## Top Ten Sporting Dog

As one of the largest groups in an AKC dog show, it can be a challenge for the wash-and-wear Chesapeake Bay Retriever to stand out in the Sporting Group lineup. Among some of the toughest competition are the flashy Setters, the fluffy and popular Golden Retriever, the refined Pointers and the aristocratic English Springer and Cocker Spaniels. For a Chesapeake to get noticed in such a lineup, it takes a lovely example of the breed, first and foremost, but also expert handling and the attitude of a winner.

Only five years in our breed's history has this mixture of breed type and showmanship resulted in a Chesapeake Bay Retriever landing a spot as a Top Ten Sporting Dog among all breeds. To achieve this ranking, all dogs of all sporting breeds defeated are recorded and tallied over the course of a year. Dogs who rank among a group top ten amass a combination of multiple breed wins, Sporting Group placements and Best in Shows over the course of a year to rack up enough points to claim the coveted spot.

2020 added our fifth Chesapeake, Hank, to those who have ended a year as a Top Ten Sporting Dog. Following are all of our breed's winningest Sporting Dogs:

### "Hank" 2020: Number 7 Sporting Dog<sup>1</sup>

MBIS MRBIS GCHG Sandbar's Hardcore Hank MH QAA Hank was the first Chesapeake in breed history to earn an all-breed Best in Show, while also being an AKC Champion, Master Hunter and Qualified All-Age. As of this writing, Hank currently has six career Best in Shows.



# Pilot Programs for Rally & Obedience

## AKC announces changes and additional Pilot Programs for Rally and Obedience

### AKC Rally® Virtual Pilot Program

The AKC Companion Events Department is excited to announce the expansion of the AKC Rally Virtual Pilot Program to include the Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent classes. These are the next levels of classes added to the AKC Rally pilot program announced last year.

As with the Rally Novice and Rally Intermediate classes, the competitor sets up a pre-designed AKC Rally® course, video records the team's performance, and submits it to AKC. In turn, AKC will assign a pre-selected AKC Rally Judge to virtually review and score the team's Rally performance.

The AKC Rally Virtual Pilot program is open to all dogs six months of age and older. Dogs entered in the Rally Advanced class must have earned the Rally Novice (RN) title and may have earned the Rally Intermediate (RI) title according to the owner's records. Qualifying in the Rally Advanced class three times will result in the dog earning the Rally Advanced (RA) title.

Dogs entered in the Rally Excellent class must have earned the Rally Advanced (RA) title according to the owner's records. Qualifying in the Rally Excellent class three times will result in the dog earning the Rally Excellent (RE) title. All qualifying scores will be recorded on the dog's AKC record and applied toward the three required for the Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent titles.

The qualifying scores and titles earned virtually are the same as those earned at in-person events. You may earn a title by qualifying at either or both types of events. The RAE class is not offered in this virtual pilot program and therefore, virtual classes cannot be used to earn the RAE title where double Qs at the same event are required. Rally Championship (RACH) points will be recorded for dogs after they have earned the Rally Excellent (RE) title, for scores of 91 or better in the Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent classes in the virtual program. The scores earned virtually from December 1, 2020 and after, will not be eligible to be used to qualify for entry into the 2022 AKC Rally® National Championship event.

### AKC announces Fix-n-Go Option for Obedience

Fix n' Go – Pilot Concept This is a new concept, and new things can create anxiety. After all, just like our dogs, we're

all creatures of routine who take comfort in the familiar. To alleviate any anxiety, you might be feeling with respect to this new change, here are some things to remember. The new Fix 'n Go concept will be offered on a one-year pilot basis beginning April 1, 2021. The concept will be evaluated throughout, and a survey will be conducted prior to the end of its term. The Fix n' Go concept is intended to allow the handler to reattempt the exercise to help their dog while performing in the obedience ring. Historically, any attempt to help the dog was considered 'training in the ring' and has not been permitted. Such training was penalized; however, these penalties sometimes have been inconsistently applied by judges and misunderstood by handlers. Our goal is to bring clarity to what a handler may and may not do, in the spirit of good sportsmanship, to help their dog be successful at future events. Please remember that we are all guided by the principles of good sportsmanship. We ask our judges to be kind and patient, and our exhibitors to be thoughtful and respectful, while we work together to implement this new procedure.

