





MBIS GCHS Sandbar's Hardcore Hank MH QAA

The dream of almost every Chesapeake owner is to have a dog that can do it all. With Hank, we're living the dream!

From the beginning, as an eight-week-old pup, it became immediately apparent that he had what it takes. Anybody that knows Hank can see he has confidence, attitude and a big, goofy sense of humor. His personality is what makes him such a fun dog to be around.

During his first year, Hank had no formal gundog training, yet he worked all over the Midwest, hunting with a guide service and showed great promise. At a year of age he joined Adam and Andrew at Next Generation Gundog Training and quickly earned his AKC Junior and Senior Hunter titles. This is when he worked his way into Adam's heart and became his buddy and sidekick.



Before starting his Master work, he took a short hiatus from training to hit the show ring. In just 3 weekends he earned his AKC Championship with 4 majors and 2 Best of Breed wins over Specials. That was just a preview of a big show career to come.

Hank quickly earned his AKC Master Hunter title, passing 6 out of 7 Master tests, which also qualified him for the 2017 Master National. The following year, he easily qualified for the 2018 Master National.

He spent a few weekends during Summer 2018, out as a Special, earning his Grand Championship and a few group placements. At the 2018 ACC National

Show Specialty in Ohio, he earned a Judge's Award of Merit and placed 4th in a very nice and sizable stud dog class.

Hank also spent the same summer training for field trials and the Master National. Fall 2018, he took a trip out West with his buddy Edgar to the ACC National Field Trial Specialty where he earned a Judges' Award of Merit in the Amateur and came home Qualified All Age.

Through the training, testing and showing, Hank spends his falls and early winters as Adam's personal gundog. He does what a Chesapeake is bred for, hunting waterfowl and pheasants in some of the toughest conditions in the Upper Midwest and Canada.

In February, 2019, we decided to see what Hank could do in the Specials ring. We entered him at the Westminster Kennel Club dog show, where he was awarded Select Dog. Shortly thereafter, he won Best Of Breed at the ACC Supported Entry in Birch Run, MI. His show career was coming together pretty quickly, and just three short months after starting his specials career:

"Hank made history, winning his first All-Breed Best In Show! This win made him the first ever Master Hunter titled Chesapeake to win an AKC Best in Show. This honor also made him the only Retriever in AKC history to be a Best in Show winner, who is also recognized as both a Master Hunter and Qualified All-Age."

A few weeks later, Hank earned his second AKC All-Breed Best in Show!

Outside of the ring and the field, Hank has also begun proving himself as an exceptional stud dog. To date, he has produced numerous hunt test-titled offspring, multiple AKC Champions, several group placing offspring and many great all-around hunting dogs.

Hank has a huge group of people to thank for all his success. He is owned by Adam Levy, Andrew Barbouche and Diane Baker. He is trained by Adam, Andrew and Nate Stahl at Next Generation Gundog Training. He was bred by Diane Baker of Sandbar Chesapeakes. He was handled at the ACC Field Trial Specialty by Edgar Johnson. He is flawlessly handled in the show ring by Devon Kipp. He also has a big group of devoted fans that cheer him on, in every venue, from week to week. Thank you to everyone who has had a part in this incredible journey. We couldn't do it alone. It's been quite a ride and we know the best is yet to come!

Agility

Changes effective June 19, 2019:

- Head Halters are no allowed on the grounds when dog is being brought to the ring for it's run

Changes Effective January 1, 2020:

- Weavepoles will no longer be striped by tape, stripes must either be painted or poles may be alternating solid colors
- A dog may be entered in a mixture of regular and preferred classes within the same trial day/weekend (ex. Master Preferred STD & regular Master FAST)
- A dog may be entered in a mixture of jump heights within the same trial day/weekend (ex. 20" Master STD & 24C Master FAST)

AKC FIT DOG program

AKC implemented the AKC FIT DOG program in the Fall of 2018, where owners who walk a specified distance with their dogs can receive a free AKC FIT DOG car magnet. Dog groups/clubs may also be AKC FIT DOG clubs where they offer group fitness walks and/or conduct scheduled canine fitness/conditioning classes. 


supporting him! Cooper is owned, bred and loved by Karen and Jim Brown.

