North American Diving Dogs National Championship

North America Diving Dogs (NADD), the dock diving organization affiliated with the AKC, has grown to over 10,000 registered dogs in 2018. The Chesapeake Bay Retrievers had a strong showing in the National Championships in December at the Royal Canin/Eukanuba show in Orlando. The Open Distance jumping divisions are Elite (jumping average of 24' and greater), Master (20'0" – 23'11"), Senior (15'0" – 19'11" feet), Junior (10'0" – 14'11") and Novice (0'1" – 9'11"). Sixteen (16) Chesapeake Bay Retrievers participated in the Open Distance National Championships.

6 Chesapeake Bay Retrievers also earned invitations to the Air Retrieve National Championships. Air Retrieve is an event where a bumper is suspended 2 feet above the dock platform and out a set distance marked on the pool. The object of the competition is for the dog to jump from the end of the dock and knock down the bumper by either biting it or with some part of their body, like a paw or the chin. The farthest distance from the dock for a successful "grab" is the final distance recorded for the placements.







AKC Obedience, Rally & Tracking Changes

AKC Obedience Rule Changes

The following amendments to the Obedience Regulations were approved. Full details can be found in the AKC Obed. Regulations - http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RO2999_0318.pdf

Deaf Dogs (effective 11/1/18) are now allowed to compete in AKC obedience – they have been allowed in Rally, Agility & Tracking since 2015.

Open Class/Preferred Open/Grad. Nov Stay Get Your Leash (effective 01/01/2019):

- Changed from a 2 part Sit/Stay Get Your Leash to a **1 part Stand/Stay** – Get your leash. The handler will now leave the dog in a stand approx. 15' from the ring gate. Handler will walk to a designated spot outside the ring, pick up the lead, re-enter the ring and wait until ordered to return to the dog. Dog must remain standing until judge says exercise finished.

Open Class – Command Discrimination (effective 01/01/2019):

- The handler's hands and arms must hang naturally at the handler's side during this exercise when not signaling/commanding the dog for position changes.
- The judge **MUST** use signals for directing the handler to command/signal position change except for the 1st position.

OTCH Points (effective for all trials held on or after August 1, 2019):

- One (1) Championship point will be recorded for those dogs that earn a qualifying score of 197 or better in the Open B or Utility B class, if they did not earn points based on the Point Schedule.
- The letters OTCH will be followed by a numeric designation indicating the number of times a dog has met the requirements of the OTCH title. (OTCH2, OTCH3, etc.).
- Open B - The point schedule for OTCH points awarded at a trial has changed, go to Chapter 8, Section 5 to review the changes.

AKC Rally Rule Changes

The following amendments to the Rally Regulations were approved. Full details can be found in the AKC Rally regulations - http://images.akc.org/pdf/AKC1193_ROR001_1217_WEB.pdf

Rally Championship (effective February 1, 2019):

- Championship pts and triple qualifying scores will be recorded for dogs after they have earned the RE title and for dogs earning a score of 91 or better in Rally Adv. B, with a minimum of 150 pts being earned from the Master class.
- New title requirements will be grandfathered back to Nov. 1 2017. New title certificates will be generated for any dog that earned the title under the RACH requirements.

AKC Tracking Rule Changes (effective 4-1-19):

The following amendments to the Tracking Regulations were approved. Full details can be found in the AKC Tracking regulations - <http://images.akc.org/pdf/rulebooks/RU9999.pdf>

- **Test Secretary** will be allowed to enter the tracking test they are secretary for.
- **Tracking Certification** – the expiration date for a tracking certificate now extends to 24 months.
- **Tracking Certification Judges** – any person who has put a TDX or VST title on a dog within the past 10 years is now allowed to perform certifications for TD/TDU.
- **Dogs with physical Challenges** – dogs who display no signs of physical discomfort and that can safely complete the test are now allowed to compete. This allows dogs with physical challenges, including amputees, to compete.

CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966. **Winner:** CH RISKY RIVER BODACIOUS Owned by Diane Mazy

DC AFC Tigers' Cub CD Memorial Trophy: Awarded annually to the amateur handler whose Chesapeake earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open and Amateur competition. (The Open points must be earned by an amateur handler.) The trophy was donated to the ACC by Eloise Cherry in 1979 in memory of her dog Tiger's Cub. **Winner:** BILL BURKS

FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner:** CHUGACH'S TYEE Owned by Richard Garner

FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. **Winner:** FIREWEED'S THE KING OF COOL Owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey

The Louis Traung Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.) **Winner:** FIREWEED'S THE KING OF COOL Owned by Linda Harger and Tom Ivey

FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa Chief Trophy: Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Derby competition in the Central and Eastern Time zones. The trophy was donated by Alex Spear in memory of his dog Chip. **Winner:** CAPTAIN THOR'S ONE SHOT ONE KILL Owned by Nick Steen

GUIDELINES for Submitting Your Photos

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMITTING YOUR PHOTOS

We are reprinting the photo submission guidelines as we are receiving photos that do not meet the proper resolution AND image size for reproduction in print. We believe this may be due to the increase popularity/use of mobile devices. Please review the following and, in particular, the requirements for both resolution and image size.

Information to Include With Your Photo

Full name of dog, call name of dog, Sire X Dam, Breeder / Owner / Handler, Name of the Event / Date / Location the title was finished.

Members are entitled to submit one photo and short write-up, limited to 250 words, per dog, per issue. Multiple new titles may be included. The only exception will be if the multiple new titles are earned across two or more disciplines. In this case, two photos may be accepted and word limit is increased to 350. Send your photo(s) and information to the appropriate contributing editor (see page 2 of the Bulletin)

NB: Only show photos submitted by the dog's owner or co-owner of record shall be published unless written permission has been received from the owner or co-owner of record.

For ALL Photo Submissions

If a photographer requires that you provide their name in order to publish their work, be certain to include a photo credit with your submission copy.



For "Hard Copy" Photo Submissions

- Send a good quality photo, preferably 8" x 10" size. Include an appropriate sized, self-addressed, stamped envelope if you would like your photo returned. Please do not send cash or check for return postage.
- Labeling on the back of the photo is very helpful.
- Include a small caption/write up. If possible send the caption via e-mail as well. That way it's just a cut and paste rather needing to be retyped for transmission to the editor.
- Please **DO NOT** submit digital photos that are printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer as all of the passes made by your print head will appear on the photo when scanned. Such scans are not useable.
- If you are not using a photo mailer, please include a cardboard backing to help prevent bending of the photo.
- If you haven't received a photo back after the *Bulletin* it appeared in comes out, please contact the CE that you sent it to.

For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions by E-Mail

- Send the photos as an ATTACHMENT, not in the body of the e-mail.
- Good quality photo images of 300dpi AND minimal image size of 8" x 10", are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*.
- Proper resolution and size will create a JPEG image file size of around 1 MB. If your file size is significantly smaller than 900 KB or 1 MB, then it probably is not 300 dpi or the correct image size and will not be usable.
- Check the settings on your camera / mobile device before taking pictures. There should be a settings feature allowing you to adjust the resolution/pixels; choose the highest setting for best print production. For example: 2400 x 3000 pixels/inch (converts to 300dpi for an 8" x 10" photo).
- Some digital cameras/devices create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. **This is OK.** Just send the unedited file as is. The larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.
- Please **DO NOT** crop or edit your images – that will be done for you. Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.
- If you are scanning a hard copy of a photo, please check your scanner settings for proper resolution and image size, and make certain that you clean your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning.

If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan.

Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the ACC. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the Code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs, whether in person, on social media or otherwise.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.

II. RESPONSIBILITIES OF BREEDERS / BROOD BITCH / STUD DOG (The American Chesapeake Club Board of Directors strongly recommends that only animals with current OFA/CERF/PRA clearances be used for breeding).

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacraft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaapeakes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacraft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


