Rule Changes to AKC Obedience

- Effective September 4, 2019
 - Obedience Brace classes will now allow two dogs of ANY breed that are of similar height at the withers to be entered in the Brace class.
- Effective September 4, 2019 (must be compliant by Jan. 1, 2020)
 - Dogs will now be required to be judged in either ascending or descending order.
 - Regular Open and Preferred Open classes will be combined for judging.
 - Regular Utility and Preferred Utility classes will be combined for judging.
 - A Judge's ring assignment (ring #) will now be allowed to be changed if the assigned ring is running behind schedule and another ring is available and meets the original ring requirements.
 - Classes requiring a walkthrough will now be combined if the same judge is judging classes with the same set up structure and there are fewer than 20 dogs combined. Start time will be published for both classes in the judging schedule.
 - Load balancing (evening the number of dogs judged) will now be allowed after entries close if among other things the judge and AKC approve such changes before the judging program is published.

Rule Changes to AKC Agility

(these are pilot programs and will be evaluated in one year)

- Effective Jan. 1, 2020
 - For Exhibit Only (FEO) – no dog will receive a qualifying score when running FEO and will only be allowed as an option in the FAST and T2B classes at the **option of the host club & must appear in the premium list**. Handlers must notify the scribe and judge as they enter the ring prior to the start of their run. When running FEO the handler may use a toy as a reward; however the toy may NOT leave the handler's possession or be thrown. No food, squeaky toys or balls may be used. A piece of equipment may be done multiple times and the handler may touch it, including resetting bars. Judge and crew remain in the ring during an FEO run.
 - Fix and Go On – At any time during a run the handler may immediately fix a single obstacle ONE time. The handler may go back up to 2 obstacles prior to the fix. Once the Fix and Go has been used the handler/dog must finish the course or exit the ring.

New AKC Title

- AKC Temperament Test (ATT) testing may start November 1, 2019
 - The ATT will assess a dog's reaction to stimuli in the following 6 categories: Social, Auditory, Visual, Tactile, Proprioceptive and Unexpected Stimulus.
 - The ATT will test for fear, shyness, inability to recover and lack of cooperation. Dogs showing signs of aggression will not pass.
 - The test is a pass/fail and the dog must pass 3 test items in each of the 6 categories. The 18 items will be selected from a list of 24 possible items.
 - Dogs must be at least 1 yr. old and be registered or listed with the AKC prior to taking the test.

Lifetime Achievement

Nomination of Jane Pappler for the ACC Lifetime Achievement Award

Jane Pappler got her first Chesapeake, Petunia, in 1974 and joined the ACC shortly after. She bred her first litter in 1977 and kept a male pup. In 1979, Jane made her debut in the NSS ring with that first Redlion dog and at the end of the day, he received the final nod from the judge and was awarded Best of Breed! He went on to become CH Redlion's J J Sample, Am/Can CD, Am/Can WD.

From the beginning, Jane set herself on a course to prove that a dog can have both exceptional breed conformation and proven working ability. She has made a point of showing that she can accomplish great things in the show ring and in the field with the SAME dog and with Jane as handler in both. A few examples:

- Am/Can Ch* Taraglen Buckshot's Legacy***c, CWCX, WDQ, CGC - "Ripper" was an Am/Can Champion with group placements, an Am/Can QAA and a FT placement in the Open.
- Am GCH, Can CH Redlion's Notorious Wren***c QA2, MH, WDQ, CGC - "Wren" was a Grand Champion in the US and a Champion in Canada. In the field, she was a QAA and a MH.
- SUCH/Am/Can CH Redlion's Hit Doctor**c Am/Can MH, WDQ - "Joe" was a CH/MH in three countries (U.S., Canada, and Sweden) with qualifying placements.
- CH* Redlion's Bear of Upper Creek** WDX - "Bear" was the first Chesapeake with a Group 1 and AKC All-Breed licensed Field Trial Completions.

Jane has clocked an enormous number of hours volunteering for our club. She was an ACC Regional Director in NJ for 16 years. She held training days, eye clinics, a supported show, many WD/X/Q's and the club's first three breed seminars ever held. Jane also served as Program Chair for the club's Working Dog Program.

Jane has also made a significant contribution to the future of the breed by mentoring people. She welcomes anyone to pull up a chair ringside at a dog show or in the gallery at a hunt test. Jane is a natural teacher and anyone who has ever been lucky enough to sit with Jane has walked away with a deeper understanding of our breed. Additionally, Jane encourages everyone to join the ACC and to serve the club.

What can we all learn from Jane about stewardship of our breed?

- Breed for a dual-purpose dog and then go out and show the world what they can do.
- Work hard for your club so that your club can best serve the breed you love.
- Give your time freely to anyone who wants to learn about Chesapeakes so that your breed has a strong future.

