



REFLECTIONS AND CRITIQUES FROM JUDGE BETSY HORN HUMER (VA)

Judge for Bitches and Intersex

I want to thank the amazing mini-committee for pulling together and putting on the 2016 National Specialty Show: Marilyn, Karen, all their hard workers and all the chairs of the events that ran from Tuesday through Sunday.

I have not judged on the West Coast in over five years. I was not disappointed. The quality of the entry was excellent. There were many choices. I found many well-balanced sound dogs with good to excellent coats. I felt my top winners had correct outlines and were in excellent condition. I looked for correct proportions, substance and the proper head as described in the breed standard. The best dogs would be able to do the job they were bred to do.

The most important area that breeders need to concentrate on are properly constructed fronts. In addition, rears need to improve and



"stifles should be well-angulated" in order to balance the correct front with equal layback of shoulder to the upper arm. Gait should be effortless and show reach and drive for efficient movement both in the field and in water. Chesapeake should retain their athleticism and not become ponderous. When I looked at the final line-up several of the winners display field titles after their names.

Temperaments were really good with a little forgiveness for 6-9 month puppies. Several were a little timid and a couple of others were downright boisterous! I'm sure it was the first time showing in a carpeted ballroom for those in the puppy classes. A little more training and several more shows should show marked improvement in attitude. And one more observation: please do not over groom those beautiful coats.....

Judging your own National Specialty is what every breeder judge wants to do and it was the highlight of my year! I was pleased with the excellent sportsmanship on the part of the exhibitors. I was also amazed at the support that came in from all over the country – some driving several thousand miles. I thank everyone for attending and showing and look forward to attending the 2017 National Specialty Show in the East.

Best of Breed: GCH Marjan's I Walk The Line – a moderate size, well-coated light deadgrass male with a correct head displaying well set ears and correct proportion of muzzle to top skull. He has a lovely neck going into his shoulders. He is a good moving dog with rear and front angles that match. He demonstrated excellent soundness as he moved around the ring and he looks as if he can work all day. Congratulations to both the breeders and the owners for sending him to the National!

Best of Opposite Sex/Hunting Retriever: CH Coolwater's Roane Point CD BN RE JH - came from the winner of the Hunting Retriever Class – she is a dark brown bitch in excellent condition and beautifully balanced. She moves very soundly and she came fully dressed with a very correct harsh coat. Her feminine head displayed correct ear set and a correct length of tapered muzzle to her top skull.

Best of Winners/Winners Dog: Queen's Don't Call This a Comeback – a well-balanced medium brown dog with rear angles matching the front. He is sound coming and going and moves beautifully. He used everything that he had – he has a correct coat, correct feet and a good ear set. He is well moving and was a close contender for Best of Breed.

Select Dog/Hunting Retriever: GCH Spinnaker's Kodiak Fisher, SH – a well-angulated dark brown dog, balanced front and rear with a correct outline and good proportions. He has a correct well-rounded top skull with a tapered muzzle. He moved soundly coming and going.

Select Bitch: HR CH Spinnakers Fanny Porter Quailrun Mayhem – a light deadgrass exceptionally well-coated, well-angulated and balanced front and rear. Her head has a correct rounded top skull and muzzle proportions are correct.

Award of Merit/ Veteran Dog 8-10 years: GCH Chestnut Hills Rowdy – a well-balanced medium brown dog with an excellent coat, harsh and short with good undercoat. He has a correct head with small well set ears and good hare feet. He moved beautifully around the ring.

Award of Merit: GCH Marjan's It's All In The Game, MH – a nicely balanced sedge dog in good coat. He is moderately built and has a correct head and good ears. He moved easily around the ring, using himself well. He is a littermate to the Best of Breed dog.

Award of Merit/Veteran Bitch 8-10 years: CH Chestnut Hills Victoria - a well-balanced dark brown bitch with a lovely coat and very good angles front and rear. Her head has correct proportions of muzzle to top skull and a very pleasing expression. She moved well and you wouldn't know that she is just under ten years of age. She is also Best Veteran.