Using the Fix n' Go Option • The handler must begin an exercise to choose to use the Fix n' Go option. • The team does not have to NQ an exercise for the handler to choose to use the Fix n' Go option. • If the option is going to be used, the handler must do so before moving onto the next exercise. • It is the handler's responsibility to tell the judge they are choosing to Fix n' Go. • Once the handler tells the judge they are going to Fix n' Go, the exercise being reattempted is marked as an NQ and the NQ is carried down to the Total Score box. • Only one part of a two-part exercise may be reattempted. Two-part exercises are Heel on Leash and Figure Eight, Heel Free and Figure Eight, and Directed Jumping. • If a jump needs to be reset, it will be set to the original height. • The handler may begin the reattempt from the start or at any point during the exercise. • The judge will call the orders, and act as if judging for the reattempted exercise as usual. • The handler may help the dog using verbal encouragement, including additional commands and praise, and/or approaching the dog in a friendly/positive manner. • The handler may not touch the dog; judges should simply release at that point if they do. • Once the reattempt is done, the team leaves the ring. • Judges, please refrain from going into instructor mode. Leave the training up to the handler; you be the judge. • Exhibitors, please be mindful of your own and your dog's behavior in the ring. In the process of helping your dog, your actions should not be disruptive to adjacent rings. Additionally, you will need to be prepared; you will need to be ready a couple of dogs before your turn just in case teams before you are choosing to use the Fix n' Go option.



# Chessie Tales

**Sometimes a dog's greatest asset is his companionship. Other times he may be your hero. There are a lot of great Chessies out there and we want to celebrate them! Here are a few member stories about their great Chessies.**

## Blue Blooded - Derby List

In April, 2021, at just 15 months of age, "Sam" (Rocky Hooks JJs Play It Again \*\*) added his name to the National Derby List by winning the Talbot RC Derby stake. Previously, in the fall of 2020, Sam placed 3rd in the ACC FTS Derby (at 8.5 months old) and earned his first blue ribbon by winning the Maryland RC Derby stake (at 9.5 months old). In each derby victory, Sam pinned 7 of 8 marks, besting professionally trained dogs with far more experience. "Very few Chessies get on the Derby list", noted veteran field-trialer John Nichols, "and very few retrievers of any breed get on the list at Sam's tender age". Indeed, Sam is a special young dog with a lot of potential, but Sam would not exist if it weren't for a long line of people and dogs spanning many decades.



Sam's legacy began over 35 years ago when his owner, Marston Jones, received a wild puppy named "Harry" (FC AFC Stone E's Way To Go Harry WDX) from Les & Nancy Lowenthal as the stud fee for the use of "Stoney" (CFC CAFC CH Ironwoods Stone E Cubs WDX \*\*\*). Harry was sent to Rex Carr for basic training and he demonstrated his trial potential right

away. Harry earned 10 derby points in 1986, was added to the National Derby List, and got his photo on the cover of the ACC Bulletin (Sep 1987). Harry went on from there to earn both the AFC and FC titles, getting his photo on the cover of two additional ACC Bulletins (Sep/Dec 1992 & May/June 1994).

