# The Dewclaw Dilemma

## Rear Dews and Dont's

*The purpose of this article is to inform ACC members of the current situation in countries that have laws forbidding the removal of dewclaws (front and rear). In no way does this article suggest any dogs be eliminated from our gene pool because they had rear dewclaws. The ACC President asked the JBEC to write this article so members and breeders would be aware of legislation in other countries (most of Europe), and the possibility that, in the future, laws may be passed in the United States forbidding cropping, docking and dewclaw removal.*

The first AKC-approved Chesapeake Bay Retriever Standard in 1918 listed six disqualifications including "Dew claws, undershot, overshot, or any deformity." This disqualification remained the same through the 1933 Standard revision, but in 1963, changes were approved and remain part of the current (1993) Standard. Dewclaws were given their own line and clarified to indicate rear only. Since 1963, DQ number three simply states: "Dewclaws on hind legs."

Reviewing past publications, there is little information about the intent behind rear dewclaw disqualification. Janet Horn, in *The New Complete Chesapeake Bay Retriever* (1994, page 32), addresses all breed disqualifications in general and states: "The seven disqualifications in our Standard were first laid down in 1936, and at that time, I was told by one who had worked on the Standard Committee in the 1930s, these items were made disqualifications because they were serious problems in the breed. If they are now found only infrequently it is a tribute to the emphasis implied by the potential for disqualification. We need to retain these disqualifications, for anything that has previously been a problem in the breed can become one again if we do not keep alert and guard against it."

The incidence of rear dewclaws and their mode of inheritance in Chesapeakes is relatively unknown, as most breeders and owners do not actively track or relate the occurrence. Puppy buyers or breeders in the US don't usually think or find it necessary to ask about rear dewclaws in parents or past generations. The breed Standard makes no mention of removal of rear dewclaws being a disqualification, just that they should not be allowed, so it is near impossible to track anecdotally in adults. Currently, there is no genetic testing available for the occurrence of rear dewclaws and no research planned for the future. In the upcoming breed health survey, the question of rear dewclaws will be addressed to have better information available about the prevalence in the breed and potential genetic transmission.

In the United States, CBRs with dewclaws removed are allowed in the conformation ring. So, why is this a concern? The American Chesapeake Club is the authority over the official AKC Standard which is used not only in the USA, but also in countries governed by the FCI (Federation Cynologique Internationale). CBRs shown in conformation classes in these countries are held to this Standard. Canada and Great Britain have written their own Chesapeake Bay Retriever Standard based on the ACC version. Canada has only six disqualifications, with the rear dewclaw DQ eliminated. Great Britain has no

disqualifications included in their version and no mention of dewclaws at all.


Other countries vary widely in their laws regulating, or outright prohibiting, docking, cropping, and the removal of both front and rear dewclaws. For example, in Canada a number of provinces have banned the procedures, and the Canadian Veterinary Medical Association has stated (2018) they are formally opposed. In the United Kingdom, removal of dewclaws is permitted without anesthesia only if the puppy's eyes have not opened, or with anesthesia (only by a licensed veterinarian) if eyes have opened. In some countries, removal is only permitted if it becomes medically necessary for trauma or therapeutic reasons. Groups in the US are lobbying for similar bans of cropping, docking, and dewclaw removal. If such laws are ever approved, the ACC would likely be mandated to revise our breed Standard.

The conflict is:

- Rear dewclaw removal is illegal in some countries outside the US
- Rear dewclaws are a disqualification according to the ACC (and FCI) official breed Standard

National purebred dog registries in many foreign countries require conformation certification from a qualified judge before a dog or bitch can be bred or any litters registered. CBRs with rear dewclaws present are disqualified under the FCI Standard and may not be able to obtain this certification in countries that specifically prohibit dewclaw removal. As breeding stock is much more limited outside the US, this becomes a concern for foreign CBR fanciers.

Prior to these laws being enacted in other countries, breeders had no real reason to record information on puppies born with rear dewclaws. However, CBRs are sold to buyers and being bred in countries where removing rear dewclaws is an issue. US breeders can help foreign breeders by recording and sharing information with them on rear dewclaws that may be present in their lines. In addition, when selling dogs, bitches, or semen outside the US, the specific laws addressing dewclaw removal in the destination country should be discussed.

