The next few years his Platte River Chesapeakes gave him some wonderful hunts, and their puppies helped fund his college education. He even joined the American Chesapeake Club, and his name is listed in the 1959 edition of the ACC book edited by Eloise Heller Cherry. Life continued, but Dick's dream of once again hunting over his own Chesapeake never died.

Dick had told the stories of his youth to his sons, and Dale remembered about those Chesapeakes. He noticed when their friend Pat Baughman's dog Diesel sired a litter not too far away, and decided to make his dad's long-held dream come true. Dick named his new puppy Jill, after his first Chesapeake, and soon he and Pat began training Jill. They went out almost every morning, building the foundation of a great field dog and her handler one lesson at a time. It was frustrating at times, but

Dick never gave up and never lost patience.

Finally, it was time to see what Jill and Dick could do in a hunt test, choosing the Elkhorn Valley Hunting Retriever Club test to be held August 22. There was a lot to remember, but Dick did and piloted his Chesapeake to her first qualifying ribbon. At 81, Dick was the oldest handler and at 10 months, Jill was the youngest dog running, and it was a first for both of them. Of course, their cheering section of Dale, Dick's wife Ginger, and Pat and Emelise were there to watch, and the gallery applauded after their successful marks. What a great day all around! Dick has renewed his membership in the ACC, and he and Pat are planning out future hunts and tests for Jill.

Grandpa's Legacy

Maybe it's in the blood. Brynn is only 7 years old, but her mom, Rebecca, grandpa Pat, and great-great grandfather Paul in the Ozarks so long ago all hunted with Chesapeakes, so she grew up with them. Maybe that's why when grandpa asked her if she'd like to handle his duck dog, Diesel (CH, UKC CH, HRCH Musky Bay's Countryside Turbo Diesel, SH, CGC, WDQ) in a junior hunt test to try to win a ribbon, she jumped on it. When

the Nebraska Dog and Hunt Club posted the special rosette they were offering to junior handlers August 8-9, the plan was made. Brynn made the trip from Maryland to Nebraska with her mom, sister Clara, and one of their Chesapeakes, Nash, who is Diesel's son, and practice began. Every morning for 3 days she would join grandpa and Diesel for a 6:30 am training session, and every evening they would practice again. Joanne Stancer had made her a beautiful pink and blue whistle lanyard, and she soon learned to use that whistle to command a dog that outweighed her by 20 lbs.

But Brynn was very nervous when Saturday dawned. Still, she took Diesel's short orange lead and went to the line as directed. Two land marks, done. The gallery surprised her with applause as she led her big boy back to the truck, and then the wait began for water marks. Brynn remembered what to do, signaling for her birds, sending her dog, whistling him back, and even taking the wet bird from his mouth and handing it to the judge. But still she was nervous. Would the judges award her that coveted rosette? She was the last number to be called, but call her they did and after she accepted her orange rosette and the special red, white and blue junior handler rosette, she skipped away and did a series of joyful cartwheels!

The next day she was more relaxed, clad in a hot pink ruffled skirt and camo shirt, with feet in pink Muck boots. Once again, she piloted Diesel to two more rosettes and lots of high fives. This was truly a wonderful weekend for our family. Thank you to Heidi Henningson and the NDHC for offering the junior handler rosette that created a goal for Brynn, thank you to the judges and gallery who applauded, and thank you especially to Diesel, who exemplifies the true Chesapeake in his strength and kindness. New UKC Hunting Retriever Champion



Show Scene

Dog Shows in the Era of Covid

The decision whether or not to enter a dog show is a highly personal choice. Everyone must take into consideration a number of factors such as their health, whether or not they live with people or have close contact with the elderly etc. Each show location has to abide by state and local rules as well as that of the venue and many sites are not allowing shows at this time. That being said, I made the decision to go to the Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania shows and thought I would briefly describe the manner in which they were run.

