteered for the ACC.

We had so many great times. Several weeks ago I was cleaning my garage and found a dumbbell with her name on it. I have no idea how it got there, but I will treasure it forever. We always laughed about our Purina Photo Shoot in Rhode Island off the jetties. We called it our Acapulco Cliff diving shoot. Besides her love for Chesapeakes, Sue loved to watch figure skating, and together we enjoyed many shows.

It was wonderful sharing all these great moments with Sue. The breed has come such a long way in performance events, health issues, and legislation thanks to Sue. She will be sincerely missed. Not a day goes by that I don't hear her or think of her. - Joanne Silver

I met Sue when I got my first Chesapeake — way back in 1983, we had littermates and we soon became fast friends. I was new to the breed and new to obedience and she was a wealth of information. She had been in the breed far longer than me, and she was my go-to person for information about individual dogs, performance lines, health — pretty much anything related to

dogs in general and Chesapeakes in particular.

In the final months of her life, we grew closer. We both knew she didn't have much time. Despite her illness, she took a profound interest in a litter of puppies whelped by my bitch at my breeder's kennel — wanting to know how the whelping went, how the pups were progressing every week, and which one I was going to take home. She always wanted to see the little puppy I took home — but her health declined to the point that it just wasn't possible.

I have many fond memories of meeting her off-site at specialties and shows — Sue armed with a full set of ring gating and jumps — ready for run-throughs and coaching to all who were interested. No charge of course, just expert advice and unlimited moral support. She was always available to help solve a training problem, coach you through a tough spot, share your elation after running a really nice class, or prop you up after a run that was really dismal.

Another wonderful memory — Sue coming for a visit to do some field work at my place on a beautiful summer day. After we were done, we sat in a big open field behind my house feasting on wild blueberries while all our dogs ran around sharing in the spoils. That's how I like to picture her now — surrounded by all the dogs she's owned and loved over the years. Rest well, my friend. - Jan Estes

In 1991 I qualified for the Gaines Regional Obedience competition in Pennsylvania with my first Chessie. Even then, the name Sue Cone meant “premier Chesapeake obedience competitor,” a position she maintained for the rest of her life. With my Chessie Millie in hand, I gathered my courage and introduced myself. Sue took me under her wing and taught me everything I could want to know about the Regionals. That day, at my first Regional, I made my first real Chesapeake friend.

Judges in several fields knew Sue and her Chessies. Even in the South, I could walk into an obedience ring and the judge would ask, “Do you know Sue Cone?” Yes, I did, and I always felt a little pressure to look good because I knew who had set that judge's expectations of what a Chessie could do!

Sue set the bar high in obedience for Chessies, but she was always willing to share her knowledge and help bring the rest of us along. She would patiently tutor through problems and multiple phone calls and always ended with “Keep it fun and have a Starbucks.” We both loved our Starbucks!

One of the things I will miss most is watching what I called Sue's beautiful “dance” with her Chessies. When they heeled in the ring, it was as if together they heard all the same notes in a melodic, graceful dance. I imagine and hope that for eternity Sue is reunited and dancing with her Chessies. - Valerie Farrell

I first met Sue at the 2008 NSS in Fitchburg, Massachusetts. I had just put Ranger away after Open B and had struck up a conversation with the woman whose crate was next to mine. Even though we didn't qualify, she said some very complimentary things about our work in the ring. Then she introduced herself— Sue Cone. I was awestruck. Here I was with my Novice A dog still trying to learn my way through the obedience world and I'm getting big compliments from the woman with four OTCHs!! Wow!!

Fast forward a year and a half or so... Ranger needs an Open B first to finish his OTCH title but I can't get him to do stays. Out of the blue, Sue became our biggest cheerleader, providing lots of welcome advice and encouragement. “You WILL get there,” was included in just about every e-mail! She was not going to let me give up. I really believe when we got the title, Sue was happier about it than I was. Just the fact that she took the time to help me, someone she only met once for two minutes, made me realize what a truly special person she was. I'm sure that everyone else she helped through the years would agree with me on that. - Bill Lane

In 1974, my parents told me they sold a puppy to a young woman and her family who previously owned a Labrador. They thought I would enjoy meeting her. That puppy became CH Eastern Waters' Betsy Ross, UD. Sue and I became good friends, for 40 years, and due to her own successes in obedience, she opened the world of competition obedience for me. When I had questions, she answered them for me. Before computers, we would be on the phone before 7:00 a.m.

We each earned a Dog World award on our Novice dogs. She introduced me to Gaines Regionals. We went to a Regional in Buffalo, NY and also showed in Canada together on a memorable trip where we stayed in the most beat-up, run-down old cabins with cold showers. I learned a new word, “sheveley,” that described those cabins. Our dogs had the opportunity to swim in Lake Ontario...

When e-mail became popular, we used that to stay in touch. She always had ideas for me when I was teaching an obedience class and wanted creative ways to train/proof. When I became an obedience judge, Sue would exhibit her Chesapeake. It was a joy to see the team work and heel together, while I had the privilege of judging them.

Once we moved to Virginia, we saw each other less, but anytime I judged in New Jersey Sue and her dog would be there. We still e-mailed, but I would call and Sue would solve problems and present innovative concepts. She was a font of knowledge and her four OTCH Chesapeakes prove that.

At the NSS in Carlisle, PA in 2011, she told me that this would be the last time she would exhibit at a National. I was surprised -- and yes, she had some health problems, but she still had Hannah, and I thought she would go on forever.

It was not all about the dogs... Sue “gifted” friends and family with counted cross-stitch ornaments, but my favorite piece is a framed saying over my sink that says “I'd Rather Be Dog Showing” - Betsy Horn Humer

American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

OBJECTIVE

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is given to an individual who has made significant contributions to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed / the people who own them through outstanding leadership / advancement of knowledge / understanding.

ELIGIBILITY

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes personal achievement / its positive impact on the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed. The award may be given to any individual independent of specific institutional affiliation with the American Chesapeake Club or other organizations.

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is not an annual award. The awards selection committee may decide not to make any awards selection in a given year or may decide to bestow multiple awards. The number / frequency of award selection is strictly at the discretion of the awards selection committee.

Nominations may be submitted by organizations or individuals, including the nominees themselves.

AWARDS CRITERIA

Nominees are judged by the originality, vision, breadth, / impact of the entire body of their work. Candidate selection must go beyond mere name recognition / reputation. A nominee's work is evaluated in such areas as:

- A strong / well-documented commitment to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed.
- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacroft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacroft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter – a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


