
New Master Hunters

Chesapeake Competes in the 2018 Super Retriever Series National Crown Event

In July 2018, Grand Oaks Packin A Pistol MH QA2 (Grand Oaks He’s a Rebel SH X Oak Chess Miley) and I ran our first ever Super Retriever Series Classic Event. I wasn’t sure what to expect but I did some checking and learned that it is a combination of Field Trial, Hunt Test and actual Hunting Scenarios. Since Pistol has done them all and the event was nearby we decided to give it a try.

It was a 3 day event and Pistol was the only Chesapeake competing. When the final scores were tallied, we were very proud that Pistol ended up winning the Amateur Division. This win earned her an invite to the 2018 SRS National Crown Event held in Huntsville, Alabama the first week of November. Not good timing as Pistol and I had been hunting for 2 months prior to the event and didn’t do a lot of training. We made the trip anyway and were proud to represent the Chesapeake breed against an all lab competition.

Pistol got a lot of attention from the spectators and the media as the only non-lab in the competition. It was a lot different than what either



of us was used to with the TV cameras and all of the media folks. We were in 6th place after the first series Field Trial quad and were called back to the second series. That series was a quad with two blinds. After the marks were down you needed to pick up both blinds before the marks. The lines to the blinds were very tight too and under the arc of the marks and over logs and through a number of cover changes. Of course every whistle and any deviation to a straight line to the blinds and marks added points. After the second series they cut to 12 dogs and we were in eleventh so we just made the cut to the third series.



The third series was a hunting scenario with four marks and a blind. After the third series we climbed to 9th place, but unfortunately only the top six could go to the fourth series. I learned a lot and we got a chance to watch some really good dog/handler teams, even if they were labs. We were very proud to represent the Chesapeake Bay Retriever at this National event. Pistol is bred by Jason Linnerud, owned, trained and handled by Tom and Dawn Lind.

Delegate's Report

The December 2018 Delegates Meeting was centered on Dog Show rules, Delegates were presented with 14 different Dog Show Rule change proposals.

The majority of these dealt with the administration and definition of official duties of: judges, show secretaries, superintendents, and veterinarians. These items were passed with broad support.

Two items that sparked debate were changes to Chapter 16 section 1 and Chapter 11 section 8A.

The passage of the change to Chapter 16 section 1, frequently called the 1 + 1 = 1 rule, will benefit not only small entry breeds but will help encourage people to attend shows with traditionally small entries. In the last year, small entries resulting in no available points accounted for over \$250,000 of wasted entry fees by people who decided not to attend after entering because no points were available. This not only discourages participation but also effects the sponsoring clubs due to loss of revenue by vendors etc.

This change allows for sexes to be combined if there is NO point available in BOTH sexes. As always, the dog or bitch awarded Best of Winners will receive the higher number of points awarded to the Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.

The change that has been approved applies to when there are no points available to either the Winners Dog or Winners Bitch. In those instances, the number of regular class dogs in both sexes are added together. When compared to the point schedule, if the total sum of regular class dogs and bitches meets or exceeds the number of competitors needed for one point in its sex, the Best of Winners will receive one championship point.

The proposed changes to Chapter 11 section 8A relating to the identification and reinstatement of dogs disqualified failed to reach the 2/3 threshold needed for amending the current process. The debate will continue on how to properly document, identify and evaluate dogs seeking reinstatement after a disqualifying incident. This issue is not "going away"

An item of interest on the March 2019 agenda is preservation of breed purpose. This will involve looking at how AKC events can better encourage participation in events that show case the function of various breeds, in all groups.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the ACC. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the Code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs, whether in person, on social media or otherwise.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).
