

Other Titling Events

The AKC has instituted a Title Recognition Program that allows an owner to apply to have a title from a different registry recorded on their dogs' AKC records. Once approved, the title can then be displayed on the dog's pedigree and other AKC documents. Currently other registry titles that are being recognized by the AKC are:

- Barn Hunt
- Dock Diving
- Flyball
- Parent & Working Dog titles*
- Search and Rescue titles
- CGC / Therapy Dog titles

We will be highlighting these titles/events, as well as more traditionally recognized AKC titles, as space permits in upcoming Bulletins.

*The AKC does not recognize any parent club and/or working dog title that is similar to an event already offered by the AKC, in whole or in part.



Barn Hunt

Barn Hunt is a fairly new sport that is becoming quite popular throughout the dog community. The sport is based on the role that dogs played in riding farms, homes and barns/ storage areas of vermin. All breeds of dogs, including mixed, are eligible and are asked to find a rat that is safely hidden in an aerated plastic tube amongst hay bales. The dogs must climb on bales with all 4 feet, and go through an 18" wide tunnel made of bales, alerting the handler when a rat is found.

The course is timed, with the time limit and number of rat finds and decoys varying, dependent on the level at which the dog is competing.

Each "hunt" is divided into 3 dog height divisions. Trials can be held indoors or outdoors as long as the ring is securely fenced. In order to compete for titles a dog must be

registered with The Barn Hunt Association. However there are many clinics and workshops around that don't require the dog to be registered with BHA in order to give Barn Hunt a try.



Live rats are used but they have been well acclimated to the environment and their wranglers say they are pets first and foremost and seem to like the game as much as the dogs do.

This is a low impact sport so it is something that even older dogs and dogs with some physical limitations can play in. Dogs that are deaf, partially blind

and tripods – within specific guidelines – are eligible to compete.

Then to Minnedosa, Manitoba for those full colored mallards and Canadas in October, all the time hunting in Iowa when not on the road! We spent the end of the season in Arkansas where I lease a rice field by Jonesboro and hunt with great friends at the Bayou Metro Double D.



Now is the part where I feel I am being big headed: harvest totals for Ike – retrieves this year are 298 ducks, 62 Canadas, 37 snows (2015 snows 173, but we had a tough snow year this year) and 22



whitefronts! When I said I was living the dream I meant it but when it is all said and done, isn't that what our dogs were bred for! All the best!





Yogi and Phil went into the gundog group and were pulled out for the final look. The Gordon Setter won the group and then the well respected judge, Mrs D. Arrowsmith, pointed to Yogi for Group 2 (which is known in the UK as Reserve Best in Group)! Every Chesapeake person on every continent who was watching on live TV went crazy!! This is the first time that a Chesapeake has won a Group 2 at a Championship show, and to do so at the world’s biggest show was just unbelievable . . . as you could tell from the expression on Phil’s face!

*In Memory of Nancy Dougall Lowenthal
August 1, 1923 - March 17, 2016*

Nancy Lowenthal, cherished mother, grandmother, friend, and nationally acclaimed animal trainer-breeder, died peacefully in her sleep in her Mill Valley home on March 17. She was 92.

Born in San Francisco in 1923, to William and Hazel Dougall, Nancy married Les Lowenthal in 1942, just 19 days before he entered the Army Air Corps during WWII. Fortunately

Les was stationed stateside because she was not about to be separated from the love of her life. While the Army actively tried to discourage wives from following their husbands, Nancy did just that, following Les from post to post across the country, picking up work in each new city she found herself. From telephone operator to civilian truck driver for the Army, she was determined to stay close to her man. They enjoyed a storied marriage and a great partnership for 60 years. Les passed away in 2003.

Nancy had an active social life and many good friends but it is safe to say that her animals were her favored companions. She learned to ride horses in Golden Gate Park as a young child and became a skilled horsewoman and formidable trainer who co-founded the Southern Marin Horseman's Association.

Nancy's father brought the first Chesapeake Bay Retrievers to California. From childhood on, Chesapeakes were always by Nancy's side. She became a legendary dog trainer and breeder (Berteleda Kennels). She had two of the first Champion UD bitches in our breed. Nancy was instrumental in the west coast expansion of the American Chesapeake Club and published several articles on the breed. She also established the West Coast Chesapeake Bay Retriever Rescue

service with her husband. In 2002, she and Les received the American Chesapeake Club Lifetime Achievement Award. She and Les were also two of the first Regional Directors for our club.

Nancy and Les practiced an open door policy in their home in Mill Valley and their vacation home on the Smith River. Whether it was managing your marriage, raising children, dogs, or horses, Nancy was an endless source of sensible advice and support. Years later, friends still recount how her wisdom altered their lives for the better. Passionate and determined, if Nancy saw a need she would fill it. She truly was a great woman loved by many. She is missed by all who knew her. Nancy and Les taught so many of the California crew that supporting the breed came before personal goals with our own dogs. They showed us by example that hard work in every dog event was good not only for a successful outcome at a Chesapeake day or show event or field trial, it was good for the breed.