Award of Merit: CH Shocktop's California Gold Rush – a well-balanced mature medium brown bitch carrying an excellent coat. She carries substance and moved soundly around the ring, holding her topline.

Puppy Bitch 6-9 mos: Skywatcher Dublin's Irish Ire – a well-balanced and well-angulated dark brown puppy bitch possessing a lovely neck into shoulders. She showed depth of brisket at her young age and moved well around the ring. She is definitely a youngster to keep an eye on.

Puppy Bitch 9-12 mos: Spinnaker's Oh No Never of Ocotilla - a good-sized puppy in lovely coat who moved freely and easily around the ring. I'd like more angulation front and rear but she carries an excellent coat and a correct head.

Bitch 12-18 mos: Spinnaker's Ragen of Dalbrian – winner of this class has the best outline and proportions in the class along with an adequate coat. She moves freely around the ring.

Amateur-Owner-Handler: Mtn View Tweety Bird, RN BN PCD CGCA – a medium brown feminine bitch who moved quickly – very quickly around the ring. Coat tended to be softer than desired.

Winners Bitch/Bred By Exhibitor: Chesacola's Memphis Belle, JH CGC – a light deadgrass very well-balanced and well-coated bitch. She has a good outline and is moderately sized: not too long and not too tall. She has a good quality coat and a pleasing feminine head. Correct hare feet and she moved soundly coming and going and around the ring.

Reserve Winners Bitch/Open Bitch: Quailridge's Led LeatherN Antik Lace – a light deadgrass bitch with an excellent harsh coat. She is well-balanced with a good outline and moved well. I preferred the head on the Winners Bitch.

Veteran Bitch – 10 years+: GCH Echo bay's Jazzin Riversedge RN JH – a well-dressed medium brown veteran in beautiful coat with a pretty correct head and a good front – well balanced and mature who didn't show her age at just under 12 when she moved beautifully around the ring. Her excellent coat and soundness put her in First Place.

Field Trial Bitch: Comet's Sweet Music, JH CGC - a challenging class to judge: won by a deadgrass bitch in top physical condition with an excellent coat. She is well-balanced with a nice outline and very feminine. She could work in the field all day.

Best Bred by Exhibitor: Skywatcher's Golden Arrow - he had a little more substance than the Bred by Bitch. He showed and gaited well and was in excellent coat. He has a pleasing head and is well-angulated front and rear.

Stud Dog Class: GCH Marjan's I Walk The Line (Best of Breed).

Brood Bitch Class: GCH Silvercreek's Mandan Sun Vow, JH WDX CD RN CGC. Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Class are a breeder's showcase. The same littermates were shown as the "get" for the winners of each class. They showed consistency of type, balance and good movement and were in good coat. One of them "made the cut" in the Best of Breed class. After winning the Stud Dog Class, the same two "get" returned for Brood Bitch which gave me a total picture of the family of dogs I was judging.

Brace: CH Coolwater's Roane Point, CD BN RE JH (Best of Opposite Sex) and Laurelwood's True Bearing (mother and daughter). They both have correct harsh coats and are well-balanced. Their heads are correct in proportions and they gaited soundly.

**Comment – In these three multi-entry classes there were two puppies just over six months old. They were in Stud Dog and Brood Bitch as "get" and they were a definite challenge both to stack and to gait. With each class they got better and better and by the time they showed in the Brace Class with their owner/handler, they were getting tired and used to the routine. The owner discovered that the best way to move them on the down and back was to hold one on each side. It was a unique picture but it worked! There was a lot of laughter and applause for these two young girls. I hope somebody snapped a picture. With a little more age and more training, they will be competitive – watch for them in the Brace at the National in 2017!*



COMMENTS AND CRITIQUES

FROM JUDGE ANNE KATONA (NV)

Judge for Dogs

I particularly wish to thank the American Chesapeake Club's membership and show committee for inviting me. The experience was everything I had expected and more. What a thrill to walk into the ring on Friday, October 7, 2016 in Portland, OR to judge the dog classes for American Chesapeake Club's specialty show. Ring size was perfect to view every entry around; then down and back. Thank you for the wonderful ring steward that knew exactly how to keep the ring moving with trophies ready. Speaking of trophies – they were beautiful and everyone seemed to enjoy receiving them.

