## Field Day at Hope Spring Farm (VA) – May 14, 2016



Three weeks of cold Virginia rain rendered Hope Springs Farm a swampy sea of mud; too wet to mow either fields or parking areas, and the weather didn't look promising as May 14 approached, the date of our ACC Field Day. In the 14 years I've hosted these, this much rain was unprecedented – would anyone even show up? Chesapeake folks are a hearty bunch, and a little mud and tall grass didn't deter anyone. Our day dawned sunny and bright, and our biggest yet group, over four dozen, began arriving early. They came with friends and family and all ages and stages of dogs, including a large group of promising young puppies, and all levels from the pups up to seasoned Master Hunters. There were total beginners who came to learn, novices wanting to learn more, through experienced campaigners, dog and human; some people even came without dogs. We dedicated this year's field day to Susan Sciarini, who'd passed away two weeks earlier. She'd attended regularly with her dogs in the early days; and even when her health problems kept her away, she and her husband, Michael, always sent a donation; including a generous one this year. The extra money always comes in handy for ducks. And we had ducks – lots of them. I'd made an 8-hour round trip two days before to ensure a plentiful supply.

After the meet and greet, handlers gathered to watch advanced dogs run a triple set up with a live shot flyer and blind retrieves, set up by local retriever professional Bobby Baldwin and his two birdboys. Beginners could see well trained retrievers at work, with an explanation of the training of specific skills needed. Then attendees got their dogs and were split into small groups according to skill levels for

individual, hands on help. This was the first year we had such a big puppy group – and there just isn't much better entertainment than watching the little guys with their first birds.

The puppies all showed great instinct and drive; and some showed outstanding talent for such a young group. Several look like they'll be ready for hunting or hunt tests by fall, notably Lorrie Johnson's Ariel, a natural at 4 months, and Ed Moore's pair of male pups, Rowdy and Cracker, not quite 4 months. And some Pond Hollow puppies looked keen, including Lois Wida's Galaxie, 4.5 mos., and a few other hotshots. And then there were those pups that, while they have great instincts, used them to put their owners on the spot: Joanne Silver's Cara Mia liked her duck so much she outran a group of pursuers out of the field and down the drive, fortunately stopping at Joanne's van where she finally let herself be captured. And of course, what would a field day be without the host being shamed? My Poltroon was the youngest participant at 12 weeks, but had been retrieving birds since six weeks. But for an audience, she put on a show, making it clear that while she loves retrieving and ducks, she's not anxious to give her duck back.

Other puppies included Gina Downin's Gudgeon, Val and Steve Jablonski's Chili, Cami McGlynn's Curly, Walt Taylor's Maggie, Nadia Anderson's Maddie, and Jane and Steve Barnum's Skipper. All ages of dogs new to field work,

and their handlers in the starter group: the Barnum's Magnolia, Valerie Vollmer's Wild Cherry, Ann Law's Dancer, Beverly Mathias's Doots, Lois Wida's Tempest, Linda Arpuzzo's Nellie, Maria Okolito and quite a few others. The beginner and puppy groups were capably aided by attendees with experience willing to pitch in, including Mel and Lex Phillips, Ann Law, Joanne Silver, Lynne Steppe, Valerie Vollmers, Mark Yacobucci and Michael Vaillaincourt, and of course the tireless enthusiasm and experience of Pat Puwal, who with husband Doug help me put the field day on every year. We couldn't do it without all the many volunteers; they make an event like this a success and we're fortunate to have so many willing to roll up their sleeves and pitch in. (Anyone I inadvertently left off, no slight intended and thank you!)

Dyane Baldwin of Pond Hollow is a regular at our field days, usually bringing one or more young dogs as well as people who've gotten pups from her. This year

she gave an informative and hands-on conformation presentation during the potluck lunch, explaining why proper Chesapeake



conformation is so important for the work our dogs are expected to do. She used attendees' dogs as examples, and there's no better education than putting your hands on the dogs. Written descriptions, photos and even videos are no substitution – everyone was appreciative of Dyane's time, expertise and willingness to answer questions and go over individual dogs. She'd done this a few years ago and it's a popular addition to our field day education we hope to continue.

After lunch, we scrambled to get some water work done as a storm rolled in. Some even continued training after the skies opened up – our 17<sup>th</sup> in a row.

# Companion Events

## Dock Diving

One of the fastest growing sports in the world of Companion Dog events is Dock Diving and what better time to look more closely at it than the dog days of summer!

Chesapeake Bay Retrievers are a natural for this sport and have been excelling at it since it came into being in the late 1990's. There are several different organizations that offer titles, although only NADD's distance jumping and air retrieve titles are recognized by the AKC at this time. Titles are earned by meeting a standard set by each of the organizations.

