FC Topsail's Good Time Buddy

I purchased Bud as an 8 week old puppy from Craig Klein. We had discussed that breeding a year before and Craig knew that I wanted a competitive field trial dog. When they were about 7 weeks old, Craig called me up one day and said, "There's this deadgrass male that really looks good." A week later Bud was on a plane to NC.

He hit the ground running and has never looked back. Puppy training was fun for both of us - Bud showed incredible drive and tenacity from the very start. We were soon doing multiple marks on land and water, and his memory developed at a very early age. As did his blinds, as he would line up, look out and lock on and GO wide-open on blinds by the time he was 5 months old. At a year old he was solid on his basics.

I put Bud with Rick Millheim and explained that I was aiming for a competitive All Age dog at 5 or 6 years of age. I feel that took the short-term pressure off all of us. Since then, Bud has developed with Rick in the warm months, and then has come home and trained and duck hunted with me in the late fall and winter.

At 2 1/2 years of age he won a tough Qualifying in SC. At 3 1/2 years old he and Rick got a Reserve Jam in the Open, and that same week I picked him up and took a 2nd in the Open and Reserve Jam in the Amateur. At the ACC Specialty in 2017. Had not seen him in 6 months!

We trained the following winter at home and were looking forward to the spring trials.

In early March, Bud landed wrong in training and suffered an injury. We sat out his entire 4 year old season. After a long slow rehab, and several hurricanes, he was cleared to start back in training. We also bred Bud to some nice bitches, so



we are excited to see them develop.

His past year (5 years old) was pretty special, as he got an Open 1st with Rick in June and an Open 2nd in October, which gave him the final points for his FC. Bud also qualified for the 2019 National Open, but we were not able to make the trip.

To say that we are excited is an understatement! Bud has been a joy to own since day one. He always comes out ready to give 150% effort, and is willing to work through any training situation. He's intensely focused, and a blast to handle. He's affectionate, an easy keeper, and is good with other dogs. Hopefully I'll be able to spend some time working towards that AFC!

Many thanks to my home training team, Rick and Bev Millheim of Renegade Retrievers, and also for the support and encouragement of the Chesapeake community!

In Tribute

In the late summer 1997, I broke all the rules of buying a puppy. I opened the Want Ads and looked to check out available Labrador Retrievers. Little did I know, I was embarking on a long, life chapter in hunting retrievers. Adding to the broken rules, I bought a dog with a lousy pedigree, no genetic testing, every possible error was made which would haunt me through the life of this dog. I was having problems with training. My vet asked me if I knew Susan Keroack and recommended her highly.

I called, set up an observation appointment and the rest is history. Three years later, "Luke" had a NAHRA Intermediate title, never failed a test and was a wonderful dog in the field and house. After Luke got the 2nd title, I asked Sue, "Now what am I going to do the rest of the Summer?" Her reply, "Take Windy, I haven't had time to do much with her". Windy was Sue's youngest of 3 dogs, "Spendthrift Rising Wind". That Summer I spent a fair amount of time with Windy and quickly learned, this was a different breed. Very focused and very different from my experience with Luke. Windy titled in just 10 weeks of training time. A testimony to her breeding, not my training. Sue then said to me, "When you are ready for another dog, I want you to have a puppy out of Windy".

Spring 2002, Windy had a litter of pups. I spent a lot of time helping Sue with them. She told me, "You pick out the puppy and as long as it's the right one, that will be your pup". My choice was also hers. The result was "Jessie" aka Spendthrift Storm's Legacy named after Sue's prize bitch Storm who had recently passed. Jessie was the sassiest, most athletic and wild child of the litter. With Jessie, I agreed to continue Sue's line of dogs with her guidance.

