Wow, we are still riding that NSS high! We have had ups and downs and multiple challenges along the way which made this win so emotionally poignant for us. Rowan came from a miraculous emergency c-section/spay, losing more than half of her littermates in the process. Unashamedly, I/we cried when Judge Nathaniel Horn turned around and pointed at us. At that moment, the



initial heartache of that litter, the long hours of hovering, worrying over the ones that survived, and the work that followed were worth everything we poured into raising those puppies. Our hearts could not have been more swollen with pride with Rowan's win.

From the beginning, we saw amazing potential in Rowan. Our beliefs were confirmed when at the 2016 NSS under Judge Betsy Horn Humer and Sweepstakes Judge Annette Monugian, Rowan won both her conformation and sweeps 6-9 month puppy classes. In the words of Judge Humer in the Jan/Feb 2017 Bulletin, Rowan was "a well-balanced and well-angulated dark brown puppy bitch possessing a lovely neck into shoulders. She showed depth of brisket at her young age and moved well around the ring. She is definitely a youngster to keep an eye on." Little

did we know Judge Humer's brother, Nathaniel Horn, would also recognize Rowan's qualities 3 years later, giving her a new Grand Championship title with her NSS BOB win.

The journey here would not have been possible without the many decades of dedication of breeders behind the generations in Rowan's lineage. We are fortunate and grateful to have their hard work represented in what our kennel produces today. Passively, we have had many informal mentors play a role in our years in this breed. We have been able to be voyeurs, to learn vicariously through others' wins and losses, triumphs and trials. In person and in media, we watched and studied dogs and their photos, videos, and pedigrees. Thank you to all who have been willing to share their experiences. Your knowledge and experience reach farther than you know.

A special thank-you to Judge Nathaniel Horn for not only judging a large group of beautiful Chessies at this year's NSS, but for recognizing the individual strengths and attributes in all of his chosen winners. Undoubtedly, these decisions did not come easy with all the wonderful dogs in the ring. We thank you for choosing our Rowan for your Best of Breed winner. Our hearts overflow with gratitude and awe.

Thank you also to all our family and friends who were so supportive and helpful through the years. Persistence and hard work pay off, but success isn't possible without a support team. So thank you to all of you from the bottom of our hearts.

I know it takes a tremendous amount of dedication, effort and time to organize a National Specialty. This includes the venue, premium list, catalog, trophies, advertisement, and much more. The class dogs were composed of mostly younger dogs. There were a total of 8 dogs present and a couple of absentees. Both winners dog and reserve winners dog came from the 12 MOS & under 18 MOS. Winners Dog: Next Generations Defending the Line. Bred by Adam Levy, Emory Ivey shown by Devon Kipp. This is a nice deadgrass dog, with sound movement and a pleasing head. He is well coated. Aridawn's Madison owned, bred and handled by Patricia Martin. He possesses a dense coat, brown in color, and moves with a balanced gait. He displays a biddable expression.

The class bitch entry was much larger. A total of 26 bitches competed from the entry of 32. Winners Bitch: Next Generations Moonshine Still is a medium brown colored bitch, with a well-proportioned body, good coat, and a great attitude. She won the award from the 12 MOS & under 18 MOS. The reserve winner's bitch is also a pretty bitch with a color of a slightly lighter shade of brown with a dense coat, and a pleasing head. Both bitches move well.

I enjoyed the non-regular classes, Veterans, Field Trials, and Hunting. Veteran classes showed us the joy and presence of the older dogs that loved being there once again. Strength and endurance of the Field Trial and Hunting Dogs prove that Chesapeakes are successfully bred to perform the work and purpose intended for this breed.