Please let me express my appreciation for the beautiful Mini-Suite at the hotel that the club provided for my comfort. Thank you!

The entry was fun, from the 6 to 9 months class through to Winner's Dog. I hope it was obvious that I like exhibits that move in a complete package: with good toplines, and with balanced reach and drive. Within those perimeters I expect individual breed characteristics such as: Broad skull, round with a medium stop, jaws of sufficient length and strength to carry large game birds. Double coated where outercoat hair is short, harsh, and tends to wave on shoulders, neck, back and loins only, with a dense, fine, wooly undercoat that contains natural oil. Body should be strong, well balanced, powerfully built of moderate size and medium length for both body and leg, chest deep and wide, with no tendency to weakness in any feature. Clean walkers on the down and back, reach and drive on the go around, moderate bone, balance of body length – neither too short nor too long in proportion to height. I will say with the exception of one person, the sportsmanship was outstanding. Thank you for that.

Puppy Dogs (6 Mos and Under 9 Mos)

1st Place: Riversedge Jumpin Jack Flash - WOW! Congratulations to the breeder/owner/handler of this young dog! At 7.5 months he is put together like a well-planned breeding program! Today he is balanced, great outline and good walker! I will keep my fingers crossed he will continue to develop into an amazing example of the breed. Note: I plan to follow him to watch him grow.

2nd Place: Takemehome Stagecoach - This youngster could develop into a very nice mature dog. He has lots going for him; however, today he was truly a puppy! There is nothing wrong with a very nice puppy having a fun time – enjoy him and let him grow up!

Puppy Dogs (9 Mos and Under 12 Mos)

1st Place: Redlion's Invasion - Another young male that could develop into a very nice mature dog. He still needs to grow into the balance he will probably one day have, he is a nice medium boned dog, with a great attitude. He did everything that was asked of him; he just was not ready for today. Time will definitely help.

Puppy Dogs (12 Mos and Under 18 Mos)

1st Place: Mud Creek Precious Metal At Hi-Ho - Beautiful breed type! Good walker with great balance to front and rear on the go around. He had correct outline, great balance, and correct coat. This is a nice young dog that deserves socialization.

Amateur-Owner Handler Dogs

1st Place: Echo Bays Sylva Streaking Raccoon - I have no doubt that this dog could do his job – he moved around the ring with purpose. I was surprised when I noticed while writing this critique, he is 8 years old – he certainly did not look (his coat was not wavy but it did have the required natural oil) or move (gait was smooth, good reach and drive) to indicate his age. Today he certainly accomplished everything his handler asked of him.

2nd Place: Rippling Waters Brown Bart - This young dog's gait was strong, smooth and free with good reach and drive. His coat was in condition, head still needs to mature, beautiful amber hue to the eye, and a happy disposition. Today this youngster lacked balance between shoulder to elbow - elbow to ground. Topline was not mature enough to hold which indicated to me he is in a growth cycle – this will most probably be more correct as he matures.

Bred By Exhibitor Dogs

1st Place: Skywatcher's Golden Arrow - Not surprised when I noted the age of this young dog to find he is only 18 months old. He even looked like a puppy today. He needs to grow into himself!!!

2nd Place: Chesacola's Big Head Todd - Medium boned dog, and of moderate size. Has a clear amber hue eye, hindquarter as high as the shoulders and a double coat that waved on shoulders, neck, back and loin. Moved with purpose, however, today his foot timing was not as good as it should have been.

