# Force Fetch

## Force Fetch? Why?

Why in the world would anyone feel the need to force a retriever to retrieve, and then expect him or her to still be a competitive dog? If they are so “bad” that they need to be forced, it seems that the rest of the “training” part will only get worse. It is counter intuitive that a naturally retrieving dog would need to go through a force to retrieve program, and in fact, depending on what your goals are, they may not need it. This is not a discussion of how to force train a dog, but rather, why we do it at all!

I have to preface this discussion with a disclaimer that I do not consider myself to be an expert in dog training or force fetching specifically. I have been actively involved in field activities for too many years, but always feel that there are times when I am at a complete loss at what to do next. The force fetching schedule recommended by many training programs (not all) is onerous, and clearly, the least enjoyable part of dog training for both the trainer and the animal! It may be severe enough to discourage many amateurs from even attempting it! That the natural instinct of retrieving is inherent in most retrievers, is just the point that we use it to instill force and pressure into a training program. We rely on the dog instincts to help him to understand what is needed to be successful and push through the pressure.

The obvious action of going through a forced retrieve is only a small aspect of what force training is about. Having a field dog progress, goes through many stages of learning and training. After establishing a sound basis for obedience and “learning to learn”, it is time to start a force program. It was common to wait until the pup had lost their baby teeth around 6 months, and there were no teething issues creating a barrier to progress. More recently, many trainers start earlier with obedience and often are able to get forcing in before teething starts around 4 months of age. A lot will depend on the dedication of your training schedule, the maturity and aptitude of the puppy. There will also be fairly wide variations of the time to finish a program with different pups. Progress is not measured in time, but in performance.

Addressing the question about why we pick retrieving to focus on, it is the most instinctual behavior in a working retriever. It is important to teach a youngster to handle stress and pressure, as this will become the foundation of advanced training. Fetching/retrieving is the essential trait that we expect of a retriever. Early on we surely want to see their natural talent and skills before we even make a decision about how much training the dog will get or need. It is a likely indication that if a youngster cannot find a marked retrieve after a few weeks of work in an open field with no obstacles that he is not going to get better as things get more complicated. I would give serious thought to pursuing a field career with a clueless retriever, even with unbounded enthusiasm.

For those dogs that we choose to go on with, an important first step of force fetching (FF) is to teach them commands. We cannot put

pressure on a dog for things they do not understand. So early on, even before obedience, when playing fetch with a puppy and their favorite objects, it helps to teach them “fetch” when you hold it in front of them and “drop” with a little pressure on their lip when you take it from them. By the time they are ready to sit and do obedience work on lead, they will know those commands to fetch, hold and drop (equally important commands). If you do not do it this way, spend at least a week just teaching the commands before commencing with force.

What is FF all about? We teach the dog to fetch a bumper, wooden peg or dumbbell on command. We start with the pup taking it from our hand to gradually moving towards the ground in front of them, and eventually moving out yards away. Most will see the exercise as a means to assure delivery to hand and avoid mouth problems. It will later lead to the start of teaching handling, but more importantly a mechanism to teach how to cope with “good pressure.” This is, constructive pressure to push their learning, as well as a method of proofing the teaching. They learn the task but they also learn that completing the task, no matter how stressed they may be, will turn off the pressure. This pays dividends later in life, when an advanced dog is giving second thoughts about getting off a point 200 yards away (and gets a sit collar nick correction, followed by an over cast)!

Pressure is the tool used by trainers in this process; it can be a collar correction, an ear pinch or even a toe pinch. The idea is to put some stress on the dog and have them learn to “push through” the stress and understand they can control the pressure. Initially, the pressure should be continued until they are committed to complete the “fetch” command; once they are showing compliance, this is where the encounter gets interesting, as well as challenging. Capitulation is the aim at this point. By this, I mean that the dog needs to give in fully to the will of the trainer; this will vary from animal to animal, but it is the cornerstone of FF. This is also when the team is cemented (and often why a pro trainer who is going to have the dog wants to do the FF). A team with the proper pecking order is established along with all of the other apparent tasks. Further along, the dog is given “freebies” (no corrections) as a reward, once they start to respond quickly to the verbal command to “fetch” along with a collar correction.

In summary, a lot can be accomplished during FF. A dog will learn to pick the bird up, to line out for a bird, to cast for a bird and to release the bird on command. Most importantly, through these emotional gymnastics, he will learn who is in charge, how to turn off the pressure with an appropriate response, and how to live life with some control in his hands (ok, paws!). It will provide the building blocks for a lifetime of successful training, in a humane fashion. Properly FF trained dogs come out of the program eager to work with a wagging tail.

# Companion Events

## Changes to AKC Obedience, Rally, Agility and Tracking

AKC has made changes in several areas of the Companion Dog Sports division. Some of them were implemented earlier in the year, others will become effective before the end of 2017 and others will become active in 2018. For details and questions involving any of the below changes please visit the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>) for rules/regulations and the news & updates sections for each of the corresponding venues.