Best of Breed Class was large. It included WB, WD and all the winners from the non-regular classes. I made several cuts before making my final choices. The Best of Breed Bitch just "blew me away", on all counts!!! – Outstanding coat, head and head features, outline, movement, hare feet, etc. Her name, CH Skywatcher Dulin's Irish Ire owned by Michelle Junevitch and Michon Nederlander. A close call for BW went to the pretty bitch. Best of Opposite went to an outstanding male named GCHC Poissett's Doctor Mallard owners Annie and Pauline Henshaw, showed by Annie. This dog is just magnificent. He is now of older age but has still got it all. Very nice head and expression with correct eyes, balance of skull and muzzle. This dog has charisma! Select Dog GCHB Birch Meadow Just Add Water JH TKA CA CGC, is a nice handsome deadgrass male well proportioned and of good type. Select Bitch and Best NOHS, GCHS CH Chesacola's Capricious Cameo BN RN CGC possesses one of the nicest coats of the day, attractive dark reddish sedge color, pleasing head and outline. The four Award of Merits gives the judge a way to choose honorable mentions and they are as noted: CHG CH Riversedge Jumping Jack Flash RN JH CGC AD owned by Nancy Rickerson, GCHB Birch Meadow Under the Flower Moon SH JH BN RN CA CGC owned by Bert and Catherine Keeler. The Hunting Class Bitch GCH CH Coolwater's Roane Point CD BN RE NA NAJ SH owned by Laorea Griggs. Veteran Bitch 8-10 GCH CH Dut-Cheese Rozy's Sweet Magnolia SH UD MX MXJ XF RA WDQ RATN owned by Jill and Roy Conway. Best Bred By Red Water's Fly Me to the Moon owned by Sheri Boretzky, Bryan Boretzky, and Heidi Mckenn. As a Breeder/Owner/Handler and Judge of Chesapeake Bay Retrievers, I look for a well-proportioned Chesapeake, with the strength to do the work he is bred to perform. He should not have too much or not enough substance. I prefer an athlete with a quality coat, a pleasing head and correct head features. He must possess sound movement with reach and drive and the ability to swim well.

We need to continue to strive for quality coat, head with both intelligent and pleasing expression and the movement of an athlete. Areas to work on are: the appropriate proportion and outline, hare feet (not cat feet), and a continued goal toward quality and balance. Please keep in mind the balance is one that includes full liberty of action in the front and an essentially good strong rear. Condition is of utmost importance. Good muscle tone comes from proper exercise, diet, and quality of life.

Lastly, I enjoyed judging the Junior Showmanship. The junior exhibitors and their dogs were a pleasure as the juniors thoroughly enjoyed showing their dogs.

Again, many thanks for giving me this great honor to judge the Chesapeake Bay Retriever National Specialty. I truly loved judging these great dogs, the best breed in the world, Chesapeake Bay Retrievers. The dogs, committees, and exhibitors were a delight. Sportsmanship and harmony amongst exhibitors was genuine and nice to see. I would also like to thank my family: my wife Myra Horn, my sisters Betsy Horn Humer and Margi Palmer, and my belated parents (Dan and Janet Horn) for their support throughout the years.

The American Chesapeake Club offered not one but TWO Obedience and Rally trials at this year's NSS! The Obedience & Rally trials were held indoors at the Argus Ranch for Dogs facility in Auburn, WA. The facility offered ample room for crating, hard packed dirt for the rings and parking was very close. An added bonus: Lunch was offered at one end of the building! The weather cooperated during the long, busy day, with highs in the low 80's during the afternoon.

Betsy Horn Humer was the judge for the first Obedience trial Thursday morning. Mary Jane Shervais judged Rally. In the afternoon, the two judges switched. Both judges expressed their enjoyment at judging the many exhibitors at our two trials. And many exhibitors reported how much they had appreciated the two judges' efforts in evaluating teams in two trials with good-sized entries.

Charlene Cordiero won both the Challenge Trophy for going High in Trial with GCH Marnetts Bayside History Repeats JH RA (with a score of 193) and the Novice B class (earning her the CH Marnetts Grant My Wish JH UDX RE Memorial Trophy).