## In Remembrance of

William F. LaMar, Culpeper VA

(Feb. 21, 1925 - Jan. 5, 2021)

Former ACC member Bill LaMar, 95, passed away on January 5<sup>th</sup>. Originally from Long Island, LaMar and his wife Martha moved to the rural countryside outside Culpeper not long after he retired some 40 years ago. He was an Army veteran of World War II although like many of that generation, he rarely mentioned it, preferring instead to talk of his first love, retrievers, and their people.

After retiring, LaMar was able to devote more time to his favorite pastime: retriever training, including the then-new AKC retriever hunting tests. He and his wife developed their 30-acre farm into a first class training facility and were very active in the local retriever clubs. LaMar had always done all his own training and to that pastime he added mentoring and helping others. He put all age points on a number of Goldens including making an amateur field champion, AFC Riverside Hawk Kiowa, and later ran Labradors and Chesapeakes in hunt tests.

As he entered his mid-80s, LaMar's eyesight made driving at night difficult so he concentrated more on the hunt tests and titled several Chesapeakes, his own and those belonging to friends. Among those were Wes Christopher's Rogue of Rainbow Farm MH QAA, and his Tugboat Woods Colt MH WDQ, a stud fee puppy bred by Julie Reardon. With his friend Jim Coulter, they put JH, SH and MH titles on Coulter's dog CH Pond Hollow Rappahannah, MH CDX. Hannah was 8 and LaMar and Coulter were both in their 80s when she finally earned her MH. He also mentored and helped many local people and their Chesapeakes, from meat dogs to field trial hopefuls and ran several ACC training days at nearby Hope Springs Farm.

## *Gator*

### **A Coast Guard Chesapeake Named Gator**

In 1976, I was a young Lieutenant (junior grade) in the U. S. Coast Guard. I had just been assigned as the Commanding Officer of an 82 foot patrol boat. It was USCGC POINT LOBOS (WPB 82366), homeported in Panama City, Florida. The boat had a Chesapeake Bay retriever as a mascot. His name was Gator, and he lived onboard. He had been donated to the boat a few years earlier by Helen Schuh, a local television personality who was active in breeding and showing dogs. Since Helen retained Gator's breeding rights, we were required to keep his AKC registration current. So, ownership of Gator was officially transferred to me when I took command. POINT LOBOS was tied up at the Coast Guard Station on the Naval Coastal Systems Laboratory property. It was a large, fenced expanse of waterfront land dotted with pine trees of which Gator had free reign. When not out making his rounds, Gator could be found at the station's boat launch ramp, sitting in water up to his neck to stay cool. The POINT LOBOS itself was on standby for search and rescue, and we often had to get underway on short notice. Every time we fired up the engines, Gator would come running and jump onboard the boat. I'm not sure if it was because he loved going to sea, or because our cook was the person who fed him! But he would go to sea with us whenever we had a call. He would usually sleep right outside the door to my cabin, and would supervise whenever we were putting over a tow line or launching our skiff. Before I finished my tour of duty, my wife and I had fallen in love with Gator. Fortunately for us, he



was used for stud just before I completed my assignment. We got a male puppy from that breeding that we named "Lobo." Lobo spent 14 years accompanying us on various Coast Guard assignments to New York, Florida, Connecticut, back to Florida, and eventually to Alaska. We have shared our lives with Chesapeakes from 1976 to this very day.

I was later to find that at one time Chesapeake Bay retriever mascots were not altogether unusual in the Coast Guard. There is a book called "Surfman: The Adventures of a Coast Guard Dog" by Colonel S. P. Meek that was published in 1950. It tells the tale of a Chesapeake Bay retriever at a life boat station on the Outer Banks of North Carolina. It was fairly common for these stations to have one or more Chesapeake Bay retrievers as mascots. In his preface the author says: "Surfman, however, is not the story of any one dog. He is built up from the characters and credited with the exploits of a number of dogs of the same breed whom I met or of whom I was told at the various stations I visited. They were wonderful dogs with a great record for the actual saving of lives." Colonel Meek also acknowledges the assistance of Journalist (first class) Alex Haley, U. S. Coast Guard, in the writing of the book.

After retiring from the Coast Guard, Alex Haley wrote "Roots: The Story of an American Family" which was published in the same year that I took command of USCGC POINT LOBOS.