Below are some of the organizations that are available. These all offer titles in distance - distance jumped from the dock, and vertical - height jumped, although the rules on how they are achieved differ depending on the organization. A few of the organizations also offer a speed retrieve title and several titling games. Be sure to familiarize yourself with the rules of the organization that appeals to you the most.

Those who compete in Dock Diving with their Chesapeakes say it is a wonderful venue to trial a dog in. Not only do the dogs love the



game but the atmosphere is welcoming with competitors cheering each other on.

North American Diving Dogs (NADD) association distance and air retrieve titles. Titles earned through NADD include distance, air retrieve and vertical high jumping. NADD events are held throughout the US.

DockDogs offers competitions throughout the US, Canada, Europe and Australia. Titles can be earned in Big Air, Extreme Vertical and Speed Retrieve.

Ultimate Air Dogs (UAD) is affiliated with the UKC and offers events through the US in distance and vertical high jumping as well as several games.

Splash Dogs (SD) offers titles in distance and super vertical. At this time most of their events are held west of the Mississippi, their titles are recognized by UKC.

Here are a few tips on getting your CBR started in Dock Diving from several of our ACC members who title their dogs in various venues.

- Get your dog comfortable in the water before ever attempting any jumping.
- Work prey drive and retrieve first on land.
- Never push your dog off the dock, but rather "lure" them with a toy that you throw.
- As with all dog training activities, keep sessions short.
- For safety, only train one dog at a time.
- Ultimately you want to have the dog's take off

point as close to the edge of the dock as possible – much like a swimmer taking off from a block.

- You can train your dog for Dock Diving in a pool at a training facility, a lake or pond. Tidal areas aren't recommended because of the change in water level with the tides.
- To get your timing right when throwing the bumper practice at home throwing the bumper into a trashcan set out at the same distance you want it to land in the water.

Your entry would be greatly appreciated at Snake River Retriever Club, Soda Springs, ID Sep 23-25 (7.5 hrs south).





### Report from the Judge Bjarne Sorensen

I am quite proud to be invited to judge together with Claudia Breitgoff the first ever WDXQ test in Holland.

On Friday evening I had a seminar, together with Janet Morris from Wales, presenting the Chesapeake Bay Retriever, and it was 12 Dutch Show judges + breeders and owners. It is not often you have the possibility to present our lovely breed to that many Show judges. I presented the breed and the "problem" in different breed standards in different countries, (FCI Countries) which may be a problem and Janet presented different types of Chessies and it was very useful to see the difference in the breed. Thank you for the initiative. Well done.

Saturday was training, Claudia, and also Nellie Stevens who also worked as a student - judge at the test the day after. Lots of questions, some good training sessions and I think the handlers were pleased with the training.

Sunday morning started with bright sun... and very hot weather, but with a small breeze that proved to be very useful for the dogs when working. We saw a lot of dogs using the wind and nose to solve the task. Good markings, and getting near to the game the nose was "put on"! Nice work.

On the WD we had 31 dogs entered, 3 absent and 22 passed. Some young dogs failed just because inexperience, but I think they will be back the next time. Some excellent dogs and Best Dog in WD was: Adey May's Mannish Boy, Handler G. Bos.

Since this was the 45 year anniversary of the Dutch Club they were allowed to enter on the day for the WDX and the WDQ without any charge. That is nice done by the Club.

We had an entry of 22 dogs for the WDX and 7 passed. Best Dog WDX: Port West Mac Baron, Handler; H. Ijmker. On the WDQ we had an entry of 6 dogs and 3 passed this test. Best Dog WDQ: Dreamspirit Brave Buddha, Handler; E. Brouwer.

The fields and the water for the test was very good. Some handlers (and dogs) were a bit confused not being allowed to handle the dogs while working on the markings, but I think that has to do with the training. The WDXQ test was unknown to most handlers. The test ground had



**SE Chair Policy Change**

The ACC Board of Directors approved the following Motion which was submitted by the ACC Show Committee in June:

"To approve a two year (2017 & 2018) trial exception allowing the chairman of ACC Supported Entries to exhibit at a Supported Entry they chair with the following terms: Chair will be allowed to enter and show provided they submit a letter from the all-breed club with their supported entry application. The letter from the all-breed club should state that ACC SE Chair did not have any input on the judge selected for Chesapeake Bay Retrievers classes at the all-breed show. This exception does not apply to sweepstakes as the SE Chair does choose the sweepstakes judge."