Her last Chesapeake was a beloved rescue dog found for her by Camille Drugé. Constant companions, her rescue dog passed away two weeks before Nancy.

Nancy is survived by her three sons and daughters-in-law and six grandchildren. “Jill” ADCH-Platinum PDCH MACH4 Rippling Waters Jill AGD-B AKD-B AJD-S PTM-B, TQ2 MXC MJC MFB T2B4 (CH Rippling Waters Purple Haze MH X CH Rippling Waters BB MH), finished the 2015-16 agility season with several “Firsts” for Chesapeake Bay Retrievers. At only six years old, she has finished her fourth AKC Master Agility Championship (MACH4), and her fifth USDAA Agility Dog Championship (Platinum ADCH). In AKC Jill is also the first to complete a second Triple-Q title (TQ2), two Century titles in Master Standard and Jumpers (MXC and MJC), and a fourth Time-to-Beat title (T2B4). In USDAA she split her competition time between the Championship and Performance divisions and still brought home two Championship Top Ten all-breed national ranking awards.



In October 2015, Jill competed at the Cynosport World Games (USDAA Nationals) in Murfreesboro TN, in the Performance division of the Grand Prix and Steeplechase tournaments and the Team event. In the Steeplechase she advanced from 7th

place in quarterfinals and finished 11th in the semifinal. In the Grand Prix event she placed 5th in the semifinal, earning a spot in her first ever National Grand Prix Final and finishing 5th. Jill partnered with Stuart Mah’s “Ares” in the Team event, which is a five-round competition for a two-dog team. Jill and Ares won the Team Relay final and finished Tenth overall out of 132 all-breed teams. Jill also placed Fourth in the Team Standard round.



Jill has exceeded all my dreams and expectations for a partner and companion. I’m continually amazed at her brilliance and athleticism. Thank you Jilly, for the incredible journey to the top. AKC Delegate's Report

While the AKC Delegate body does not meet until June, the AKC Board has been active in refining policies reviewing "proposed changes", passing Regulations and creating new games.

In the interest in clarifying the issue of Spaying and Neutering for state and local governments the AKC position is:

The American Kennel Club opposes laws that mandate the spaying /neutering of dogs. Spaying/ neutering are major surgeries and the decision to spay or neuter a dog should be made by the dog's owner in conjunction with their veterinarian. Recent scientific studies demonstrate the spaying/neutering, particularly before the dog is fully mature, may result in detrimental long-term health impacts. In light of this information, AKC encourages breeders, owners and veterinarians to consult on the appropriateness and timing of spaying or neutering an individual dog.

Proposals to "The Rules Applying to Dog Shows" involve: having Championship points awarded to Winners dog/bitch that earn second, third and fourth in group competition, closing times for electronic Conformation entries and Junior Showmanship Criteria. These proposals will be presented at the June or September meetings for a Delegate vote.

Effective July 1, 2016 The Board has approved the following changes to the Retriever Hunt Test Regulations: Clubs, at their option, may hold a Master-level only test for their 5th and 6th events of the year provided the club has held each test level at least once at their first 4 events that year. Clubs that hold a limited entry Master shall open their entries to the public on the Wednesday closest to 3 weeks prior to the first day of the event at 8pm Central time. The Board also added to Chapter 3 section 2: Only fresh birds may be used at the event.

Effective July 1, 2016 AKC has a new game, Farm Dog Certification. The objective of this new program is to promote training and responsible dog ownership for all dogs living in a rural environment and expose a new group to herding events. The certification events will be open to all dogs over 9 months of age and held in conjunction with AKC herding test/trials. 2 passes are required to earn the FDC suffix title.

I have always had dogs in my life and experienced a variety of breeds. A high school friend had a litter of Chesapeake puppies in the fall of 1990, and that was the beginning of my relationship between Chesapeakes and myself.

My first Chesapeake, Chico, was mainly a duck-hunting dog with little training, yet I enjoyed watching him use his natural ability of picking up ducks.

In the spring of 1991, I got my second Chesapeake, Beamer. I had both dogs for about a year. We mainly hunted ducks and partridge at my northern Minnesota cabin. I purchased numerous books and DVDs, and spent a lot of time learning how to train him. When Deuce was about two years old, I was introduced to hunt tests and started running him at entry level. He progressed through the different levels of these tests, yet when he reached Master level work, he was diagnosed with a neck issue that led to retiring him from competition.

Running hunt tests had allowed me to meet a large number of people who were involved in

training and were members of different hunt clubs. One of these contacts informed me of a breeding that was of high interest to me, and in January of 2013 I purchased Rudy's Chasing Minnesota Fatz. Using my previous training, Fatz progressed through Finished and Master Level Hunt Tests. I had attended my first Chesapeake Field Trial Specialty in the fall of 2012, as a spectator. CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

- Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.
