## AKC Obedience Classic

The AKC Obedience Classic was held in Orlando, FL, in December 2021, in conjunction with the AKC National Championship and the AKC Agility Invitational. To be invited to the Obedience Classic, a dog must earn 3 qualifying scores during the designated qualifying period, along with the corresponding title for the Novice, Open, or Utility class. The Obedience Classic requires the dogs to compete multiple times during the event and the scores are cumulative for all exercises performed. In the Novice class, dogs complete the Novice exercises three times over the course of the weekend, and perform the group Stay exercises one time. GCH Silvercreek Applejohn's Little Mermaid CD BN RE NAP NJP OFP SWE SCM SBM SEM SHDA DS TKP CGC ("Ariel"), owned and handled by Lorrie Johnson (TN), competed in the Novice class and was awarded the AKC Breed Medallion for the Top Scoring Chesapeake Bay Retriever. Ariel was one of the few dogs (of any breed) that also competed in the AKC National Championship (conformation) on the same day, so we literally went from one ring/venue to the other. Ariel was bred by Joanne Silver and Teresa Tebbens (Shallcross Lake's Little Rascal MH x CH Marjan's Silvercreek Chantilly Lace CD BN RE JH CA TKP CGC). The Obedience Classic was a wonderful experience and we hope to go back someday!



## Agility Invitational

### Tom and Leo

Leonidas Places Second in the 2021 AKC Agility Invitational Finals

676 of the top dogs in the country accepted invitations to compete at the 2021 AKC Agility Invitational in Orlando, Florida, December 18-19, 2021. The top 6 dogs of each breed were invited to compete at the Invitational (5 Regular and 1 Preferred). 128 dog/handler teams in the 24" Division were vying to be one of the Top 12 to qualify for, and represent their breed, in the AGI Finals. The Finals were broadcasted live on AKC TV. Tom Martin (MI) Leonidas entered the Finals as the #5 seed in the 24" Division. Leonidas had been running strong all weekend and was getting better with each run. As we stepped to the line the ring announcer, TV commentators, and cheering crowd faded to background noise, and I knew he was ready to rumble. With a physique better suited for breaking ice and

running through brick walls, than dodging through weave poles, Leo ran a fast and clean round. In 39.67 seconds we were sprinting across the Finish Line completing his sixth clean run of a grueling and high stakes weekend competing against the top scoring dogs in the country. The Finish was Second Place – A historic achievement for our breed. I am blessed and humbled by all that cheered us on both near and far. Huge thanks to Team CBR - Lynda Barber-Wiltse & Deshka, VeeAnn Cross & Tillie, Keith Staub & Rainey, and Charlene Bridgwood & AV. Leonidas (GCH\* CH PACH3 HRCH Curly's One For Sparta BN SH MXP7 MXPG MJPG MJPX PAX3 OFP DS WDX CGC TKN) (CH Crossrhodes Trail of Pawprints CGC & CH Curly's In Hot Pursuit) Leonidas Wins AKC Breed Medallion

GCH\* CH PACH3 HRCH Curly's One For Sparta BN SH MXP7 MXPG MJPG MJPX PAX3 OFP DS WDX CGC TKN Every year, bigger and better. Team CBR fielded a solid lineup of top dogs and seasoned competitors. For the third consecutive year, Leonidas received the honor of being invited to compete at the AKC Agility

Invitational as the #1 Preferred Chesapeake Bay Retriever. Duck hunting on the Saginaw Bay one week and palm trees and sunshine the next - the life of a go anywhere, do anything gundog. Competition began on Friday, December 17th, with the optional Time2Beat class. Leonidas ran as a 20"P and finished with a respectable Fourth Place finish. Saturday marked the first day of Invitational

Competition. Leonidas qualified both his Standard and Jumpers runs and was sitting in Finals position at the close of Day 1. Day 2 began with Hybrid as we continued to climb the leader board sitting in sixth place in the 24" Class. Leo closed out the preliminary rounds with another qualifying run, going five for five for the weekend and entering the Finals Round as the #5 seed in the 24" class. This was Tom Martin (MI) and Leonidas' second trip to the event Finals. Leonidas also took home the AKC Breed Medallion sponsored by the American Chesapeake Club. The Breed Medallion is awarded to the top scoring Chesapeake Bay Retriever at the Invitational. This was the third year in a row that Leonidas has won the Breed Medallion. Leonidas is bred by Angela Boeske and is owned by Tom Martin and Angela Boeske.