As stated, this will apply for 2017 and 2018 Supported Entry shows. For those shows already approved for 2017, those chairman may submit their letter by September 30, 2016. Additionally, those persons wishing to submit an application for a supported entry to be considered for 2017 because of this change must submit those applications by September 30, 2016. Please feel free to contact the show committee with any questions you might have.

## AKC Delegate's Report June 2016

Two significant items were the main topics of discussion at the June 2015 AKC Delegates Meeting: Procedures for Disqualified (DQ) dogs and their reinstatement and the recent Retriever Hunt Test Regulation regarding "fresh birds".

Due to a recent event in which a DQ'd dog was applying for reinstatement at a show and injured a child, procedures for handling DQ and reinstatement have been enhanced:

- A list of all dogs that have been DQ'd over the last 5 years will be sent to superintendents and show secretaries and will be up dated on a regular basis. A new accident insurance policy to cover judges at AKC-approved events was taken out. This policy is in addition to the existing AKC liability policy for judges.
- Criteria was established for proof of insurance on the part of the owner of the reinstated dog.
- Whenever a dog is DQ'd it must immediately leave the grounds. The same applies following a reinstatement procedure.
- It is being recommended to the AKC Board that in these situations the owner or handler will be asked to use a DNA swab. If the dog is not DNA'd it will be ineligible for reinstatement. The dog will be DNA'd again at the time of reinstatement. There will be a \$500 processing fee.
- Many clubs expressed little interest in allowing dogs to go through the reinstatement process at their event and simply refuse the entry based on the dog's DQ status.

The recent Hunt Test Regulation requiring dead birds to be no more than 24 hours old that was proposed by the Retriever Hunt Test Advisory (RHTAC) and Performance Department was discussed. This regulation was proposed due to complaints to the RHTAC and observation of AKC field reps. This Regulation change was not discussed at the Delegate prior to passage. It was pointed out to the Performance Department that this regulation will create a greater financial burden on clubs and result in an increase in HT entry fees. It was further pointed out to AKC that there are numerous factors that influence the quality of birds beyond the date of kill. It was suggested that those opposing this new Regulation write to the RHTAC and

the AKC Performance Department expressing their objection.

On June 28, 2016, AKC issued a press release announcing a title designed to celebrate the lifetime achievement of dogs that excel across all AKC agility classes – the Agility Grand Champion (AGCH). To earn the AGCH title, the following number of qualifying scores must be earned:

- Master Standard & Master Jumper with Weaves – 100 qualifying scores from each class
- Master Fast – 75 qualifying scores
- Time 2 Beat – 75 qualifying scores
- Premier Standard and Premier JWW – 50 qualifying scores from each class

Qualifying scores will be grandfathered and may be earned from either the Regular or Preferred classes or a combination of these classes.

The new title becomes effective in July. In addition to a title certificate, a plaque will be awarded to each AGCH recipient.

Linda is working with George Makatura to develop an online “AKC Volunteer Application Questionnaire” that is user friendly and fillable. Linda asked George Makatura to recommend a member to fill committee position vacancy.
- c) Field Trial Committee (Linda and Heidi) – The 2016 NFTS will be held September 20-22 and work is under way. The 2017 NFTS will be held in Virginia, near Williamsburg, a week after the Master National event in Texas.
- d) Health Committee (Betsy) – the Committee prepared an article about influenza that was published in a recent Bulletin. The AKC sent a health request to parent clubs and the Committee is reviewing the information and will make recommendations to the Board then update the ACC website information.
- e) Hunt Test Committee (George) – The Master Amateur Retriever Club is a new National Retriever Club dedicated to the Amateur Handler. March 2016 starts the qualifying period clock for the Master National and Master Amateur. Dogs need 6 passes at the Master level. Johnny Fogle is chairing the March ACC Hunt Test at H. Cooper Black in Cheraw, SC. Linda reported that AKC Delegate Tim Carrion is looking into club fees that ACC pays to belong to a few of the retriever organizations, which, in turn, allows our ACC events to qualify.   - o Parent Club’s Recommendation for AKC Approval on a member of their club to judge their breed
    - Parent Club is invited to submit recommendations, not to exceed three members each year.
    - Submit certified copy of meeting minutes at which action was taken by the Parent Club Board.
  - o Requirements from Applicant/Judge
    - All Recommendations by Parent Clubs must include 20 years in the breed by applicant with breeding/exhibiting success.
    - Must include 10 years membership in Parent Club.
    - Must be occupationally eligible.
    - Must be 21 years of age.
    - Procedural and anatomy test required and if applicable, scale and wicket test required.

**CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB**

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

**I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS**

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

**II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG** (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.