Open Dogs

1st Place: Queen's Don't Call This A Comeback - Beautiful breed example!! Outline (had correct proportions/topline/underline), balance (well laid back shoulders with well bent stifles), coat (dense double coat with a somewhat coarse outer coat), and head (skull broad and round with medium stop) were outstanding! He covered ground with smooth ease; foot timing was awesome to watch. I am not sure he had a handler because he did it all himself. In my opinion, he is one of those breed examples that should be seen in the Best Of Breed ring so others can enjoy him! I could say much more about this beautiful dog, but I am sure you get the picture that I saw (goose bumps) when I looked at him.

2nd Place: N Awe Striking Tye Coon - This dog has much going for him – except today, he was lazy. His handler needs to learn what “pacing” feels like on the end of the lead! He did take enough good steps to prove he could do it, but since his handler did not insist he move correctly he paced! He has a very nice broad head with medium stop, correct balance, and a good coat.

Winners Dog/Open Class: Queen's Don't Call This A Comeback - Medium boned, body length balanced in proportion to height, hindquarters slightly higher than shoulders, scissors bite, and in great condition. Congratulations to his owners and handler, this finished his championship! He is, in my opinion, a beautiful example of the breed! Hope to see him in the Best of Breed ring often so others can enjoy him!

Reserve Winners Dog/6 mos & under 9 mos class: Riversedge Jumpin Jack Flash - Of correct balance being slightly longer than the height at withers with beautiful head piece with intelligent express, muzzle approximately the same length as skull. Topline not quite as

solid on the move (he is a puppy for goodness sakes) but correct side gait (straight and positive with reach and drive) on the go around and a great attitude!

Veteran Dogs 8 Yrs. & Under 10 Yrs.

1ST Place: GCH CH Chestnut Hills Rowdy - He was so happy to be back in the ring. His whole body wiggled and his tail never stopped wagging! Beautiful condition for a 9 year old!!

2ND Place: CH Sago's Brookhollow Gomez - Also in great condition for an 8 year old. Still had the show spirit and enjoyed being there today.

Field Trial Dogs

1ST Place: GCH CH Shaken-Not Stirred SH CGC - This is a nice example of the field stock, good walker with beautiful legs and feet. Shown to perfection!!

Hunting Class Dogs

(This was not an easy class for me – all three were in great condition and good representatives of the breed)

1ST Place: GCH CH Spinnaker's Kodiak Fisher SH - This dog was a bit better in outline (correct proportions/topline/underline), balance (well laid back shoulders with well bent stifles) was very good, coat was double with a coarse outer coat. He was Type, Type, Type!

2ND Place: CH Chestnut Hills Epic Brew JH RATO - This dog had a beautiful head with an amber eye, but was a tad bit longer in loin. Back was not as solid, and the coat seemed to lack the natural oil today (maybe he was shampooed to close to show day?).

Open Intermediate/Best Junior Handler

GCH Pond Hollow Brooklyn Bridge JH - A young junior with soft hands on her exhibit throughout their time in the ring. She was aware of where the judge was at all times without "staring", she listened to all verbal instructions given and then took a second to "digest" those instructions before walking away. She has great potential for being a very good handler. **Editors Note:** Though she did not judge Junior Showmanship, Ms. Katona wanted to provide her thoughts on the skills of our Best Junior.

A FEW WORDS FROM JUDGE ANNETTE MONUGIAN

Judge for Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes

To say I was nervous prior to judging, was an understatement, but once the dogs stepped into the ring and I had a job to do and a ring to control, the nerves went away, and the fun began. To handle pups in the show ring for the first time or first several times, is always a challenge, and as an exhibitor myself I understood that not all pups will stand solid, or have the training yet to move nicely on lead, so when I judged I forgave many misbehaviors. However, I wanted a pup that would allow me to approach, check the bite, feel the upper arm length, feel coat quality, and determine muscle conditioning. Most pups were wiggly and friendly, but not apprehensive, even though at times touching them made them sit or squirm away. Time, training, and patience on the part of the handlers/owners will fix all those puppy problems. When moving I wanted a dog that could move with ease on the side go around, and on the down and back a pup that did not interfere with itself or show soundness issues. Larger size did not bother me, as long as the pup was well put together and appeared to be able to work all day long without tiring. At the end of each class, before making placements, I asked myself, which animal would I want to take home on this day, and then placed them accordingly.

