North American Diving Dogs National Championship

North American Diving Dogs (NADD), the dock diving organization affiliated with the AKC, has grown exponentially in 2017. The Chesapeake Bay Retrievers had a strong showing in the National Championships in December at the Royal Canin/Eukanuba show in Orlando with several top 10 placements. The Open Distance Jumping divisions are Elite (jumping average of 24 feet and above), Master (between 20'0" and 23'11" feet), Senior (between 15'0" and 19'11" feet), Junior (between 10'0" and 14'11" feet) and Novice (between 0'1" and 9'11" feet). 19 Chesapeake Bay Retrievers participated in the Open Distance National Championships.



4 Chesapeake Bay Retrievers also earned invitations to the Air Retrieve national championships. Air Retrieve is an event where a bumper is suspended 2 feet above the dock platform and out a set distance marked on the pool. The object of the competition is for the dog to jump from the end of the dock and knock down the bumper. The farthest distance from the dock for a successful "grab" is the final distance recorded for the placements.

Companion Event News

January 1st 2018 saw a few minor changes to the agility rules and on May 1st there will be some major changes to the AKC obedience regulations. Listed below is an overview of the changes that may affect your training and performance in the ring. There are other changes, including obstacle specifications that may not have a direct impact on your training and performance but that you should be aware of. For specifics on the below and to reacquaint yourself with the rules and regulations pertaining to the venues you participate in please visit the AKC website, <http://www.akc.org/>.

Agility changes as of January 2nd 2018:

- **24”C** (choice) - class will replace the 26” jump height in the regular division. This class is for dogs who measure 22” and under ONLY but whose handlers chose to enter them at the higher jump height of 24”. Course time for the 24C class will be the same as that for the 20” class. The 24” height division (note not the 24C) is ONLY for dogs who are 22” or OVER at the withers.
- **Pause Table** – There will no longer be a 24” table. **The 24” & 20” classes will now use a 20” table, the 16” classes will use a 16” table, 12” classes will use a 12” table and the 4 & 8” dogs will use an 8” table.**
- **Ascending Double Bar Jump** - which may be used in any of the regulation classes (Novice, Open, Ex/Masters) will consist of 2 ascending bars where the back bar is positioned at the correct jump height for the class and the front bar is set 4” lower. A 3rd bar will be placed under the back bar and angled to the ground.
- **Wall Jump** – may be used in Premier only. This jump consists of 2 pillars, a triangular bottom base, boards and tops. Dogs will be required to jump over the tops between the pillars without displacing any of the tops or boards.

Agility changes as of June 1, 2018:

- **Premier Classes** – will now have a single class level. Dogs eligible to enter Novice, Open or Ex/Masters may now enter the Premier Classes.

Obedience as of May 1st 2018 (videos of the new exercises are viewable at: <https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCOmnrKKiM2kcaowVI3SXeVQ/videos>)

- **General changes:**
 - **Leash** – must be **clipped** to the collar in classes where on-leash exercises are required and when returning for the awarding of ribbons and scores.
 - **Misbehavior** – dog must be under control when entering and exiting ring without jumping, pulling or tugging on lead.
- **Novice** – the “Sit Stay – Get your leash” is a new exercise and the Group exercises have changed:
 - **Sit Stay – Get your leash:** Dog will be left in a sit/stay while handler walks to designated area to pick up leash, turn and face the dog and on the judge’s command will return to the heel position. Command and/or signals may be used to sit and when leaving dog.