### Keith and Rainey

We had a great time in Orlando. Rainey (MACH Whiskey Creek's When It Rains It Pours MXB MJB NAP NJP MFB OFF T2B DMA CGC TKN) ran great in all 4 runs, just the handler (Keith Staub (FL)) made 1 mistake on 3 of the 4 runs. Was nice to see the other chessie people & fantastic a Chessie placed in the finals with a well-deserved team!



### VeeAnn and Tillie

The 2021 Invitational was the culmination of a wonderful year for Tillie (MACH3 Treasure Lake Tiller Towards Trouble RE JH MXG PAD MJC PJD NJP MFS TQX T2B2 DM CGC) and VeeAnn Cross (MA).

This was her 4th invitation to the event, and her third time attending, finishing the event with



qualifying scores in 3 of the 5 events. But the absolute best part of attending is being with and cheering on the other chessies and their handlers since Tillie is often the only chessie where we compete. Other significant agility events this year for Tillie included Westminster, AKC Nationals, and USDAA Cynosport (nationals) where she finished third in the team competition individual standings in her jump height. Along with the major events Tillie accomplished numerous AKC agility titles such as her MACH3. But perhaps the most significant of the new titles were the Premier standard and Premier jumpers titles. I believe Tillie is the first chessie to achieve those titles. Tillie wasn't just busy with agility in 2021. We also ventured into the world of hunt tests and received her JH title. Who knows what new adventures 2022 will bring!

# In Memory

Alabama Moon Bear MH 39 MA1 MN1  
Oct. 4, 2012 - Oct. 29, 2021

The day after Thanksgiving 2012 I went to look at a litter of CBR puppies. My wife, Adena, had found a litter advertised in the local newspaper and located only a short distance from where we live in N.E. Washington State. My knowledge of the breed was limited to what I had heard about CBR's (stubborn, hard headed and hard to train) and what I had learned after owning 3 others over the previous 20 odd years. To say I was not a very savvy puppy buyer was an understatement. I knew I wanted a female and there was this little girl that caught my eye and so I picked her. But looking back I think she picked me! I worked construction and spent 99% of my time on the road living in a 5th wheel trailer. I was looking to recreate a bond with this pup like I had experienced with my 1st CBR as well as a having a good gun dog she went on the road with me.

What I got was a dog of a lifetime. Moon was an energetic puppy, she was a little on the small side but she was mighty and fast. She had ears that laid perfectly and framed her beautiful face, until she started teething. One then the other drooped and then stood out like they would have served her better as wings. They stayed that way! It was a unique look, you could always tell when Moon was on the line or running by her Yoda ears. Often her ears would telegraph which bird she was going after next.

Moon was a terrific natural marking dog! At the Master Amateur in Butte Mt. 2019, Moon ran 6 clean series for a pass

in very challenging set ups. The judges nick named her "The Brown Marking Machine". She was the only Chesapeake to get a plate that year. We only got to run one master amateur due to covid and Moon's health issues.

I never did much field trialing with but we entered Quals at 3 FT Specialty's when they came out west. The first was not pretty but she finish two series. The second was better. The third one was 2020 in Cascade Idaho, that was one of my most proud moments, she picked up a 3rd place ribbon. One of the judges, the lady, loved Moons ears!

Moons hunt test career was pretty impressive considering the handler she had. Some of my friends used to joke that she could not help who her owner was.