A. Standing Committees

1. Companion Events Committee – Lynda Barber-Wiltse (AK) Doreen Palmer reported: Nothing to report.
2. Field Trial Committee – Ed Bahr (AL) NFTS set for November 5-7, 2019, at Pin Oak Kennels in Ravenna, TX. Have a block of rooms at host hotel. RV parking set up. Raffle and auction items coming in. Still looking for volunteers. Things are moving forward.
3. Health Committee – GiGi Grant (ID) Dr Jim Stewart reported: This report is directed to the President and Board of the ACC. There are multiple reports on research being done that involve the ACC. Because Bloat has been studied for the last 3 years, it is the first report.

The key research on this subject continues to come from two sources. One is by Dr. Michael Harkey at the Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center in Seattle Washington. His work continues to be substantial and follows a different diagnostic path than the course taken by the research group at Tufts Veterinary School.

This difference in approach allows a broader approach into different areas by two highly qualified institutes with multiple grant pursuits, different areas of interest and great experience in fund raising. They both have had close oversight by Dr. Diane Brown CEO of CHF who also has been very supportive of the ACC's deep interest in this project. I truly think an answer to our Bloat problem will come from one of these 2 groups.

Our second major area of interest involve the discovery of genes involving Chondrodystrophy, Chondrodysplasia and certain retrogenes that are involved with spontaneous gene mutation.

We will shortly have results done by the Genetic Analysis group at Cal/Davis headed by Dr. Danika Bannasch. This should clarify the extent of the presence of significant new genes in our dogs, if any. This review will give access to over 100 samples that cover dogs of broad usage, disperse pedigrees, broad geography and random selection not targeting a specific gene pres-

ence. It will give anonymity to all subjects but will have accurate results in terms of presence and absence of genes including their strength of activity.

Our access to the Bannasch Lab and the clarification of the technical information we have received on gene activity, spontaneous mutation involving retrogenes was the direct result of contacts made by Julie Cole of the Health Committee and Diane Mazy by way of Charitable Trust. This information should clarify many questions on the possible impact of new genes to our breed.

Obviously, there are other subjects being reviewed and discussed. The areas commented in detail are key for the moment. The others need more investigation.

4. Hunt Test Committee – Pat Baughman (NE) Follow up on two judges that were not eligible currently for the future hunt test. Pat will follow up with Johnny Fogle regarding the hunt test in March and if he is stepping down from this. Communication on a Chesapeake Only Hunt Test in conjunction with a Specialty for the future.
 - Master National Retriever Club and Master Amateur Retriever Club – Pat Baughman will ask Dale Langhorne (ID) if he would like to be the liaison for both of these.
5. Judge Breeder Education Committee (JBEC) Committee – Gina Downin (MD) Working on getting mentors in place for the Washington Specialty. Committee will work on a motion for approved policy for attending and participating in ring side judge mentoring at a National Show Specialty for the Board to review and vote on via email. The committee will also be working on a mentoring program for breeders as well.



He was known to always have a brown dog or two nearby, but perhaps best known for running and titling his friend Bob Ferguson's Chesapeake Happy, aka MHR HRCH Fergies Happy Time MH QAA (Sir Chesapeake Newport x Bonnie Pagan Lass) a dark brown male bred by Thomas B. Gray and whelped 7/16/1982. Happy was the first Chesapeake to earn the then-new AKC hunting test title of Master Hunter in 1986 and the first retriever of any breed to earn all 3 master level titles: AKC MH, NAHRA MHR (North American Hunting Retriever Club Master Hunting Retriever) and UKC's HRCH (Hunting Retriever Champion). For good measure Happy was also Qualified All Age from finishes in AKC licensed field trials.



Hopkins graduated from Poquoson High School in 1942 and attended Campbell College. He worked as a waterman on the Chesapeake Bay prior to his employment at the Naval Weapons Station in Yorktown, where he worked for 32 years until retiring in 1989. He is survived by his wife of 73 years, Rose Marie Hopkins, three of his 4 sisters, his children Joyce Hopkins Wilburn of Yorktown, Anne Claire Hopkins Conner of Seaford,

Kevin Ray Hopkins of Los Angeles, CA. and David C. (Chris) Hopkins of Seaford and their spouses, plus 8 grandchildren that he adored.

Dual Champion Sodak's Gypsy Prince - Breeder: Rev. Schuster; Owner: Chesacroft Kennel (A. Bliss); Trainer: Charles Morgan. "Prince" was the first dual champion retriever of any retrieving breed. He was the second Chesapeake to make a field title. Prince was a medium sized deadgrass dog with an intense desire to work especially in icy water. He had a lifetime total of 14 pts. Today all field trial Chesaupes trace back to Prince through his son Chesacroft Baron ***.

FC Shagwong Gypsy - Breeder: C A Smith; Owner & Trainer: E. Monroe Osborne. "Gypsy" was the first Chesapeake bitch to earn a field trial championship (1939). She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.