- **Group Exercises:** if the dog has gotten a non-qualifying score in the individual exercises the judge **MUST** excuse them from the group exercises. If the dog doesn’t remain sitting during the 1st part of the exercise it **MUST** be excused for the 2nd part. Dogs will be placed in the center of the ring in one row or **BACK to BACK** (minimum of 6’ between the rows) The exercise must be done on a **6’ leash** the will be held by the handler for the entire exercise, with the armband remaining on the handler’s left arm. The leash must remain loose with slack for the entire exercise. The amount of time that the dog must hold the sit and again the down will be **1 minute** for each.
- **Open:** - “Command Discrimination” and “Stay – Get your leash” are both new and replace the out of sight group exercises.
 - **Command Discrimination:** This is a 2 part exercise. This exercise features the dog’s correct response to its handler’s commands and/or signals to sit, down or stand and that the dog stays in place until the handler returns. The dog will be left in either a stand or down, handler leaves and walks 15’ away and faces dog. On the Judge’s signal the handler will ask the dog to change position. On the judge’s command the handler will again turn and walk an additional 15’ then turn and face the dog – the handler may give an additional stay command and/or signal before turning. A third position change will be asked for. The judge will then command the handler to return to heel position; the handler may give an additional stay command and/or signal before returning to the dog. Order of position changes for the “A” class will always be Stand/Down/Sit. In the “B” class the order will vary.
 - **Stay – Get Your Leash:** This is a 2 part exercise. The dog remains sitting or down position for the entire exercise. Handler will leave the dog in the requested position, giving a command and/or signal to sit or down and also when leaving the dog. Handler walks to designated place, 30’ away and faces the dog. After 1 minute the handler will be instructed to return to the dog. Judge will say exercise finished and the 2nd half of the exercise will start. Judge will again give command to sit or down dog and for handler to leave and get leash. Handler will walk directly to leash which is **OUTSIDE** the gate. Handler picks up leash, turns and walks back to the ring stopping at the gate to wait for the judge’s command to return to heel position. In the “A” class the order is always “sit, down” and varies for the “B” class.
- **Preferred Novice** – “Sit Stay – Get Your Leash” has been added and will be judged as in the “Novice Sit Stay Get Your leash”
- **Preferred Open** – “Command Discrimination” and “Stay – Get Your Leash” have been added and will be judged the same as in the Open class.
- **Graduate Novice** – “Stay – Get Your Leash” has been added and will be judged as in the Open A class.
- **Team Class** – “Stay – Get your Leash” and the Group Exercises will be performed as in the Novice group

Delegate's Report

The New Year brings new AKC Board policies. Effective January 1, 2018:

The following Conformation Judging CEU values will be assigned for the attendance of breed specific seminars submitted on applications for additional breeds:

- Hands-On workshop held with National Specialty 3 CEU
- Judges Seminar "only" at Specialty 2 CEU
- Seminar and Hands-On Workshop with Advanced Judging Inst. 3 CEU
- Seminar only at Advanced Judging Inst 2 CEU
- Any other Seminar + Hands-On Workshop 2 CEU
- Any other Seminar only in breed 1 CEU

The Board has approved a policy making it easier for new clubs or clubs that have been inactive for more than 5 years to hold Conformation events. These clubs may be eligible to hold "Mentored Events" that will allow these clubs to fill a void created by a recently dissolved club and award points and titles at their first event. The AKC Club Relations Department will assist clubs through the process. This change in policy can remove the Fun Match requirement for new or inactive clubs.

Effective June 1, 2018:

- Agility Regulation Chapter 11 Section 2 will allow all dogs to enter the Premier Class. Prior to this change only Master level dogs were eligible to compete.

Other policy changes in the areas of Agility and Sweepstake Events are scheduled to be discussed by the Board in February.

exercises. “Stay – Get Your Leash” will be performed in similar fashion to the Drop on Recall where all dogs are left on a stay while leave handlers to get their leashes together.

Scentwork changes as of March 1, 2018:

- **For Alert Confirmations** – No longer using the 6” on any axis for Novice/Advanced or 2” on any axis for Excellent, Master, Detective classes standard. Instead, allowing judges to use their expert opinion to determine whether the dog has worked the odor as close as possible to the hide location.
- **Handler Discrimination Master Class** – Have removed the possibility that the Handler Scent be buried, inaccessible or located higher than 24 inches above the ground.