NACSW Element Titles: Exteriors (L1E), Vehicles (L1V), and Interiors (L1I)

"Derby" U-NC U-NV U-NI CH Sandbar's Demolition Derby @ Riverdel, NW1 L1E L1V L1I RATO RI CGC SWN SCA SIA SHDN (BIS BISS GCH Sandbar's Stock Exxchange x CH Sandbar's and Then...) completed his AKC Scent Work Handler Discrimination Novice title (SHDN) on April 28 at Burlington County Kennel Club's trial in Mt. Laurel, NJ. To earn the Handler Discrimination (HD) title, a dog must qualify 3 times by finding an article scented by the handler. In the Novice search, the article is a cotton glove placed in one of 10 boxes. One of the other 10 boxes contains an article scented by the judge. The dog needs to locate the handler's scent only, discriminating it from all other scents, and indicate this find to the handler. Derby has taken to HD, all 3 of his Qs were fast, 20 seconds or less (time allowed is 2 minutes). Later in the spring, we made the draw in a couple of nearby NACSW trials hosted by SPOG. On May 18 in Milford NJ he earned his Exterior Element title with his usual flair, on the first of the four required searches he picked up a water bottle spraying water all over, then turned around nailing source! He was all business for the afternoon trial earning his Interior Element trial with speed and ease. At the New Hope Vehicle trial on June 15 he was fast and accurate despite it being a very hot and sunny day, earning his Vehicle Element title with placements. In between all



this we decided to fit in a Canine Good Citizen Test on May 31st, which proved fun as the evaluator had several people in the crowd exercise carry luggage, one a rolling piece of luggage. PROTECT YOUR PETS FROM HARMFUL ALGAL BLOOMS



What are cyanobacteria and harmful algal blooms?

Cyanobacteria (also called blue-green algae) and algae can form harmful algal blooms (HABs) in lakes, ponds, and rivers. Many HABs produce toxins that can harm animals and people. The water may have a scum or be discolored (e.g., green, blue, yellowish, red, or brown). Some blooms may occur along the bottom of the waterbody or become detached and float to the surface or along the shoreline. A [visual factsheet](#) is available to help the public identify HABs.¹ To learn more, visit the [California HABs Portal](#).



How can dogs be exposed to HABs?

- By swimming in lakes, rivers, ponds or any affected water body, drinking the water, or eating algal material. Animals are attracted to the taste and smell of HABs. Dogs lick algae caught in their coat after being in the water. Dogs that scavenge around the shore may ingest drying clumps of algae.
- By consuming water and algal material from residential pools or decorative ponds.
- By ingesting health supplements containing blue- green algae, which may unintentionally include HAB toxins.

How can I keep my dog safe from HABs?

- Do not let your dog drink, wade, or swim in water with a HAB present.
 - Check if a waterbody has a reported bloom by viewing the [HAB Report Map](#), contacting the waterbody manager, and looking for [posted advisory signs](#).¹
 - Check for visual signs of a HAB.¹
 - If you are still unsure whether a bloom is a HAB, keep pets away from the water.

- Never let your dog eat scum or algae.
- Always wash your pets with clean water after water contact.



What are signs of possible cyanobacterial toxin poisoning in dogs?

Animals can experience symptoms within minutes to days following exposure to the toxins. Symptoms include vomiting, diarrhea, weakness, difficulty breathing, seizures, or death. In 2017, there were 18 reported dog deaths from suspected HAB-related exposures in California.

If your pet experiences these symptoms after exposure, contact your veterinarian immediately. A [veterinarian fact sheet](#) on diagnosis and potential treatment is available. For additional assistance, contact the 24-hour ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center hotline at (888) 426-4435. A \$65 consultation fee may be applied.

ACC Rescue Update



 - 3. Health Committee – GiGi Grant (ID) Dr Jim Stewart reported: The isolation and identification of gene mutations identified as Chondrodystrophy Mutation (CDDY) and Chondroplasia Mutation (CDPA) present physical changes for puppy watchers.

The presence of a normal puppy at birth that changes in weeks to being too small, or too short of leg and too curved of leg or having a normal body but having a reduction of the shape and size of legs, bent in the curvature of the spine at an early age.

These physical signs come from a series of genetic mutations having the designation of Chondrodystrophic (CDDY), Chondrodysplastic (CDPA) and having certain retrogenes that when attached on certain canine chromosomes cause premature and

excessive calcification and herniation of discs.

The existence of these genes may have been present for centuries in the dog genome. The positive accurate association with the CBR and this gene has only been confirmed beyond a genetic doubt since 2009 and 2017. Primary confirmation came from the famous Bannasch Lab of the Veterinary Genetics Lab at Cal/Davis.