There some standouts in the puppy classes. My Best in Sweepstakes winner caught my eye from the moment he walked into the ring, and it wasn't just his beautiful clear deadgrass color. On this day, this pup had all the parts I was looking for, great easy side movement, a stable temperament, fabulous coat quality and nice muscle conditioning for his age. The bitches were all of such quality, that any one of my first place winners could have taken Best Opposite, however the female I choose had maturity on her side, a great coat, beautiful side movement, and she showed like a seasoned dog.

All of the breeders and owners of the veterans need to be commended for the longevity and quality of our old guys and gals. These old farts could still get the job done happily. Some very difficult choices had to be made as I could not give first place to every dog out there. My Best Veteran was a female who in spite of her advanced years, and extra pound or two, could still soundly trot around the ring with style and vigor, showed in great coat and had a very bright disposition. My best Opposite veteran was a younger male veteran whose body condition was amazing, correct working coat, well balanced body and attractive masculine head.

A true pleasure it was to judge some fine young Chesapeake and some magnificent older Chesapeakes. This breed was developed so

many years ago with the ability to work for long hard hours in the field, without tiring, and thus needed to have good conformation and good coats in order to perform its job, and what I saw in the ring shows that as breeders we can still deliver those traits in a modern age.

2016 Triple Crown Versatility Challenge

For the 6th consecutive year, we celebrated the versatility of our breed with the Triple Crown Versatility Challenge by honoring and recognizing those handler/dog teams that successfully competed in multiple disciplines. The challenge was to qualify and/or place in a minimum of three different classes across at least two different NSS disciplines. Dogs/handlers that met the challenge received a Chesapeake Bay Retriever ornament.



The 2016 NSS included 5 disciplines: Tracking, Agility, Obedience/Rally, Conformation/Sweepstakes, and Field. The criteria for each discipline was:

- **Tracking:** Qualifying score in tracking.
- **Agility:** Qualifying score in any agility class offered.
- **Obedience/Rally:** Qualifying score in any regular or optional titling Obedience and/or Rally class offered or placement in non-regular class.
- **Conformation/Sweepstakes:** Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog/Bitch, a Judge's Award of Merit or by making the cut in the Best of Breed competition, Placement in any regular or non-regular conformation class. Placement in any Puppy or Veteran Sweepstakes class also qualifies.
- **Field:** Qualifying score in any Working Dog Stake (WD, WDX, WDQ).

We had 22 teams from across the country (AK, CA, CO, GA, MD, MT, OR, TN, and VA) ranging in age (dog!!) from just barely 6 months to 14+ years accept the challenge.



Companion Events Feature on the AKC Canine Good Citizen and Therapy Dog Programs

The AKC Canine Good Citizen Program and the AKC Therapy Dog Program are ways to recognize and encourage responsible pet ownership, good basic obedience training and sharing our dogs with the community. Working towards CGC and THD titles is a wonderful way to spend quality time with your Chesapeake!

The AKC Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic obedience training for dogs, designed to reward and encourage dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. All dogs who pass the 10-step CGC test may receive a certificate from the American Kennel Club, and the test is open to both AKC registered purebreds (including those with PAL numbers) and mixed breed dogs with ILP numbers. Some homeowner's insurance companies are encouraging CGC testing, and an increasing number of apartments and condos require that resident dogs pass the CGC test. In 2013, CGC became an official title, allowing dogs who passed to add the CGC suffix to their name.