We campaigned up and down the west coast from Carnation to Niland and to the east coast. Moon had it down, it became almost automatic for a weekend Master pass. Altogether Moon and I ran in 3 Master Nationals, that pewter plate was so elusive, until 2021 in Cascade Idaho.

Earlier in 2021, Moon developed a little cough and I was having a hard time getting to the cause. We spent 3-4 weeks and a lot of trips to the veterinarian

In May x-rays revealed a shadow in the right lung. June 1st a biopsy confirmed it was cancer! July 1st we were able to get Moon into Washington State University, veterinary school of medicine's oncology dept. The staff there is top notch and I would recommend them to anyone. I might add, the genuine care and compassion we received at WSU was wonderful. The doctors and the staff absolutely loved Moon. Everybody that came into contact with her did. Moon was a real social dog and she wanted to meet everybody. Moon was a great ambassador for the breed, often greeting people with her tail furiously

wagging and her big toothy grin. We started Moon on chemotherapy and she stayed on it thru October. I was wary of the chemo and how it would effect Moon but she seemed to tolerate it well. This cancer really put a hitch in things and I figured that Moon and I had made our last trip to line. I asked our oncologist Dr Tien what level of exercise we could do with Moon and she said , don't put Moon into any situation she could not get herself out of. Let her decide when she wants to quit! Another thing she told me was that Moon didn't know she was sick or had cancer. With that info I had hope! I thought just maybe we had a chance to make the MN.



One obstacle we had to clear was that Moon still needed one more pass to

qualify and in mid July we got our pass at a test in McCall Idaho.

I considered our chances of finishing the MN was slim but I was willing to pay the entry fee even if we went to the line one time and let her pick up the first flyer, turn around and walk off the line. I was ready to scratch right up to the start. Moon would let me know. The day came and dog 108 went to the line, I looked down at Moon and her ears perked up then she took her customary two steps and I knew she was up for the task at hand! She picked up that flyer and the other two birds and did a good job on both blinds!

The 2021 Master national only went 4 series, tarnished the test some say. I say I can't worry about what I have no control over. Moon went on to run clean except for one handle in the 3rd series. The 4th series was a triple with a flyer, a double land blind and a honor. The 2nd blind was down a hill through a patch of sagebrush tight to the middle mark, then through timber. If the dog got very far offline they would be out of sight from the handler. A lot of teams struggled here but I was delighted when Moon 2 whistled that blind! That was the last duck that Moon ever delivered to me. Our judges in flight E were from our region and I had run under and judged with both of them. As we went to the honor position in that final series, through tears I looked back at the judge and I saw tears streaming down her face, she said to me You better not let that dog break!!!

Looking back it was an emotional roller coaster ride and I couldn't have been more proud of that dog. She picked up all her marks out of order, she did it her way and she gave me everything she had! Who could ask for more than that? So that little puppy that had picked me almost 9 years ago and had taken me all over the country meeting new people and seeing new places, had truly changed my life!

Three weeks to the day after we ran that final series and got that pewter plate, Alabama Moon Bear crossed the bridge !

Moon was a special dog and she is truly missed!

# The Swimming Dip

## Or Another Piece of the Puzzle – “Kinnick”

This article is an addendum to “Inside the Outline”. Following is a collection of referenced sources that refer to the “swimming dip”. It is another part of the topline. Not much has been written about the swimming dip, but I felt it should be included. The “swimming dip” is not something that breeders or judges should be intense about. It is not necessary to examine a dog looking for the swimming dip. If a dog is in excellent coat, you may not notice the dip in the outline. The dip is not caused by a soft back when a dog is not in working condition. The “dip” is just there and the quotations below describe it in several different ways. The “swimming dip” has been written about in several books on conformation, describing part of the topline. Below are quotes from some judges and movement and breed experts.