Obedience Judge's Comments

It all began in Feb. 2018 when I had a judging assignment at Argus Ranch in Auburn, WA. My sister, Margi Palmer, joined me in Seattle 3 days prior to judging. With the able navigating ability of Janice Krogstad we saw many of the great sights of Seattle. Janice mentioned that she was thinking about putting in an application for the 2019 NSS. I suggested that she look into the Argus Ranch Facility. Fast forward several months later and it was a signed deal with a Specialty Show Committee and a show site in place.

When I was invited to judge obedience & Rally I did not hesitate to accept. I knew I would not be making the drive cross-country

to show a dog. I have served as Obedience chair half a dozen times but had never judged obedience at our National. Rupe and I were always exhibiting, especially in Team competition. We decided to do back-to-back trials for both obedience & Rally. The results were overwhelmingly successful. Fellow judge, Mary Jane Shervais, and I started at 8:30 a.m. and finished around 7:00 p.m. that night. There were 28 obedience entries plus two Teams in Trial #1. Trial #2 had 25 entries and four Braces. In Rally there were 45 entries in each trial, plus 3 Rally Teams and 2 Rally Pairs.

Obedience results for the "official #1 Trial" were very successful. There was at least one qualifier in every obedience class and some finished new titles. High in Trial came from Novice B – GCH Marnetts Bayside History Repeats JH, RA and handler, Charlene Cordiero and Annette Monugian. High Combined was awarded to TattleTails Autumn Guide, UD, PCDX, Re, JH, CGCU and owner Brenda KC Owens, bred by Paul Gilmore. They earned a total score of 370 out of a possible 400 points, placing 1st in both Open B and Utility B.

Team was the usual hilarity especially because with Team #1 there was constant switching of dogs and handlers, once the dogs were off-leash. Seems that one handler, had two dogs and the "stand-in" handler for the 2nd dog just did not have the appeal that the actual owner did. One of the dogs decided to leave said substitute and go over and heel with its owner. The same thing happened on the Drop on Recall. When the dog was called – it went to the "real" owner instead of the other handler. When all was said and done on the Drop on Recall – one handler had two dogs – However, they did pull it all together for the Stay exercise and the Team had a perfect score on Stays. Team #2 – life guards with "sharks". . . were the ultimate winners with a very good performance – passing on two of the Drop on Recalls and some really good heeling. They scored just over 700 points out of a possible 800.

Let's not forget the workers – volunteer stewards stepped up to the plate on the day – Margi Palmer found herself at the obedience table from the time she stepped into the building until the last class was over. Other exhibitors jumped in and helped once they had competed. It was a revolving door, but it all came together.

My own personal thoughts on judging only Chesapeake Bay Retrievers is "the Best" It was so great to see each time enter the ring ready to show. I knew most of the exhibitors, and after the day had ended, I knew them all. I think everyone enjoyed themselves, qualify or not. Several exhibitors told me they would not have entered but because they knew me, they would feel more comfortable in the ring. This was one of my Top 3 judging experiences.

The "finale" occurred at the dinner Saturday night. Charlene and Annette asked me if they could re-donate the High in Trial Trophy, since one of them had the required three legs and could retire it. It is totally acceptable and that is what Sue Cone had done when she retired it previously. She re-donated the trophy and re-named it. Legs won prior to 2019 are not counted. The new count will start at the 2020 NSS to be held in York, PA in October. See you there!

Agility Trial Report

2019 ACC NSS All Breed Agility Trial Report

The All Breed Agility Trial was one of the leadoff events at our 2019 National Show Specialty (along with Dock Diving). Chesapeake and their people drove from the four corners of the USA to mingle with local Pacific Northwest agility enthusiasts. We had a nice turnout for a mid-week trial – 64 dogs entered in 181 runs. Judge Gillian Crawford set up great courses and Trial Secretary Lori Sage kept track of all the official paperwork and kept us moving. Thank you to all the volunteers!