The CGC test consists of ten basic exercises:

1. Accepting a friendly stranger
2. Sitting politely for petting
3. Appearance and grooming
4. Out for a walk (walking on a loose lead)
5. Walking through a crowd
6. Sit and Down on command & Staying in place
7. Coming when called
8. Reaction to another dog
9. Reaction to distraction
10. Supervised separation

AKC has recently introduced additional levels of the CGC testing; the CGCA and the GCGU. AKC Community Canine is the advanced level of the AKC's Canine Good Citizen Program. Dogs who pass the AKC Community Canine test earn the official AKC Community Canine title designated by the letters "CGCA" (Advanced CGC)

on the dog's title record. Whereas Canine Good Citizen tests are most often tested in a ring and situations are simulated (e.g., 3 helpers serve as a "crowd"), the AKC Community Canine test is done in real situations including at shows, classes, and in the community and has more advanced training requirements as well as higher levels of distraction. AKC Urban CGC (CGCU) requires that the dog demonstrate CGC

skills and beyond in an urban setting. AKC Urban CGC is administered in a place where there are cars, streets to be crossed, noises, and distractions such as riding in elevators or subways, and requires a more advanced level of training and control than the CGC test.

The AKC Therapy Dog program awards official AKC titles to dogs who have worked to improve the lives of the people they have visited. Therapy dogs are dogs who go with their owners to volunteer in settings such as schools, hospitals, and nursing homes, bringing comfort, support and cheer. From working with a child who is learning to read to visiting a senior in assisted living or providing emotional support and comfort after a disaster, therapy dogs and their owners work together as a team to improve the lives of other people. Therapy Dog titles can be earned by dogs who have been certified by AKC recognized therapy dog organizations and have performed the required number of visits.

- AKC Therapy Dog Novice (THDN): Must have completed 10 visits.
- AKC Therapy Dog (THD): Must have completed 50 visits.
- AKC Therapy Dog Advanced (THDA): Must have completed 100 visits.
- AKC Therapy Dog Excellent (THDX): Must have completed 200 visits.
- AKC Therapy Dog Distinguished (THDD): Must have completed 400 visits.

Each of our dog’s stories is very different. Many have lost their home due to family emergencies, divorce, owner death, downsizing, or simply a family that is too busy. It is so sad! With the surrendering of a dog to ACC Rescue, a chance for a new life, new family begins. We work very hard to match dogs with the right family or situation to ensure their success.

A very sweet little girl came to us off of a large ranch where she had been injured by a large ram. She just couldn’t understand that not all animals were her friends. Tullahla was placed in the foster care of Camille Druge; long time ACC Rescue Member who has made rescue a part of her life. AKC Delegate's Report

As 2016 comes to a close and we look towards 2017 the December AKC meeting covered a variety topics involving the administration, entry and judging of conformation shows and field trials.

The Delegate body rejected a proposal to amend Chapter 6, Sect 9 of the Dog Show Rules which would have extended entries from noon to 11:59pm of the Thursday prior.

Proposals were presented to the Delegates to consider for a March 2017 vote:

The establishing of a retriever field trial National Derby Championship event and title. This proposal was met with some opposition siting the establishing of a prefix title for a minor stake and that the highest Derby dogs could be excluded from competition due to birthdate.

Changing Chapter 2, Sect. 3 of the Dog Show Rules to allow the AKC to consider appeals of clubs that have been denied access to a date and or venue. This proposal came about because some clubs have been deemed to be "unreasonably protective" of their territory.

A topic in the planning stages is the possible realignment of Groups for Dog Shows and the expansion of up to 11 groups. This has been in response to the large increase in the number of approved breeds by the AKC over the last several decades. At present the Delegate body seems hesitant to approve this expansion until details such as: what breeds would be in which groups, certification of judges for these groups, and the time and money impact on clubs.

If anyone has any comments on these or other AKC issues please contact me.

Minutes of the September 19, 2016 Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB, a California Nonprofit public benefit corporation, was called to order at 5:42 PM MDT, Monday, September 19, 2016. The meeting was held in Ronan, MT, at the 2016 NFTS.

The following officers and directors were present: Linda Harger, President; Ed Bahr, Director; and Heidi Henningson, Director.

