



AKC Delegate's Report

May and June has seen a variety of changes for AKC events. The AKC Board of Directors has approved the following changes:

The AKC Breeder of Merit designation will now include additional levels of success. Bronze will denote 10 titled dogs, 5 being prefix, Silver 25 titles with 15 prefix, Gold 50 titles 30 prefix and Platinum 100 titles 60 prefix.

Agility: Effective January 1, 2018 the 26 inch jump will be eliminated and replaced with a 24 inch. This change will be worldwide within the next 6 months.

Tracking: Effective immediately, dogs may wear protective footwear provided the footwear is put on in the presences of the judges.

Field Trials: Effective June 1, 2017, honoring is now mandated in all Qualifying, Amateur and Open stakes.

Hunt Test: Hard copies of the judge's examination are no longer available. The exam can be accessed and is now online at: [caninecollege.akc.org/collections/performance-judges- education](http://caninecollege.akc.org/collections/performance-judges-education)

The AKC Delegate body vote to approve the following at the June 13, 2017 meeting:

Dog Show Rules: Chapter 6 Section 6 has been modified to allow the winners of non-regular classes to be counted for determining the awarding of points.

Field Trial Rules: As of July 1, 2017, Chapter 6 Section 6 will allow for clubs, at their option, to institute a rotation system in the running order in Derby and Qualifying stakes after the first series provided that notice of a rotation is clearly stated in the premium.

President Linda Harger served as Chair and Secretary Tina Cox served as Secretary of the meeting.

1. Approval of Minutes – To approve minutes from January 30, 2017. **17:10** (Tina Cox, Linda Harger) Passed 03/21/2017.

2. Report of President: Linda Harger

Ideas about how to enhance the WD/X/Q program to make it more appealing to general membership, this would mainly be ways to advertise its history and relevance to the breed and the owners. Linda had a thought that we need some big guns at the WD/X/Q in NC, so I'm soliciting help from some of the more active local Field Trial & Hunt test advocates. We can encourage puppy owners to get their first 'title' Linda thinks a major article of its history in the bulletin is a must.

4. Report of Treasurer: The Treasurer (Gale Frana) reported she just renewed our General Liability Insurance Policy. Our insurance company has explained that any ACC sponsored event is covered by our General Liability policy. Certificates of Insurance are only to be issued if the landowner/facility owner, where the event will take place, requests one. Requesting a Certificate of Insurance must be done through the ACC Treasurer.

- Our grace period for membership renewal ended on January 31, 2017. Total memberships paid – 825.
- Donations made through the membership renewal process for the 2017 National Show Specialty totaled \$639.
- Donations made through the membership renewal process for the 2017 National Field Trial Specialty totaled \$1040.
- Gale is currently working on the 2016 Tax Filing for the club.

5. Reports of Committees:

A. Standing Committees

1. Companion Events Committee (Jill) – Companion events from Doreen Palmer, looking at other clubs Versatility Title programs so that we can develop one that will dovetail with the ROM program that is being revised.

Submitting articles to the Bulletin to highlight new and current AKC titles.

2. Health Committee (Betsy) – National Show Specialty (NSS) and National Field Trial Specialty (NFTS) possible health clinic – Exercised Induced Collapse (EIC) - still getting prices. Had hoped to get a Speaker from North Carolina State Veterinary School, but that will not work.

WDXQ Program Updates

The updated revision of the WDXQ Program is complete 7-5-17. Please take a look and download it from the ACC website at www.amchessieclub.org. (If you have no computer a copy can be mailed to you).

There are many pages that are sent out in a packet to the person holding a WDXQ Stake and these pages for holding a stake have been simplified and are now easier to read and to do reports after. Here are the changes to make note of:

1. Minor wording change regarding judge's qualifications
2. WDXQ was a land double with a flyer. It is now a land double with a dead bird and the flyer will be with the combination land/water triple.
3. Rules are now updated for non-members running (see the copy on website).
4. Prices are now \$55 each stake members, \$65 non-members.
5. Any member in good standing can be a chairman for holding a WDXQ Stake, that has always been the case. You need to have a "sponsor" sign the paperwork which can be a Regional Director and we've also added that it can be Board Member. The sponsor does not need to be present at the Stake, it is for financial/paperwork overseeing only.
6. WDXQ now held only in North American and no credit from field trials/hunt tests for titles. (approved 11-30-16 previously published).
7. If you already have a WD, X, or Q title you may not run in competition again. If time permits and you want to run non-contention this may be possible. Please see rules for details.

Please delete all old versions so there is no confusion.

The ACC would love to see several stakes held each year in different parts of the country, especially opposite to where the show specialty/WDXQ is being held. The ACC Board and I have worked very hard to update and move this program forward for our members. Please contact me with any questions.

New International WDXQ Program: A letter has gone out to our seven International Regional Directors regarding a proposal for a program just for International countries with a type of WDXQ test that would better suit their style of training, hunting and working their dogs in the field. It would be the same for all countries other than North America and be agreed upon and established by these seven RD's. It would be a part of the WDXQ Program with certificates etc just different in judging requirements, type of tests and types of birds used. Future information will be listed in the Bulletin about the program.

American Chesapeake Club LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

JUDGING

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacroft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacroft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