## AKC Delegate Report

March 9, 2021 the AKC Delegate Meeting was held via Zoom. During this meeting the new Board of Directors were elected:

### Canine Partners Being Exhibited in Junior Showmanship

The AKC Board approved at the January Meeting a proposal submitted by the Delegate Junior Sub-Committee and AKC Staff, to allow Canine Partners to be exhibited in Junior Showmanship. This is an 18-month pilot program. The dog must have an AKC Canine Partner number and meet the ownership eligibility criteria. The Junior will include the breed of the dog is being exhibited as on the entry form in the breed designation space. This is the same approach that has been successfully used by the 4-H participants. Eligibility of Canine Partner to be entered in Conformation Junior Showmanship is limited to all-breed shows or events holding all-breed Junior Showmanship. The Judging Operations Department will be providing procedural information to all breed Junior

Showmanship Judges. The purpose of this is to encourage Juniors to participate in the sort of dogs; and to provide Juniors with a meaningful competition in which they can learn, practice, and improve in all areas of handling skill and sportsmanship.

The effective date is July 1, 2021. The impact of the pilot program will be assessed in 2022.

**Retriever Hunt Test:** The board has approved a recommendation to allow clubs to set aside either 25% or 35% of the slots in their Master Test for amateur handlers. This is due to there being more demand than supply and prevents pros from filling up the events. This will be effective for application received after April 1, 2021. The event conflict mileage has been reduced from 200 to 150 miles between events.

### Statistics for 2020:

- Fast CATS are up 127% from 2019
- Scent work events are up 108% over 2019
- Hunt tests are up 106% from 2019
- Field trials are about even with 2019
- Agility and Specialty shows were held at about the same number as 2019
- AB/Group shows, Obedience and Rally trials are being held less than 75% of 2019

## HR Hope Springs Hush Hush MH WDQ "Usher"

Washed from training at a year, father of an accidental litter at 16 months and sold to what would turn into 4 different homes in 4 years, Usher did not have the most auspicious beginning. A pretty puppy, he grew into a tall, lanky adult, with a head that looked too big for his body and we nicknamed him Jughead (among other things). He was very slow to mature: he wanted to please, but he was timid and would often shut down in training. The pro and I both thought even AKC senior hunter might be a struggle for him, but I got advice I've never forgotten: "You should finish his transition yourself," he said. "I'm afraid this dog will just give up under the grind if I do it, but he, and dogs like him, will try harder for the owner, than from any pro and that's the best way to get him through this." I did take over his training, but sold him shortly after. At at 17 months, he left for what would be one of 4 different homes in 3 years. By the time he was almost 5, two pups from his accidental breeding were finishing derbies and earning hunt titles, and litter sister HRCH Hope Springs Dowry MH QAA was on her way to becoming HRCH, MH and QAA. The dog I bought back at almost 5, was

nothing like the gangly, timid young dog I'd sold. He had a strong mistrust of strangers, especially men wearing ball caps, and a take no prisoners attitude. Any correction, deserved or not, was simply a minor interference to getting birds, but Usher was not afraid to challenge anyone he thought he could intimidate. With the help of Virginia gundog pro Neil Selby, we found that indeed, he had retained much of his early training and he could mark. Selby easily got him through his SH and then MH, but he was not an easy dog to train for blind retrieves as the trust was simply not there initially. But he was an uncanny marker, always ran hard, and never again refused a retrieve. He loved to hunt, and he more than held his own when we trained for field trials when he was 9. Although he went sterile at a fairly young age, he did sire 3 litters and out of each of 3 different females, got MH/\*\*\*/\*\* offspring. I have no doubt that if he'd started earlier and had a better handler, he would have been a very good field trial dog himself. He was nearly 12 when I retired him; he'd gotten too deaf to hear the whistle but was otherwise in remarkably good shape. At his last trial he was nearly 12 but still completed 9 series—he made it to the last in open, amateur and qualifying. And he mellowed into the same sweet jughead he'd been before I sold him. I will miss him and all that I learned from him.





# American Chesapeake Club Lifetime Achievement Award

## OBJECTIVE

Nominees are judged by the originality, vision, breadth, / impact of the entire body of their work. Candidate selection must go beyond mere name recognition / reputation. A nominee's work is evaluated in such areas as:

- A strong / well-documented commitment to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed.
- Vocal / written advocacy of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever breed today.
- Advancement of best practices in owning, training, competing, rescuing / breeding Chesapeake Bay Retrievers.
- Service to the community / the public in connection with the Chesapeake Bay Retriever as a breed, in competition, to owners / through rescue efforts.

## JUDGING

Nominations will be evaluated on the criteria provided above. The names of the award winner(s), if any, will be announced prior to the annual American Chesapeake Club Meeting during the National Specialty Show. The formal presentation of any award will take place at the Specialty.