In the 35 years since Harry was on the derby list, Marston acquired a long list of puppies with potential, including Harry's son, "Jamie" (CFC CAFC When Harry Met Jessie \*\*\*), bred by Mitch and Linda Patterson, sired by Marston's Harry, out of the Patterson's great "Jessie" (DC AFC J J's Jessie CD WDQ). Marston recalls about Jamie's early years, "[Bill & Mary Hillman] brought him along very slowly and carefully, as he was a sensitive puppy. The basics continued until he was two years old, so he never was able to run a derby". Despite the slower start, Jamie matched Harry's accomplishments with his own CFC and CAFC titles, and got on two ACC Bulletin covers himself (Sep/Oct 1996 & Nov/Dec 1997). Much like Jamie, Sam is descended from both Harry and Jessie, with all of the same potential. Only time will tell if he has similar accomplishments.

Everyone knows the value of a quality pedigree when looking for a dog, but a lot of people forget that you also need a strong and diverse collection of veteran breeders behind the

pedigree. Sam is a perfect example of both aspects. When Marston called the Pattersons looking for a puppy, you can be sure that he was pleased to hear that their dam "Jazzie" (J J's Chi-Town Jazz \*\*\*) was a great-grand-daughter of his Harry. But, there wasn't much need for any detailed pedigree analysis before Marston made his decision. Rather, after many years of knowing them, Marston simply trusted that the Pattersons had chosen wisely when pairing Robin Orr's "Bud" (FC Topsail's Good



Time Buddy) with their Jazzie. True trust in a breeder has a way of simplifying decisions, but a deeper look at Sam's pedigree proves that the trust was well placed.

Sam's four grand-parents represent a very interesting and diverse collection of well-built lines. Sam's paternal grand-sire is Tom & Dawn Lind's "Magnum" (Lind's Northcreek Magnum MH \*\*), bred by Dyane Baldwin & Maggie Hoagland with a blend of strong performance and conformation lines, including many great dogs like Stoney, Chip & Bogey. Sam's paternal grand-dam is Craig Klein's "Piper" (CK's Pay Piper MH QAA), part of a very strong performance bitch line developed by Craig, who also bred Bud. The strong sire side is equally matched by the dam side. Sam's maternal grand-sire is Wendy Chisholm's "Rudy" (DC AFC Westwind's Rudy of Nordais WDQ), bred by Mario Beauregard, blending an impressive collection of strong performers and well-built dogs including Stoney, Harry, Widgeon, Chip, Jazz, Cub and Surfbreaker. Last, but not least, Sam's maternal grand-dam is the Patterson's "Rachel" (JJ's Rachel \*\*\*) who adds the strength of the Decks, Tiger, Hummer male line to the Patterson's already strong bitch line descending from their great Jessie and her daughter "Lizzie" (DC AFC J J's Chi-Town Blizzard CD MH WDQ). Look anywhere you want in Sam's pedigree and you'll see the handiwork of good breeders. Marston's trust was well placed in all of them.

The title of this article is not just a tribute to a young dog who won a couple of blue ribbons. It's a tribute to the great dogs of the past who have blue running through their lines and to the long-time owners like Marston who have supported the field trial sport for many decades in pursuit of those silly blue ribbons. Most of all, it's a tribute to the dozens of veteran breeders who have steadfastly crafted well-made pedigree lines so that we can all have the hope of grabbing a blue ribbon one day.

# Nominated Slate

I have served for three years as a Director of the club and I am currently in my first year as Secretary. I focus on projects that document and preserve the history of our dogs and our club and that make that information available in a useful format for the Board, our members, and the public. Major projects include the club database and a new website (to launch in early summer). I'm excited about the potential for these projects to "tell the story" of our breed and our club. Less visible tasks include the work of modernizing the Board's use of technology in the ways we collect, archive, and access important club documents. Our club benefits greatly by the work we are doing right now to preserve club history because we can't effectively run a club by relying on the memory of longstanding members.

Another goal of mine has been to invite more people into the work of the club. Dog clubs are powered by volunteers and we need to think creatively about new and interesting ways to get people involved. Our Data Group is effectively using volunteers to help us "grow" our database. And, our Web Team just conducted Focus Groups of members to get feedback about the new website. "Many hands make light work," as the saying goes. And, new volunteers bring new ideas.