Eight Chesapeakes were entered and 6 competed (Lynda's Koy came into season and missed competing in all events at the NSS and Rob and Jill's Callie was carrying her pups). The 6 Chesapeake teams were: Rob Conroy/Brody (GCH CH Dut-Chesse Spark Of Susquidilla CDX BN RA JH MX AXJ OF CGC TKI) and Jill Conroy/Maggie (GCH CH Dut-Chesse Rozy's Sweet Magnolia UD BN RA SH MX MXJ MJB XF TKI) (New York), Stacy Hanley/Piper (Laurelwood's Operating Under The Radar BN RN JH) (Florida), Annette Monugian/Roxy (Marnetts Schoolhouse Rock CD BN RE JH MX MXJ NF T2B) (California), Lynda Barber-Wiltse/Kach (GCH CH MACH Eastern Waters' Nuka Bay Kachemak VCD1 PCD BN RM2 RAE3 MXB MJB XF T2B CA DJ TKI) and Deshka (GCH CH Nuka Bay's Deshka River Mexicana NF TKI) (Alaska). Rescue Update

ACC Rescue has been busy with a number of dogs in the past few weeks. We have been working to place two young males in North Texas. One has a wonderful new home on a ranch in Texas, while another boy is headed to Montana to become an emotional support dog for wonderful young lady. Both of these dogs ended up with ACC Rescue due to a family emergency.

We pulled a very nice male from a Minnesota Shelter. He was at a foster home and had begun to have seizures after a few weeks. He was placed on medication and his seizures were controlled and he was thriving. On the weekend, he had three seizures in a row and he was admitted to the Emergency Clinic in St. Paul on September 7th. Bodee was in ICU and tests and medication were administered. He became very aggressive as he was recovering, with fluid in his brain. The decision was made that Euthanasia was what was best for this sweet boy. His foster family was with him in the end. We lost this sweet boy but still have a bill that even after a discount for rescue that came to \$1,904.09. I would do exactly what we did again if in the same situation. This was a very tough day of all involved. Making a decision like this is one that I made with the Foster Family and upon the recommendation of his Veterinarians. Of course people can always second-guess the call but I know that it was the only way for Bodee to be free.



We also pulled sweet Higbee from a shelter who had been surrendered in terrible condition. Her owner is facing charges from the Human Society for neglect. She is improving but had to have surgery to have a mass removed and we are waiting on the results. Hopefully, they will be positive.




We have a significant bill for her surgery and treatment. We have solicited and received over \$400.00 in donations for her, but as you can see, this all comes at an expense. She is a sweetheart and to give her a second chance to be loved and live is a call that I made. Yes, expensive, but that is what rescue is about.



This last week we were in search of a new home for a beautiful male in Maryland. No fault of his own Deacon found himself in need of

a new home. His family had added two new children and Deacon needed more structure and training than he had received. He also was protective of his toys so there was a concern for two small children. With the help of Facebook we worked with his breeder to find him a new forever home. Brandon who recently lost his dog in a divorce was truly rescued by Deacon. They were perfect for each other as you can see!



We are very successful with the ease of Facebook in finding and matching the right home with the right dog. Multiple people are involved in looking at applications and the placement of dogs in need of new homes. If a dog with a bite history, of a mix will be brought to our attention, this information is shared with other Chesapeake Rescue organizations. Our breed is fortunate to have two very dedicated groups working for our breed.

This has all been in just a few short weeks. I like to focus on the positive whenever possible. Bodee was admitted while I was at the Banquet for the Show Specialty in Washington. I don't always have time to call members of a committee and ask for opinions. I do what I feel is right for that dog and that situation. I have a wealth of individuals who share their expertise when dealing with individual dogs. I do run medical concerns or often ask for input from Dr. Marlene Drag DVM and her husband Dr. Bruce Ahlers DVM who freely share their expertise, often at all hours of the day or night.

