

ADCH-Platinum PDCH-Bronze MACH5 Rippling Waters Jill ASD-B AGD-B AKD-B AJD-S PTM-B, TQ3 MXB2 MJC MFS T2B4 (CH Rippling Waters Purple Haze MH X CH Rippling Waters BB MH), "Jill", became the first Chesapeake Bay Retriever to earn a fifth AKC Master Agility Championship (MACH5) on February 12, 2017. The MACH5 requires a total of 100 DoubleQs (qualifying in both Master Standard and Jumpers classes on the same day), and 3750 points which represent the number of seconds under SCT for each qualifying run. 


Companion Events

Companion Events Feature on Flyball

Flyball is a team sport developed in the 1970s. Think of it as a canine relay race over a series of jumps. Each dog on the team jumps over a series of four hurdles to a spring-loaded box that shoots out a tennis ball when the dog hits a release pad. A tennis ball!!! That shoots out of a box!!! Chesapeake heaven!!!

The dog catches the ball and returns back over the jumps to the handler. Once the dog passes the finish line, the next dog on the team gets to run. The goal is to have the dog finishing the run and the dog starting the run pass nose to nose at the start/finish line, to get the fastest times for the team.

How is it organized? The jumps are spaced 10 feet apart, with the first jump six feet from the start line. The box is 15 feet from the last jump — so the dogs are running 51 feet each way. Jump height is determined by the size of the smallest dog on the team.



Each team races against another four-dog team in competition, racing side-by-side in separate lanes. Flyball dogs have to contend with distractions like barking dogs, stray balls, and excited handlers and fans.

Faults When dogs make mistakes on the course, they have to repeat the heat after all the other dogs on their team have run. Sometimes multiple errors are made and several dogs on the team have re-runs. Common errors include:

- Dropping the ball before crossing the finish line.
- Going around hurdles instead of jumping them.
- More than one false start—where one of the first two dogs to run the race crosses the start line before the start light flashes green. Teams are allowed one false start in each heat. In the case of a false start, the heat is simply re-started.
- Early release—leaving the start line before the previous dog on the team crosses the finish line.

How do you win? The first team to have all its members run clean — without errors — wins the heat. The team winning the majority of the

heats wins the race. Winning teams receive points based on the team's time. What's the record? For United Flyball League International, the record is 14.182 seconds for the whole team. For the North American Flyball Association, the record is 14.459 seconds for the team. Wow! That's fast!

Governing bodies: Two groups sanction flyball competitions in the US and Canada. NAFA, the North American Flyball Association, (www.flyball.org) was started 33 years ago and has 400 active clubs and 6500 registered dogs in competition. U-FLI, United Flyball League International (www.u-fli.com), is a younger organization, started in 2004. The rules are slightly different for each organization. In 2012, the AKC began recognizing three NAFA titles (Flyball Champion, for dogs who have won 500 points, Flyball Master, for dogs who have won 5,000 points, and ONYX, for dogs who have won 20,000 points).

What does it take to compete? Although herding breeds dominate many competitions, all breeds can compete—even mixed breeds. Dogs have to be at least a year old and need a sound disposition to handle the noise and excitement of the races. Good health and body condition are important as dogs run multiple heats in tournaments.

Teams are seeded into divisions by running times, so that dogs are racing against others with similar abilities.

Patti Kipper has run Chesapeakes in flyball competitions and thinks their stamina, single mindedness and joy for retrieving are all great qualities that can help them excel at flyball. "Most of the work and training comes in shaping a good (safe) turn off the flyball box. As a rule Chesapeakes are bigger and heavier than the average dog playing flyball. High speeds and the many repetitions of hitting the flyball box, make a good turn on the box paramount for any dog to hold up to the rigors of the game of flyball. If your Chesapeake likes to run, jump, and retrieve, flyball just might be the game for you. It is a lot of fun for both dog and handler."



Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Amateur competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. E. C. Fleishman and was first awarded in 1962.

Winner: AFC Red Dog's Anything Goes owned by Bill Burks.

CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966.

Winner: DC AFC Yakity's Shake Rattle 'N' Roll owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey.

DC AFC Tigers' Cub CD Memorial Trophy

Awarded annually to the amateur handler whose Chesapeake earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open and Amateur competition. (The Open points must be earned by an amateur handler.) The trophy was donated to the ACC by Eloise Cherry in 1979 in memory of her dog Tiger's Cub.

Winner: Bill Burks.

FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961.

Winner: Get Back owned by Bill Burks.

FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961.

Winner: Vee's Zeus Of Lzy Mtn owned by Todd & Barbara Adams.

The Louis Traung Trophy

Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.)

Winner: Vee's Zeus Of Lzy Mtn owned by Todd & Barbara Adams.

FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa Chief Trophy

3. Report of Treasurer: The Treasurer (Gale) reported as of this weekend, we have 556 members still needing to renew. We have about 900 total, so a little under half have renewed.

Final financial reports are just coming in now from the NFTS and the NSS. She has not received the final reports so amounts are approximate: NFTS – profit of \$2839, NSS-WD – profit of \$262, NSS – loss of \$12,980.

In regards to the NSS, the hotel has a policy of a 500-night minimum for events at their facility. Marilyn Williams, the chair, was able to negotiate them down to 250 nights for the contract. We were 80 nights short which came out to about \$10,000.

Bank accounts: As of 11/27/16, checking is \$17,215 and savings is \$160,219 for a total of \$177,434. These numbers will go up in the coming weeks as we close out NSS and NFTS bank accounts and transfer those funds to the Savings account. We also continue to renew memberships. The deadline for membership renewal is 12/31/16 with a 30-day grace period, making the last day to renew 01/31/2017.

American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

OBJECTIVE

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is given to an individual who has made significant contributions to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed / the people who own them through outstanding leadership / advancement of knowledge / understanding.

ELIGIBILITY

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes personal achievement / its positive impact on the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed. The award may be given to any individual independent of specific institutional affiliation with the American Chesapeake Club or other organizations.

The ACC Lifetime Achievement Award is not an annual award. The awards selection committee may decide not to make any awards selection in a given year or may decide to bestow multiple awards. The number / frequency of award selection is strictly at the discretion of the awards selection committee.

Nominations may be submitted by organizations or individuals, including the nominees themselves.

AWARDS CRITERIA

Nominees are judged by the originality, vision, breadth, / impact of the entire body of their work. Candidate selection must go beyond mere name recognition / reputation. A nominee's work is evaluated in such areas as:

- A strong / well-documented commitment to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed.
- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacroft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacroft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