Thanks to the Nominating Committee for inviting me back for another year. I look forward to continuing this work on behalf of the club. And, thank you all for the opportunity to serve.

## ***Treasurer – Margi Palmer (New Mexico)***

I have been the treasurer for the last two terms. It has been good to give back to the club that only has what's best for our breed on its agenda. I have been involved with Chesapeakes my entire life. My parents got their first Chesapeake in 1946, before I was born. I showed in Juniors, qualifying and exhibiting my Chesapeake at Westminster. In my teens, I titled Ch. Eastern Waters' Chobee Belle CD. I bred her and had a litter of puppies, one of which was a multi group placing dog and NSS winner; AM BDA Ch. Eastern Waters Brown Charger, AM BDA CD.

After college, I left the East Coast and moved to New Mexico. I brought with me Ch. Chesachobee's Papoose whom I continued to show in conformation and also trained and earned her CD and CDX. I got a male puppy, Ch. Eastern Water's Chieftain CD. I spent most of the 70's showing Chief in breed and obedience. Chief had nine Sporting Group placements, which at that time was very unusual for a Chesapeake. During these years I was an active member of the local obedience club and served as their treasurer.

I spent the next twenty years raising my children and running my CPA practice. I was never without a Chesapeake. After my kids were grown, I got a puppy and began showing again. Since then I have also involved my daughter and "soon to be a Junior" granddaughter. In regards to my experience and qualifications for being treasurer, I have been a CPA since 1977. I have my own firm and I am very familiar with all financial and reporting requirements. I have been treasurer of the Rio Grande Kennel Club since 2009. I understand the workings of dog club finances and what is required. I have also served on the ACC Nominating Committee.

If I am re-elected as Treasurer of the American Chesapeake Club, I would approach the position from the perspective that we must, as a club, do everything we can to protect this wonderful breed and not let the changing society affect it. I am most proud to have a breed of dog that can still do that for which it was originally intended.

## ***Director - Todd Adams (Alaska)***

I made the move to Alaska in 1995 and my journey with Chesapeakes started shortly after. I grew up in West Tennessee and hunted and guided from Illinois to Arkansas where waterfowl hunting was my favorite past time. Dogs, of course, came along with those pursuits and yes, I started with Labs. I brought my Candlewood dog with me to Alaska and he did everything I asked, but the cold waters affected him and started me on the Chesapeake challenge.

I bought my first Chesapeake in 1999 and my education began. I got involved with Hunt Tests (HT) and entered a few Field Trials (FT) with her. I was able to get her Senior title and passed a Master test before her time was cut short with Degenerative Myelopathy (DM). I am thankful she was able to contribute to the genetic testing we now have for that disease.

I was impressed enough with Ginger that I knew I wanted to continue with Chesapeakes. I also had become actively involved in our local retriever club. I have served on the Fairbanks Retriever Club board and in various officer roles over the years. I am an AKC FT and HT judge and have judged both in and outside Alaska on many occasions, as well as serving on HT and FT committees including the ACC - FTC. I also currently serve as vice president of the Alaska Conservation Land Trust, largely a wetland mitigation organization managed for public use and wildlife.

With each Chesapeake I have had increased successes in HT and FT stakes over the years and currently have two males competing in FT All-Age stakes. I am amazed with the breeding and training techniques that develop the athletes that can be competitive in both performance and show venues.

I have competed at ACC National FT Specialties for many years and have had dogs finish All-Age stakes in every time zone they are held. These are great events and I love seeing people campaigning their dogs. I am inspired by the wealth of training information shared and watching dogs' abilities in the most challenging scenarios. It would be my honor to be considered to serve on the ACC board.

### **Director - Laura Griggs (Georgia)**

I got my first Chesapeake in 1997 and have been in love with the breed ever since. I have trained, handled and competed with multiple dogs, to include multiple Bred-By Champions, Sporting Group win and placements, NOHS Group wins & Best in Show. I compete in multiple disciplines- Conformation, Hunt Tests, Obedience, Rally and Agility. I feel that my participation in a wide range of dog sports will help me understand and serve the needs of the Club and its members from many angles.