I've now had 4 Chessies over the years. Two from breedings I did under Sue Keroack's tutelage. Sue loved this breed, it was



her life. Over the 20 years I've known Sue, we had many great hunts and hundreds of "Group" training sessions through spring and summer. I've been the recipient of many tongue lashings from her on my training methods, how I drilled my dog prior to a lesson, timeliness to my lesson, hunting scenarios I've set up for training, how I've thrown a bumper on a mark, how I've lined my dog for a mark. You name it, I've caught grief about it!! It was part of the deal. It was what made Sue Keroack, Sue Keroack. She was one of a kind. The hundreds of clients and our hunting companions loved her for it. If you were prepared and did your homework, Sue quickly could tell. If you didn't, get ready for some unfiltered "Gospel according to Sue" and there would be no filtering of her superlatives!! Her classic line I heard so many times: "The dog knows how to be a dog; my job is to teach you how to be a retriever trainer."

Sue passed away Friday, January 17th from a long battle with cancer. She did it her way. She was a very tough woman. Like her handler ability, she could drop waterfowl with the best of us.

She leaves behind her son Charlie and her grandson son Matt. They were both everything to her. And she leaves her final Chesapeake, 7 year old Mysty. Mysty will go with one of Sue's closest friends and former client. In Upstate New York, if you know retrievers or you know the Chesapeake Breed, you know Sue Keroack. For many years, the Spendthrift line of dogs were a fine representation of the breed. She put her heart and soul into anything she did with these animals. I was honored when she asked me to carry on her Spendthrift lineage and to have one of her puppies. She will be missed by so many for her guidance, coaching, and attention to detail.

First Goose

The flight of 7 geese was coming in above tree top height and coming down the field diagonally toward the hedge row where Gus and I lay concealed among some small cedars on the side of a drainage ditch. Three other small flights had preceded this one on the same track but I felt they were too high. Well, I guess this was as good as it would get for today.

This was Gus's first goose hunt and I was anxious for it to be successful. I wanted him to have a good experience.

I have had four other Chesapeake Bay Retrievers from the mid 1990's but when I lost the last one in 2012 I decided to take a hiatus. Losing them became too difficult. However, as I approached my 77th birthday I realized that the window for another dog would soon be closed so, after discussing pros and cons with my wife, Susan, we decided to go for one more time. Little did I expect that my wife would throw a curve and say she wanted one, as well. I was looking for a male with a hunting background. Susan wanted a dead grass female, if possible. As fate sometimes encourages fools, Pond Hollow had two litters due a month apart and the pedigrees were encouraging.

I am fortunate to live in a rural area of New Jersey next to a Federal waterfowl wildlife preserve. There are several large fields on our road and geese often move from the preserve to feeding areas. There are several spots to set



up small blinds and have opportunities for pass shooting.

Upland season was about over and Gus had done well flushing and retrieving pheasant and chukar and I felt he was ready to give the big boys a try as he was now 20 months old. He had shown good natural retrieving ability early and had spent 6 weeks at Rise and Shine Retrievers where Wes has shown him the basics.

When our small flight of geese was almost vertically above us, I pushed out of the cedars and managed a quick shot and then they were past. Then I heard breaking branches as a heavy bodied bird crashed through limbs and thudded to the ground behind me. Gus flashed off in an instant and was out of sight. I wasn't sure how he would react to such a large bird. I gave him a minute and then three short whistles . . . nothing . . . three more. Up from the far side of the ditch Gus emerged, proudly carrying a very large goose. He paused in pride and then delivered to hand. Not sure which of us was prouder.

We still have a lot of work to do but he meets my expectations as a hunting buddy and best friend.

AKC Star Puppy

So, what is an AKC STAR puppy?? I had no idea. My puppy, Bernie, was born 9/29/2019. By the time all other pups gone, she was a rambunctious 8 week old that needed some structure. I teach at an obedience school, and usually all of my pups go there for puppy kindergarten. Unfortunately, we were on break, so I found another place who used this AKC STAR program as their puppy class. Jokingly, I signed up and we started right away. Of course we were the youngest . . .