I would also like to welcome Steve Webb to the Rescue Committee and Team! Steve has been involved in rescue previously and will be assisting as an East Coast point of contact. Steve's email is parkesridg@aol.com

Our breed is also very fortunate to have the ACC Charitable Trust who adopted as part of their mission statement to "ensure the humane and effective rescue of any Chesapeake Bay Retriever in need." The financial support from the ACC Charitable Trust and all of the members of the Chesapeake Community make it possible for us to give a dog that second chance to live and be loved!

CBR Database News

Wait, CBR Database... what? How many databases are out there? The answer: only ONE that is sponsored and maintained by our parent club, The American Chesapeake Club, to include only information from validated, official sources.

Formerly known as the ACC Health Tests Database, the breed club database has grown to include more than just health data. While collecting health data will still be front and center, the inclusion of new information necessitates a name change that encompasses not just health data. The homepage URL is changing from <http://health.amchessieclub.org> to <http://CBRdata.amchessieclub.org> and will, from now on, be referred to simply as the CBR Database. The new release has an updated look and the homepage was changed to reflect the look of the new ACC website.

With the new release, users will see continued performance improvements including several new features:

Historical test data for PRA, DM, and EIC has been added. (Historical test data is defined as tests performed before OFA registries were established.)

AKC Title data has been imported from various sources and will continue to be added as more sources become available.

BIS and Group awards for dogs placing in regular or Owner Handled Groups now appear under a dog's Title tab.

The Group Awards Awarded by Judge is a new searchable feature available from the homepage of the database. This is a great feature if you are interested in which judges really like our breed.

Individual dogs are now linked to parents, grandparents, siblings and offspring so that we can easily explore information about closely related dogs.

The ACC Data Team always welcomes suggestions. Is there information that you would find beneficial? A process that needs improvement? Let us know!

Maintaining a database is an ongoing effort and if you would like to volunteer for short term work we have a need in this area, no special skills required. Please contact the ACC Data Team at ACCDATAteam@gmail.com if you would like to help.

Info About the "Note" Feature

- **What can be included in a "Note?"** A note can include the dog's call name, the owner's and/or breeder's names, the location of the dog, contact information for the owner, whether the dog is deceased, etc. Be creative.
- **What cannot be included in a "Note?"** The note feature cannot be used to advertise your dog or your breeding program. No links to websites. No claim: or descriptions that appear to promote the dog or kennel.

Tips for Providing Documentation

- Snap a clear photo of your supporting documents with your cell phone and upload with your submission.
- Some official supporting documentation is publicly available online and you have the option of providing a link to that data. For example, you may link to information that is available at places such as Paw Print Pedigrees, the UK Health Finder, the Swedish Kennel Club, the German Retriever Club, etc.

How to Change Data or Correct Errors

- Notes, photos, and parent info can be changed/corrected by users by submitting new data.
- To correct a health test record, contact the ACC Data Team at the address below to report the error.

On the National Derby List

"Abby" Church Creek Abigail Von Duckslayer (Grand Oaks He's No Boy Scout MH QA2 x HRCH Pond Hollow Otter Point UD SH WDQ **) has had a very successful Derby season. As of Oct 27, she finished each of the seven Derby trials that she started, with one 1st Place, three 2nd Places, one 3rd Place, one 4th Place, and one JAM, for a total of



17 Derby points putting her on the National Derby List. Abby also qualified to attend the 2019 National Retriever Derby Championship (NRDC), a difficult 10-series, weeklong trial with a strong field of 32 dogs. Abby represented the breed well during the event, making it to the 8th series before being picked up. She was the runt of her litter - a royally bred litter. Her sire was FC Skipper Bob and her maternal grandsire was Dual Ch Sodak's Gypsy Prince. Run by her owner Ed Osborne, Gypsy had 31 Open pts. and ran/completed the first National Open in 1941.

The Secretary has not received any additional nominations according to the bylaws, Section 7 Elections, B Nominations, 2 "Additional nominations of eligible members may be made by written petition addressed to the Secretary and postmarked on or before August 1st, signed by five (5) percent of the current membership or 50 signatures, of members in good standing, whichever number is lower, and accompanied by the written acceptance of such additional nominee signifying his willingness to be a candidate. No person shall be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee."