I currently serve as a Director, Program Director for the Working Dog Program, and have served on that committee since 2013. I serve on the Companion Events (2015) and Electronics Committees (2019), and am also an Administrator for the ACC Facebook Page.

I have been fortunate to be able to attend and enter in many National Specialties and Field Trial Specialties, and I've volunteered at most of those events, to include Hospitality, Donations and Auction Chair for the NSS in Ohio. Last year I Chaired a successful and very well-attended Supported entry in Georgia, and have been invited to judge Sweepstakes at other Supported. I'm chairing the 2021 Field Trial Specialty in Americus, Georgia.

For many years, I have volunteered, helped organize and set up the ACC Meet the Breed Booth at Royal Canin in Orlando. This is a group effort and this past year we won Best Booth in Show out of over 200 breed booths.

My dogs and I have also volunteered with the AKC Canine Ambassador Program, taking AKC sports into schools and educating young people about dog sports. I volunteer with my local 4-H Club's Dog Show and Dog Obedience programs.

I have participated in Breed Rescue since 2011, having fostered, transported, pulled dogs from shelters and helped with rehabilitation.

## ***From the Bylaws***

From the ACC Bylaws page 16-17, Section 7, Elections, B. Nominations, Subsections 2 and 3

(2) Additional nominations of eligible members may be made by written petition addressed to the Secretary and postmarked on or, before August 1st, signed by five (5) percent of the current membership or 50 signatures, of members in good standing, whichever number is lower, and accompanied by the written acceptance of such additional nominee signifying his willingness to be a candidate. No person shall be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee.

(3) If no valid additional nominations are received by the Secretary on or before August 1st, the Nominating Committee's slate shall be declared elected, and no balloting will be required. The new officers and directors will take office on October 1st.

President Lynda Barber-Wiltse served as Chair and Secretary Gina Downin served as Secretary of the meeting.

#### 1. Approval of Minutes

Minutes from our last Board Teleconference were approved prior to this meeting. See motion **21:05** in the Report of the Secretary.

#### 2. Report of the President (Lynda)

The President, Lynda Barber-Wiltse, thanked everyone for everything they are doing. The club is moving forward on many important projects.

#### 3. Report of the Secretary (Gina)

The Secretary, Gina Downin, reported the following motions have been approved by unanimous written consent of the Directors, effective on the dates noted, and the consents will be filed with the minutes of this meeting.

4. **Report of the Treasurer (Margi)** The year-end report is nearly complete. For 2020 we had gross income of \$94,592 and expenses of \$77,098 along with \$2,292 of interest income for a net profit of \$19,787. As of December 31, 2020 there was \$280,422 in the various banks including the one-year CD valued at \$103,366. We have closed the western regional bank account that Sally Diess was handling. The 2021 dues renewal has ended with the renewal of 828 members. Eighty-four members did not renew. The dues renewal process included \$5,855 donated to the ACCCT and over \$2,000 donated to the National Specialties.

#### 5. Reports of Committees

##### a. Standing Committees

i **AKC Delegate (Heidi)** Our AKC delegate provided information about candidates for upcoming AKC Board Positions. The AKC has approved an 18-month pilot program to allow Junior Handlers in conformation to exhibit "Canine Partners" in all-breed Juniors competition.

ii **Companion/Performance Events Committee (Laurea)** The Board received the following report from newly

appointed Chair, Mel Phillips: "On behalf of the newly renamed Companion/Performance Event Committee, we are honored to volunteer with the club. Committee Members for 2021: Chair Mel Phillips (VA), Donna Cooley (WA), Lorrie Johnson (TN), Jan Estes (NY), Doreen Palmer (CT), Laurea Griggs (GA) – Board Liaison. Many thanks to Joann Stancer for your work on this committee for the past few years, to Doreen Palmer, past Chair and Jan Estes for staying on to provide some continuity. The change to the committee name reflects our intention to expand the recognition of the traditional companion sports of Obedience, Rally, Agility and Tracking, to include, support and promote newer sports like Barn Hunt, Lure Coursing, Dock Diving, Scentwork and more. We will continue to keep members informed of rule changes and new titles that are covered by our committee. We plan to provide information to members, via the Bulletin and social media, on getting started in these various sports. If you would like to see any particular sport highlighted, please feel free to reach out to any committee member."