1. Roll Call: Forty-three (43) people signed the sign-in sheet. A quorum was not established for this meeting (requires 10% of 1191 members, or 119 members). President Linda Harger introduced herself then asked members and guests to introduce themselves.
2. Minutes of the last meeting: Minutes were published in the January/February 2016 Bulletin (October 8, 2015, meeting at the Oconomowoc, WI, NSS). Copies were available for members to review.
3. Report of the President: President Linda Harger reported the club is doing extremely well, no controversy going on, folks are here to have fun and see some great dogs.
4. Report of the Secretary: Notice of the annual meeting was in the July/August 2016 Bulletin and the August 13, 2016, Blast Email.
5. Report of the Treasurer: The ACC has \$6,755.86 in the checking account and \$170,036.14 in the savings account. First notice for membership dues have been sent out, please pay ASAP.

6. Reports of Committees:
 - a. Field Trial report (Chair Heidi Henningson) – Heidi asked Mike Moscovitz to present information about the 2017 National Field Trial Specialty (NFTS). Scott Bergman will be FT Chairman, October 31 – November 2 and will submit a new proposal to the ACC. There is a problem with the property: Steve Ferguson Memorial Retriever Grounds. The first week of October 2016 they will decide about our FT in Emporia, VA; second property Farmville, VA. The national is only 1.5 weeks later which may be conflicting. We may have a conflict with MNRC also if we go earlier. We will turn it over to the FT committee.
 - b. Show Committee – The 2017 National Show Specialty (NSS) will be in Raleigh, NC, August 31 – September 4, chaired by George Makatura and Lois Schulz.
 - c. Illustrated Guide Update – the IG is being revised and edited and will be available on line once the update is completed.
7. Unfinished Business: Mitch Patterson asked for a moment of silence for good Chesapeake people and great Chesapeake dogs: John Ackerman, John Dahl, Nancy Lowenthal, Hans, Comet.
8. New Business
 - a. Trophies: Skipper Bob Trophy to winner of Open – oldest traveling trophy since 1936 for FT, it's getting beat up and expensive to insurance and ship. The Board has been asked if they would consider a permanent display at the Retriever Hall of Fame in TN. The ACC will add a plaque to it every year. The Heller Pot will also be placed in the RHF in TN. We would like a Chesapeake Body Statue made and placed in the Hall of Fame as well. Hope to work on that this year. Marston Jones offered that there are a few of the original casts in Baltimore, perhaps one is still in a hospital in Buffalo, NY.
 - b. Rescue: Heidi took over a year ago. She has done a phenomenal job! ACC Rescue has taken off! If you think about giving to the charitable trust when you send in your dues, please think about the ACC Rescue. It is because of the members, the trust, and our belief in these dogs. If you have items to donate

to the charitable trust that would be great, it's a tax write off. We have a lot of fosters and a lot of failed fosters (they don't let the dog go!), they become members when they take on the dog. We've got dogs everywhere. Diane Mazy is more than willing to take items for the trust. What does the charitable trust do with the items? They sell it and then use the money for ACC Rescue. Sometimes we put them up for auction. FB has an ACC Rescue page.

- c. Question - Will they take old trophies? Answer - We can add old trophies to the Retriever Hall of Fame memorial. They want to make it bigger and better. Other trophies you can re-donate to the specialties or we can auction them off for rescue.

The proposed Bylaws amendments passed. The balloting closed on December 15, 2016. Total voting membership was 1193, and 476 ballots were submitted comprising 39.89%, or approximately 40% of the membership voting. The ACC received the following Teller's Report for the American Chesapeake Club Bylaws Ballot from Chris Dickey, Professional Registered Parliamentarian and Mediator, dated December 15, 2016:

Proposal: To amend Article 3(A) (Purposes), Article 3(B) (Specific Purposes), Article 3(C) (Limitations), Article 4(A)(1)(e) (Classes and Qualifications), Article 4(A)(7)(a) (Grounds for Discipline), Article 5(E)(8) (Meetings of Directors – Board Action), Article 7(B)(4) (Nominations), Article 10 (Parliamentary Authority), Article 14(B) (Delegate to the American Kennel Club), and Article 15 (Dissolution) of the American Chesapeake Club Bylaws as set forth on pages 26-28 of the September/October 2016 ACC Bulletin.