1. Companion Events Committee – Lynda Barber-Wiltse (AK)
2. Field Trial Committee – Ed Bahr (AL) National Field Trial Specialty (NFTS) going well. Cathy Scroggins (TX) is accepting donations.
Dina Perugini (ID) is planning on hosting the 2020 NFTS.
3. Health Committee – GiGi Grant (ID) Dr. James Stewart reported: Questions have been raised by some ACC members concerning participation in studies on epilepsy and seizures. It should be plain to concerned people that research and treatment of these diseases are no simple thing. First, identification of the disease is no simple matter. Positively identifying the disease requires the exclusion of many signs that are present with epilepsy, but are also associated with toxins, environment, and medications for other diseases. It is not simple to make and confirm the disease, and a huge step to find a cause that could actually have a genetic marker that could then be modified or treated.

I have listed the most recent CHF research grants and their investigators if you wish to see the diversity that is being investigated. I also have the report being handled at NC State. They have a new approach in dealing with their subject. Their director is very willing to talk, and you may have a better insight to working with the disease after speaking with them.

Questions on Chondrodystrophy and Chondrodysplasia in our breed will be addressed by information gathered in our blood collection and banking, thanks to the CHIC DNA database at the University of Missouri. Over 120 samples have been transferred to the Bannasch Lab at Cal/Davis. It will be analyzed by Dr. Danica Bannasch and the material gathered will exceed everything accumulated in past efforts. The finances for this were supported by the ACC Charitable Trust and the considerable influence of Dr. Bannasch.

The last question involved the ACC Health tests database. It touches a constant concern I have had

where people use the information on “Facebook” to become educated in one of the most complicated sciences we deal with...DNA! Four different veterinarians on the health committee have crumbled trying to understand and use the reports on our testing. Understanding this information included a great deal of help from Dr. Bannasch and a conference at Cal/Davis attended by Dr. Briedi Gillespie. There was also personal communication with Dr. Bannasch by Julie Cole, another members of the Health Committee with background equal to most, if not all ACC members.

In answer to this problem, AKC has established an “Ad Hoc Committee Regarding Genetic Testing”. This committee consists of nine members involving AKC delegates, AKC staff, scientists, and veterinarians. The goal is to analyze the current and future state of canine genetic testing, and recommendations regarding the future use of genetic testing by AKC and its breeders.

Major efforts are being made to clarify science far beyond the means we have previously had. The answers will not be simple or quick, but they will be forth coming and accurate, with review by highly trained professionals.

AKC Report Oct/Nov

The Board of Directors of the AKC recently made the following changes to the regulations governing Retriever Hunt Test:

- To increase the capacity of Master Hunt Test by 10%. Under this new regulations clubs at their OPTION may establish limits of 66, 100, 132 and 200 for Master entries. The regulations regarding the number of days required remains the same.

- Handlers withdrawing dogs prior to the close of entry may only be charged a scratch fee approximately equal to the credit card fee.

- An individual handler that has more than 12 entries in a Hunt Test (all levels) is "asked" to take responsibility for having an assistant to care for and have dogs on line at each on time.

The Board is also considering Agility course changes that will most likely be finalized at their November meeting. These changes will involve:

- Wall: clarification of equipment design and current judging practice of this object

- Tunnels: Use of a 10 - 13 foot to replace the closed tunnel

- Weave polls: Judges and staff feel there is a need for greater uniformity in configuration nationwide

- Fast class: changes to the obstacle content to increase flexibility of course design

At the December Delegates meeting 12/12-13/19 votes will be taken on 2 items regarding Dog Shows. A change to Chapter 3 Sect 22 would allow dogs registered with an acceptable foreign or domestic registration to participate in Miscellaneous. The proposed change to Chapter 11 Section 8-A dealing with Disqualifications would remove the requirement of physical injury to have occurred for an Event Committee to disqualify a dog that has attacked a person or another dog.