- iii. **Field Trial Committee (Marlene)** Laurea Griggs, Chair of the 2021 NFTS gave a brief report on the 2021 NFTS.
- iv. **Health Committee (Gale)** Nothing to report.
- v. **Hunt Test Committee (Pat)** The Chesapeake only Hunt Test associated with the NSS in August is in Entry Express and plans are very much underway. There was a recent inquiry to the committee about holding an all-breed hunt test in Texas. The Ohio All-Breed Hunt Test will take place in early August.
- vi. **Judge and Breeder Education (Gale)** An educational article on rear dewclaws was researched and written by members of the JBEC. It was reviewed by the ACC Board and has been submitted for publication in the ACC March/April Bulletin. The JBEC will contact all ACC mentors to see if they are willing to continue as Mentors and if they will be available to ringside mentor at the ACC National Specialty Show to be held on August 27-28, 2021 in York, PA. Upcoming Breed Seminar: York, PA NSS Specialty Show – August 2021.
- vii. **Lifetime Achievement Award Committee (Margi)** The committee has received no new nominations for the LTAA. Linda Harger will be assuming the role of Chair on March 1<sup>st</sup>. Mike Pickett's term on the committee ends at that time.
- viii. **Show Committee (Tina)** Discussion on Challenge Trophies in need of repair or replacement. A few supported shows have been canceled, Celtic Classic, Delaware and Trenton. Michelle Keehn's term as Chair ends at the end of February. Michelle Voss has agreed to step into the roll pending Board approval. (see motion **21:08** under New Business)

## b. Ad-Hoc Committees and Groups

- i. **ACC National Specialty Show Manual Update (Tina)** The Show Manual Committee is currently reviewing the new manual for edits and additions based on standing rules and/or needed forms. Next steps will be to format the final draft and present to the board for review.

- ii. **Breed Rescue Service (Carolyn)** Our rescue committee has reported that the pandemic is having a toll on many in ways that increase the need for the support of a thriving rescue service. The Lynch Creek holiday wreath fundraiser raised \$1,191.00 to support the rescues. ACC rescue still has funds from the 2020 disbursement of funds from the ACCCT. It is the Chairperson's recommendation that we do not ask for a 2021 disbursement at this time.
- iii. **CBR Data Group (Gina)** The committee is continuing to invite volunteers to help with various projects. We hope to expand the sense of ownership and responsibility for preserving important breed data. We recently received a request from a member who needed assistance in entering his dogs' data. We used the Database Fb group to request volunteers to help him and we immediately got responses. We will be training volunteers to enter data via a Zoom meeting.
- iv. **Editorial Committee (Lynda)** Nothing to report. But the Editorial Committee wants to encourage committees to send in anything they would like printed in the Bulletin.
- v. **Electronic Communications Group (ECG) (Laurea)** The committee is exploring expanded use of amchessclub domain email addresses to improve continuity of communication when we transition volunteer positions from one person to another.
- vi. **Health Survey (Gale)** The Health Survey Ad Hoc committee is continuing to gather comments from members. In the first few days we received four comments and nothing since then. Members have until February 22 to respond. The committee will come together for another teleconference with the Board in March.
- vii. **New Membership Approval Process and Application (Tina)** Having achieved its purpose to research membership policies of other clubs and make recommendations for improvements to our own process, this ad-hoc committee will be sunsetted. Many thanks to committee members Gina Downin (Chair), Kelly Bromelkamp, Linda Harger, Adam Levy, and Joanne Silver.
- viii. **Nominating Committee 2021 (Margi)** The Nominating Committee is collecting names and bios. The Board and previous Chairs have been a great asset. The committee will meet via teleconference after April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ix. **ROM Program (Lynda)** The committee has an old list of dogs recognized through the ROM program. That list was digitized and uploaded into the ACC database. The committee will meet by teleconference soon to update the point system and develop a system for members to apply for recognition of their dogs.