The Bloomsburg fair grounds were set up with 9 indoor rings, three outdoor and two in outside livestock arenas. The indoor rings were in three large buildings, three rings per building with the rings up against the walls and a large open area on the other half of the building. No crates, grooming or ringside chairs were allowed. You could bring your own chair and crate but both had to be removed after you showed your dog. Each indoor ring had an entrance and exit, ribbons were placed on a table by the exit ring and you took it as you left. There was a "ready ring" where you waited with your dog. Dogs were brought in and gaited together, they then exited and were brought in one at a time to be examined. The judge sanitized his hands between each dog. It is hard to visualize the amount of empty space that

the buildings had, imagine a typical high school gymnasium with about 20 people spread out across the length of it. It was unbelievably quiet and the set up made it much more pleasant to watch the dogs without being jostled by people, dogs, and carts amid the din of blowers and conversation. The set up outside was pretty much the same.

When you arrived at the show, you handed in a waiver that you had signed stating that to the best of your knowledge you had not been exposed to Covid and did not have a test pending. Your temperature was taken and you picked up your numbers for all the days that you were entered. There was no throng of people crowding around the steward's table searching through the catalog for their numbers. This was so easy that I hope that it remains in place after life goes back to normal.

Having a win photo taken was also an improvement in my opinion. Prior to the show photos of all the judges had been

taken. At your convenience you brought your dog to the photographer, your ribbons were attached to a clipboard and the photo was taken. The judges were later photoshopped into the picture.

While you missed out on that additional minute or so to chat with the judge, the ability to get your picture taken immediately and go on your way was wonderful.

Overall, I think the show went incredibly smoothly. People adhered to the masking and social distancing

requirements as well as "show and go", the venue felt safe and people seemed to be happy to be at a show. Vendors were outside, hand sanitizer was everywhere and I for one was thrilled to have some sense of normalcy in this crazy world.

Obviously, there are many things to be said pro and con about holding dog shows right now. My desire in writing this is not to debate those points but just to offer a snapshot of how it worked for those who may be interested one in the future.

2. Report of the President-President Lynda Barber-Wiltse stated that Linda Harger reported a nice entry for the rescheduled All-Breed Field Trial held in Montana. The National Field Trial Specialty in Idaho has revised their dates.
3. Report of the Secretary-The Secretary Carolyn Johnson reports the following motions have been approved by unanimous written consent of the Directors, effective on the dates noted, and the consents will be filed with the minutes of this meeting.

For Electronic (Digital) Photo Submissions by E-Mail

- Send the photos as an ATTACHMENT, not in the body of the e-mail.
- Good quality photo images of 300 dpi AND minimal image size of 5" x 7", preferably 8" x 10", are needed in order to print well in the *Bulletin*.
- Proper resolution and size will create a JPEG image file size of around 1 MB. If your file size is significantly smaller than 900 KB or 1 MB, then it probably is not 300 dpi or the correct image size and will not be usable.
- Check the settings on your camera / mobile device before taking pictures. There should be a settings feature allowing you to adjust the resolution/pixels; choose the highest setting for best print production. For example: 2400 x 3000 pixels/inch (converts to 300dpi for an 8" x 10" photo).
- Some digital cameras/devices create photos that are 24" to 30" in size but are shown as being only 72 or 96 dpi. This is OK. Just send the unedited file as is. The larger physical photo size provides lots of pixels and most of these photos can be edited to the required physical size and dpi needed for printing.
- Please DO NOT crop or edit your images – that will be done for you. Whenever possible, cropping will be done to show the dog as fully as possible.
- If you are scanning a hard copy of a photo, please check your scanner settings for proper resolution and image size, and make certain that you clean your scanner's glass surface prior to scanning.

If your scanning software does not automatically crop your scan to the size of the photo, please do so manually prior to saving the scan. Scans of digital photos printed onto inkjet photo paper on your home printer will generally not reproduce well.
