

# On the Cover

## New Amateur Field Champion AFC CH Fireweed's Poison Ivy

(CH Crackshot Ben There Done That QA2 JH x DC AFC Genny's Yakity Yak Don't Talk Back MH)

Time flies when you're having fun.

In 1985 I got my first Chesapeake from Shirli Hayes and met my wife, Sharon Walen. Pike became AFC Foxridge's Riddley Walker. Sharon then conspired with Linda Harger in 2008 to surprise me with a pup out of CH Crackshot Ben There Done That and DC AFC Genny's Yakity Yak Don't Talk Back MH. We named her Fireweed's Poison Ivy (Ivy), and she has truly been a joy. She first retrieved at a licensed trial at five months of age, when a water test needed a pickup dog, and we have gone on from there.

Field trials did not get easier during the intervening years, so Linda encouraged an absolutely solid foundation for Ivy's development. Jeff Weber started her formal training in Idaho, and I then sent her to Jerry and Jane Patopea of Utopia Retriever Kennel

in Oregon. Jerry's basics, transition, and advanced work have been instrumental in both Ivy's achievement and my own learning, together with continued support from both Sharon and Linda.

Ivy's years have generally been divided into winter/spring training time with Jerry, summer months training at home with Diane Mazy and others, and fall/winter months at home for hunting. Between Jerry, Linda, and myself, we have generally run trials from February through September. Championship

points have gradually accrued and have been shared—five Open points to Jerry, five to Linda with her 2015 ACC Specialty Open win, and one to me; two Amateur points to Linda and 11, including two wins, to me. Ivy has also qualified for and competed in two Nationals (the 2014 Amateur and the 2015 Open), she has earned two qualifying scores towards a Master Hunter title, and she earned her bench championship in October of 2014.

I am enormously thankful for the people and factors in Ivy's success—in largest measure Jerry's foundation

and training knowledge, Linda's breeding development and all-around support, and Sharon's encouragement under the difficulty of Ivy's training absences. Ivy is a wonderful example of the kind of dog enjoyed by Chesapeake lovers—a retrieving nut who is bright, attentive, eager to please, physically sound and good-looking, and endowed with her own individual spirit. She's a real treat.

# Field Trial Report

## Perpetual Trophy Recipients of 2015

All of the trophies listed below are the property of the American Chesapeake Club and may not become the property of any individual. The trophies are awarded annually to members of the American Chesapeake Club. (Historical notes are from the May/June, 1996 ACC Bulletin.) The winners of the ACC perpetual trophies for field trial accomplishments in 2015 are as follows:

### FC AFC CFC Nelgard's Baron CD Trophy:

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake of an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. Walter S. Heller and was first awarded in 1963. **Winner: AFC CH Fireweed's Poison Ivy** owned by Brett Crow & Sharon Walen.

### DC AFC Mount Joy's Mallard Trophy:

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Amateur competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. E. C. Fleishman and was first awarded in 1962. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll I** owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

**CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966. **Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll I** owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

### DC AFC Tigers' Cub CD Memorial Trophy:

Awarded annually to the amateur handler whose Chesapeake earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open and Amateur competition. (The Open points must be earned by an amateur handler.) The trophy was donated to the ACC by Eloise Cherry in 1979 in memory of her dog Tiger's Cub. **Winner: Linda Harger.**

**FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner: Chugach's Thumping Jago MH QA2** owned by Mike Vogel.

### FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy:

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most

points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winners: Oakhill Chesbay Hank** owned by Tim Carrion; **Grand Oak's Packin A Pistol SH** owned by Tom & Dawn Lind.

**The Louis Traung Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.)

**Winner: Gunpowder's Cayuse Clipper JH** owned by Jody Smith.

### FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa

**Chief Trophy:** Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Derby competition in the Central and Eastern Time zones. The trophy was donated by Alex Spear in memory of his dog Chip. **Winners: Oakhill Chesbay Hank** owned by Tim Carrion; **Grand Oak's Packin A Pistol SH** owned by Tom & Dawn Lind.

Please join us for the 2016 American Chesapeake Club Field Trial Specialty near Ronan, MT. Located in the Mission Valley area of Western Montana, Ronan offers great scenery along with great places to run dogs. The trial will be held on some of the same grounds as the 2015 National Amateur Retriever Championship. There are many attractions in the area including the National Bison Range and Flathead Lake nearby, and Glacier National Park a couple hours north. 

All the Chessie's and their people who were there competing in the different events stopped by to hang out, show off ribbons and eat the treats we had.