The three members and chair should be chosen from non-board members, but their serving on the Show Committee shall not preclude their becoming Board members while on the Show Committee.' (Barber-Wiltse) (The new Board and president were advised to extend or change some members terms on this committee to get it back in line with the above SR {only 2 committee members leave in one yr.}) For: unanimous (Bomber absent)"

**Executive Session** - The Board went into Executive Session at 9:18pm and came out of Executive Session at 9:45pm. There was nothing to report from Executive Session.

**Adjournment** Meeting adjourned at 10:00pm.

## ***AKC Delegate Report***

2020 was obviously a difficult year for AKC Sports and Events. Events are down by 10,000 and Entries down by 1.4 million. Standing out positively were Fast CAT, Scent and Herding. Others with very respectable numbers are Hunting Tests, Lure Coursing, Agility, Field Trials and CAT.

Registration is up. 2020 was the 7th consecutive year of increases in Dog Registration, the 6th consecutive year of increases in Litter Registration, and the 6th consecutive year of increases in Unique Breeders. Best full year since 2009 & 2008, respectively.

Delegate Meeting attendance: Research was conducted for the Delegate Zoom meetings in comparison to the past 5 years of Delegates Meetings. The September (376) and December (377) 2020 meetings were the highest attended in 5 years.

Event Application Practices – extended through 2021 - (1.) the application fee for cancelled 2021 events will be applied to the next event of same type. (2.) Clubs will be allowed to submit event applications up to 30 days prior to event without incurring a late fee.

2-hour Fastest Dogs USA aired on ESPN2 Sunday, December 13, 2020. The show used the finals of the AKC Fast CAT Invitational in Orlando to highlight competitors: it was the number one show on ESPN2 for the entire day. AKC TV has signed with ESPN to televise more AKC events.

CAT and Fast CAT Event Applications – Performance Events is in the process of adding information about the "service provider" to the Event Application form. This was added on paper but online requires programming.

Virtual Obedience Test Program – The AKC Virtual Obedience Test titling program will begin on March 1, 2021. There will be Virtual Beginners Novice and Virtual Novice.

AKC Virtual Rally® Program: Adding the Advanced and Excellent Classes

The AKC Virtual Rally® Pilot Program was launched at the beginning of May 2020. In July 2020, the program was



expanded to include the Rally Intermediate class. The Board expanded the program to include the Rally Advanced and Excellent classes. Like in the Novice and Intermediate classes, there is no change to the exercises required to pass the Advanced and Excellent classes. The Board extended the pilot period for the Virtual Rally program to year-end 2021. The Advanced and Excellent classes will also terminate at year-end unless extended or made permanent. The course maps for the new classes along with a new and improved Rally Virtual Guidebook was released on Monday, February 22, 2021. Rally/Obedience National Championships - to be held in Wilmington, Ohio July 9-11, 2021

**Canine College:** The AKC offer over 600 courses and exams available for Conformation and Performance Judges, Breeders, Groomers, and the public. Over 80 current courses and exams were revised throughout 2020

The AKC Humane Fund is seeking nominations for its AKC Humane Fund Awards for Canine Excellence (ACE). Nominations are open now through July 31st and winners will be announced in late 2021. The 2021 Awards for Canine Excellence will be covered on AKC.tv. One award is given in each of the following five categories:

- Uniformed Service K-9
- Exemplary Companion
- Search and Rescue
- Therapy
