
Puppy Group Placements


New Senior Hunter

AKC News

Looking to try a few of the newer AKC titles available? Check out the world of agility by participating in an Agility Course Test or see how your dog would fare on a farm by participating at a Farm Dog Certification.

ACT - The Agility Course Test

- ACT - The Agility Course Test is an entry level event designed to introduce and welcome beginning dogs and their handlers to the AKC sport of agility.
- There are two levels of ACT events – ACT1 and ACT2. ACT1 is designed for the beginning level dog to show beginning sequencing and performance skills. ACT2 requires an increased skill level shown by the additional obstacles to be performed.
- In addition to showing their dog's entry level skills, exhibitors will learn to fill out an AKC entry form, check-in at the ring, taking their dog in and out of ring, handling their dog while being judged and other information that will help them when they move on to AKC agility trials with their dog. Dogs must be 15 months old to enter these events. They do not need to be AKC registered at the time of entry.

Farm Dog Certification Program

This test involves your dog performing a series of 12 exercises that are typical for a farm environment such as being in close proximity to livestock (who are always penned to avoid any altercations); jumping and staying on hay/straw bales; walking

on unusual terrain; and jumping over logs. The goal is to assess the dog's aptitude as a working farm dog by exhibiting self-control, confidence and trust with you or his handler.

Your dog must be at least 9 months of age and have an AKC number via **one** of the following:

AKC registration #, PAL #, Canine Partners # or FSS #

Scent work changes

Changes to Buried Class

- All levels will use tubs of substrate (Excellent and Master will no longer be outside buried in the ground).
- All classes have odor 4 inches beneath the surface.
- Novice- 6 tubs of play sand (1 hide)
- Advanced- 8 tubs of water (2 hides) • Excellent- 12 tubs total, 6 play sand, 6 water (3 hides)
- Master- 16 tubs total, 8 play sand, 8 water (1-4 hides)

Increase Consistency, Establish Higher Minimum Standards

- Required separation between "active" search areas (those that have odor)
 - o Container- 20+ feet apart, or physical barrier
 - o Interior- 30+ feet apart, or physical barrier
 - o Exterior- 30+ feet apart, or physical barrier

- o Buried- 20+ feet apart, or physical barrier
- Physical barrier is minimum 6 feet tall and reaches all the way to the ground.
- If crating and searches are in the same room, there must be a physical barrier between.
- Limit reuse of search areas- no more than 7 hides in the same area in a set of trials. Judges must mark location of removed hides with stickers or tape.
- “Nesting” searches is not allowed (if area is reused for another class, hide locations MUST change).
- Area can’t be used as “blank” for a Master search if it was used for odor during that set of trials.
- “Rows” refers to parallel straight-line rows (cannot be angled or offset from each other).

Daily Judging Limit Reason:

- Change from hard numerical max of 125 per day to 8 hours judging time
- Judging Time Calculator to be used to limit entries (similar to Obedience)

Remove Requirement of Hide

- Allow judges to set their own hides for odor classes
- Hide Steward will still be required for Handler Discrimination, since judge’s scent is used for discrimination

Restructure High in Trial

- Handler Discrimination classes not included in High in Trial calculation
- If HIT is offered, clubs must also offer High Combined Division (HCD)- includes all odor classes + handler discrimination

No Special Accommodations for “Reactive” Dogs

- Clubs may dictate lining up and staging of competitors how they see fit; must be the same for all dogs • No blanket rules that dogs are not allowed to interact (except in staging areas or warm-up areas).

Demo Dog

- Reworded to emphasize importance
- Club must make a demo dog available, but judge can choose whatever dog they want to use

Container Types

- Containers should mirror what real-life detection dogs search; luggage, parcels, etc.
- Silly or out-of-place objects shouldn’t be used.
- Containers must be closed so as to “contain” the odor (ex: tote bags are not permissible unless they have a zipper closure).
- Cardboard boxes can be of any construction, but must have seam on the top for the odor to escape

Purina Parent Club Partnership Program

Purina Awards Money to Breed Clubs - Sign Up Now to Maximize the Benefit to our Breed

Do you feed Purina foods? Are you aware of the Purina Pro Club and the Purina Parent Club Partnership Program (PPCP)? If you sign up for these programs and name the American Chesapeake Club as your breed Parent Club, Purina awards points to the Parent Club which equates to dollars that the ACC Charitable Trust can direct to the canine health research, breed education, and rescue.

If you feed Purina foods, please join the Purina Pro Club and be sure to identify the American Chesapeake Club as your Parent Club. There are a few criteria that you must meet to participate in the Pro Club, but many of us meet those criteria. There is no fee to participate and the points that you earn for your parent club are not subtracted from your own reward points. The benefit to the ACC is in addition to your own benefit. To earn points, you simply snap a photo of your dog food receipts and upload them to Purina via their website. For every \$100 of qualifying Purina Points earned by Pro Club members, Purina donates \$10 to the participating national parent club, in which half goes to American Chesapeake Club Charitable Trust and half to the ACC’s Donor Advised Fund at the AKC Canine Health Foundation.

Last year, our club was awarded more than \$3,000, but we are hoping to increase that amount in the future by spreading the word about the program. Under the advisement of the ACC Health Committee, the ACC Board recently directed our Purina Points to research that hopes to improve the accuracy of diagnostic tests for tick-borne diseases. These contributions from Purina can make a big difference.

AKC Delegate Report

There has been a steady decline in entries to most all AKC events. A survey of current participant demographics conducted by the AKC in the venues of Conformation, Conformation NOHS, Agility, Obedience, Rally and Scent Work has revealed:

In Conformation 48% involved have been in the sport for over 20 years while 21% have been involved for 5 years or less.

Agility had the lowest rate of new people with only 6% having 1 year or less involvement.

Most participants listed “bonding with their dog” or “their dog enjoys it” as the determining factor for their involvement. Only Conformation listed “earning titles” as their primary reason for entering.

The new venue of Scent Work was the most popular of sports that people would like to try with the goal of moving onto Tracking.

The Achiever Dog Program has been discontinued. A total of 33,000 certificates were awarded but a survey of the 25000 owners that entered dogs in this program 73% felt that the program did not encourage future entries and the criteria were too easy.

The Airedale Terrier Club of America has applied for eligibility to enter and title in Retriever Hunt Tests. Airedales have already been approved to enter Spaniel Hunt Test and their club has hosted Spaniel Hunt Test.

The AKC awarded \$2.7 million to the Canine Health Fund in 2018. These funds have produced advances in canine oncology, tick diseases, epilepsy, allergies, kidney diseases and others. For complete details see:

I am devoted to this breed, and it is an honor to serve on the board of the club which cherishes and protects it.