**AKC Obedience and Rally effective May 1, 2017:** The obedience and rally regulations were amended to allow a closing time for entries no later than 11:59 pm on the third Wednesday prior to the trial for trials held on Friday through Monday.

**AKC Obedience and Rally effective Sept. 1, 2017:** Club clothing, AKC event clothing, or breed clothing may be worn by anyone exhibiting a dog or by ring stewards. Clothing may display the person's name, the dog's call name and/or the dog's picture. Titles may not be displayed. Writing or graphics on the clothing must not be in poor taste or contain profanity. Clothing must not display any information that would be in conflict with a sponsor of the trial.

**AKC Rally effective Nov. 1, 2017:**

- **Rally Intermediate (RI)** AKC has created a new class and title for dogs that have won the Rally Novice title, but have not yet earned a qualifying score in the Advanced class. The Rally Intermediate class will provide a stepping-stone class to help prepare teams for the off-leash performance required in the Advanced class. The Intermediate course is a mirror image of the Advanced course without a jump. It is the Novice exhibitor's choice to take advantage of this additional opportunity and the RI title is not required to enter the Advanced class.
- **Rally Master title (RM)** will now provide additional challenges for dedicated rally exhibitors. An RM is earned after the dog has received 10 qualifying scores in the Master class.
- **Rally Champion (RACH)** will also be available after Nov. 1, 2017. The RACH title (sounds like "ROCK") requires the team to earn 20 triple qualifying scores; qualifying in the Advanced B, Excellent B and Master classes at the same trial, at 20 separate events, plus earn 300 RACH points from the Excellent B and Master classes. Points are determined by a dog's score. At least 200 RACH points must be earned from the Rally Master class.

**AKC Agility effective Jan. 2, 2018:**

- Addition of 24C jump height division and removal of 26" class:
- The 24" Choice jump height is for dogs entered in the Regular division that measure 22" and under **ONLY**, whose handlers choose to enter 24". Dogs measuring 22" and over that are required to jump 24" will stay in the current 24" height. Course times for the 24" Choice will be the same as the 20" height in all classes.
- Pause Table, 2 new heights have been added - The height of the table will be 8" for dogs in the 8" jump height; 12" for dogs in the 12" jump height; 16" for dogs in the 16" jump height; 20" for dogs in the 20", and 24" jump height. Preferred Class Requirement: The Pause Table shall be set at 8" for the 4 and 8 inch jump height, 12" for the dogs in the 12" jump height, and 16 inches for the 16" jump heights and 20" for the 20" division
- NEW Ascending Double Bar Jump (optional) – This Jump consists of two ascending bars 5 feet in length where the back bar is positioned at the jump heights specified for the Bar Jump. The front bar is set 4" lower than the back bar.
- NEW Wall Jump (optional) – This jump consists of two pillars, a Bottom Base (Triangle), four widths of boards, and "tops".

**AKC Tracking Effective May 9, 2017**

- Dogs may wear a protective coat and/or footwear. If worn the coat, tracking harness and footwear must be put on in the presence of both judges.

# ACC Rescue

## Lost Chesapeake Survives Nine Months In Cold And Snow, Is Reunited With Owners!

Mo, an elderly Chesapeake Bay Retriever, wandered away from her owners during a hunting trip in Idaho in September 2016. After nine months and a brutal winter alone in the American Rocky Mountains, she is back home with her owners.

Darwin and Cindy Cameron stayed near the tiny hamlet of Horseshoe Bend about 48 kilometers north of Boise for three months looking for Mo. But deep snow and harsh conditions eventually made the search impossible.

Mo, somehow made her way to a nearby ranch in June, and ACC member and rescue member, Cheri Glanker was contacted and took Mo into her care.

It is believed the dog had been living in the wild on her own for nine months. How she survived the brutal cold, snow and wolves are a story that will remain untold, but a credit to Mo's intelligence and natural abilities.

Ms. Glanker posted photos on Facebook and word quickly reached the Cameron's that Mo may have been found. The Cameron's were initially hesitant to see the dog after receiving so many false alarms

before Ms. Glanker's call.

Mo had lost her hearing and half of her body weight while surviving in the wild, and Ms. Glanker warned the couple that the Chesapeake Bay Retriever would not be exactly the same as they might have remembered her. Dogs will go into survival mode if living in the wild for extended periods of time.

Despite Mo's subdued behavior, the Cameron's recognized the dog through its mannerisms and other distinctive details. The couple is extremely thankful to all the people who came forward to make the reunion possible. "The sheriff's office, the hunters who set aside their tags and their hunting trips to help look for a lost dog," Mr. Cameron said. "Boy, we're blessed to have her back."



"Mo" now nicknamed "The Legend" in honor of how she survived, found herself on National television as a Celebrity where her survival story and reunion with her family was celebrated.

"Mo" is just one of the many dogs that ACC Rescue has had the privilege of working with. We continue to assist families in finding a new family member who is in need of a second chance!

**CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB**

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the American Chesapeake Club. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the code of Ethics.

**I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS**

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.