STAR stands for "Socialization, Training, Activity, and a Responsible owner." It is a 6 week class - and owner and pup have to attend ALL 6 weeks. It's sort of a precursor to the AKC Canine Good Citizen program - but, you're allowed to have food! During the 6 weeks, your puppy will be socializing with other pups up to 1 year of age. We were allowed some play time also. Owners are taught basic responsibilities such as carrying poop bags, having their dogs identified, whether by chip, tattoo, collar name, etc. Also, owners have to show proof that their dogs are vaccinated.

Bernie started the first night charging in happily to play, I could not control her - this is kind of embarrassing because I teach obedience. She was able to focus when I pulled out the steak for treats. Classes are very informal, the instructor walks around and you demonstrate that your puppy can be handled and hugged - and that they are not collar shy. As weeks go on, other people come up and pet your dog. That was a hard one for Bernie, she's soooo happy.

Eventually, it is week 6 - test day - all of a sudden, the 8 dogs and handlers were nervous it was a "test". The people didn't realize that the instructor was testing them throughout the whole 6 weeks. Some pups had problems with another person holding the leash while the owner walked away. Some had problems with downs, recalls, distractions.

Bernie flew through this program. She was the youngest pup to obtain the AKC STAR! She was only 3.5 months old. I am very proud of her. I think that it gave her more confidence around other dogs and she was able to work through distractions. The full guide to the AKC STAR puppy program is found on the AKC website.

At 3.5 months old Bernie (GCH CH* Dut- Chesse Spark of Susquidilla JH CDX MX AXJ XF RA TKI CGC RATI WDX CD-C X Pond Hollow Dut-Chesse Callista BN CD JH OA OAJ NF TKI CGC WD). Introducing Dut-Chesse to Auburn and Back - "Bernie". Hopefully the first of many titles and certificates from the AKC.

AKC Report

It has been 9 months since the initiation of the 1+1 rule for low entry breeds at Dog Shows. In that time there has been an increase in number of instances of 1+1 entries. This has amounted to an average of 4.2 additional entries per all-breed show. For dogs that have entered and find themselves in a 1+1 situation, the absentee rate has been reduced from 48% to 26%. The combined impact of these two changes is that an average of 5.4 additional dogs are being shown per all-breed show.

The 2008 - 2019 AKC registration and participation reports are available. Over this time period Chesapeakes have experienced a 20% decline in litter registration (712 in 2008, 571 in 2019). The rate of individual Chesapeake pups that become registered has remained constant, about 50%, during this period. This registration rate is fairly typical of all the Sporting Group breeds. The Sporting Group as a whole has seen an increase in participation in AKC events. Chesapeakes, however, have seen a decline of 2.9% in Conformation, 5.6% in Companion and 3.2% in performance venues.

Club News

The March meeting of Delegate Hunt Test and Field Trial Committee began its look at the low participation of the majority of eligible breeds in AKC Field Trials. This inquiry is part of our effort to sustain and promote breed function. Delegates from the eligible Parent Clubs will be invited to voice their individual concerns at the June 2020 meeting.

For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions by E-Mail

- Send the photos as an ATTACHMENT, not in the body of the e-mail.
- Good quality photo images of 300 dpi AND minimal image size of 5" x 7", preferably 8" x 10", are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*.
- Proper resolution and size will create a JPEG image file size of around 1 MB. If your file size is significantly smaller than 900 KB or 1 MB, then it probably is not 300 dpi or the correct image size and will not be usable.
- Check the settings on your camera / mobile device before taking pictures. There should be a settings feature allowing you to adjust the resolution/pixels; choose the highest setting for best print production. For example: 2400 x 3000 pixels/inch (converts to 300dpi for an 8" x 10" photo).
- Some digital cameras/devices create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. This is OK. Just send the unedited file as is. The larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.
- Please DO NOT crop or edit your images – that will be done for you. Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.
- If you are scanning a hard copy of a photo, please check your scanner settings for proper resolution and image size, and make certain that you clean your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning.

If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan. Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.