Before you look for a ledge don't be too nervous. The testing (genetic) is excellent. You can accurately find what if anything you are carrying and if you are thoughtful you should be able to avoid significant problems with phenotypes and genotypes.

The Health Committee has tried to give good advice as we try to understand the genetic mixes that can arise. It is our plan to have both a technical and functional explanation of what could happen and how to handle it.

Until then feel free to call, beware of over descriptive under informative terms like dwarf. Do not think that our dogs are suddenly going to look like Dachshunds or Bassets. It will take a lot of mistakes to bring this around. Hopefully these mistakes will be eliminated before they are spread.

- 4. Hunt Test Committee – Pat Baughman (NE) The Chesapeake Only Hunt Test in conjunction with the National Field Trial Specialty will not happen this year, will be looking at doing this in the future after doing some research and speaking with all involved.
- 5. Judge Breeder Education Committee (JBEC) Committee – Gina Downin (MD) Betsy Horn Humer reported: Have contacted the JBEC members. We are deciding what to offer at the 2019 NSS in Auburn, WA. Have been in contact with Janice Krogstadt, Chair concerning this and making arrangements to schedule the Judges Seminar/ Workshop during the National Show Specialty in September. We are making up a questionnaire to send to all mentors, asking for recent participation and upcoming availability for future seminars, including plans to attend the NSS in September.
- 6. Lifetime Achievement Award Committee – Ed Bahr (AL) Mike Pickett reported the LTA has not received any nominations to date for 2019. Recently, three members of the committee were reaffirmed by the ACC Board to extend their tenure on the LTA.
- 7. Show Committee – Gina Downin (MD) Michelle Keehn reported: We have 16 supported entries for 2019. New shows added since last report Durham, Clarksville, and North East Indiana Kennel Club.

We are looking to find a replacement for GiGi Grants position on the show committee because her time is up.

CODE OF ETHICS – AMERICAN CHESAPEAKE CLUB

Love / respect of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever is implicit in membership in the ACC. Therefore, all members agree to foster the goals set forth in the Code of Ethics.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES OF MEMBERS

- a. Read / familiarize yourself with the American Chesapeake Breed Standard for the Chesapeake Bay Retriever that is approved by the American Kennel Club. Support / abide by the rules of the American Chesapeake Club / The American Kennel Club.
- b. Appreciate the unique nature of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / try to develop the characteristics this dog has inherited through selective breeding (intelligence, desire to mark / retrieve with style, love of water / keen scenting ability).
- c. Assume the responsibility of proper feeding, maintenance, health care, and training at all times.
- d. Always conduct yourself in a manner which will reflect credit on yourself / the breed. Refrain from public criticism or malicious degrading of other or their dogs, whether in person, on social media or otherwise.
- e. Never knowingly sell or place a Chesapeake Bay Retriever with unethical persons or those who would not provide proper / humane care to the dog. Refuse to sell any Chesapeake Bay Retriever to any pet shop or to any wholesale dealer in dogs.
- f. Should you become aware of the mistreatment, abuse or need for relocation of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever, make every effort to be of assistance by notifying the breeder of the dog involved, the appropriate local authorities / helping in any other way in which you are able.

- a. Do not breed Chesapeake Bay Retrievers that are not registered by the American Kennel Club or by kennel clubs recognized by the American Kennel Club.
- b. Strive in each breeding to improve the breed according to the ACC Breed Standard. Conscientiously plan each breeding, based on parents of appropriate temperament, appearance / other desirable qualities.
- c. Be aware of genetic defects which can be harmful to the breed. When breeding, endeavor to select animals that will reduce the incidence genetic problems while enhancing the positive attributes / abilities of the breed. Be open with all persons interested in the welfare of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever / discuss possible physical or temperament defects in your own stock.
- d. Do not breed any bitch who is not mature (never before the second heat) or in good health. Do not allow puppies to go to their new homes until at least 7 weeks of age.
- e. Act responsibly toward all puppies produced by your brood bitch or stud dog for the lifetime of the puppies. (Recommend that the breeder encourage the owner to contact him if he can no longer keep a dog at any time in the dog's life).
- f. Understand that written contracts are strongly recommended for all transactions, such as sales, guarantees, co-ownerships, breeding rights agreements, bitch leases, stud services, etc. Keep accurate records / pedigrees / give new owners registration papers or forward as soon as possible.
- g. Use / promote the use of the American Kennel Club non-breeding registration on pet quality puppies which are sold or placed by you.