Dr. Quentin La Ham, *The Anatomy of Movement: The Vertebral Column* – Ch. 2 <https://nationalpurebreddogday.com/slipping-hocks-with-caveats/> August 22, 2021

I was privileged to attend a seminar given by Dr. La Ham on Suffolk, Long Island in 1977. It was the first structure and movement seminar that I attended and it was excellent.

Dr. La Ham (all breed Canadian and AKC judge) gave seminars on canine structure, movement and function in the 1970's/1990's. He actually coined the word:

“kinnick” – “physical landmark on a dog’s topline to help evaluate couplings and the length of the loin.” The kinnick can be used interchangeably with the concept of the swimming dip.

The loin is described as the coupling that is part of the spine between the end of the ribcage and the place on the topline where the hip joins the spine.

Eloise Heller Cherry. (1983) *The Complete Chesapeake Bay Retriever* – p. 67 Howell House

Guest writer Mrs. James Edward (Anne Rogers) Clark wrote that “...the swimming dip is found in some retrievers and also in the Poodle that started life as a retriever in Germany. This is a slight but perceptible hollow just behind the shoulders.”

Another reference to the Swimming Dip is presented below.

Judges Education Committee for the Poodle Club of America. (2013 & 2007). *The Poodle: Breed Standard Presentation* p. 4

“Check Structure: slight depression just behind the shoulder at the top of the back (the swimming dip)”

This is part of a list of nine suggestions on how to judge a Poodle.

Edward M. Gilbert, Jr. & Patricia H. Gilbert (2013) *Encyclopedia of K9 Terminology* Dogwise

“Swimming dip: A slight but perceptible hollow just behind the shoulders that is found in some retrievers and in the Standard Poodle.” (It is likely that the Gilberts are using the information from the writings of Mrs. Clark.)

Chris Zink & Marcia Schlehr (Oct 2020) *Working Dog Structure, Evaluation and Relationship to Function*. *Frontiers in Veterinary Science*. <https://www.frontiersin.org/articles/10.3389/fvets.2020.559055/full>

“Note that all dogs have a normal, small dip in their topline at T11...(the anticlinal vertebra) is very short to accommodate this change in the direction of the spinous processes, creating a slight depression.”

Robert J. Berndt. (2001) *The Science and Techniques of Judging Dogs*: p. 35 Alpine Publications

What is the physical reason that the “swimming dip” exists?

“The thoracic spine consists of thirteen vertebrae. There is a great increase in the length of the spinous process starting with the first thoracic vertebra. The first four are the longest and point almost straight up. This is the area of top attachment for the scapula and forms the withers of the dog. The spinous process of next five vertebrae decrease in size and begin to slant toward the rear. This is what causes the slight dip in the topline behind the withers. The spinous process on the remaining four vertebrae is shorter and thicker. On the lower side of each thoracic vertebrae is attached one of the pairs of the ribs. The back of the dog begins at about the fifth vertebra and runs to the lumbar spine.”

Patricia V. Craig (1997) *Born To Win* p. 18 Doral Publishing

“The spine acts as the foundation does for the house. The accompanying bones of motion become the wheels of the vehicle. The spinal column is the support system for the dog, and it functions somewhat like a suspension bridge in that it connects the front to the rear in much the same way as the Golden Gate Bridge connects San Francisco to Marin County. Because the law of gravity acts on this suspended weight, the spine has to have some curves to accommodate the force. Thus the spine has a gentle curve behind the withers – first nine thoracic vertebrae – at the mid-back area of the last four thoracic vertebrae. This is the dog’s bodily divide with the center of those vertebrae carrying most of the suspended weight.”

“The question of why so many breeds ask for a straight topline – distancing between withers and tail – when it is obvious that the actual spine curves is answered by conditioning and muscling of the dog. If you have a well-conditioned animal, the muscles will fill in the crevices of the skeleton to give a smooth outward look to the back. Without curves to absorb the stress, the back would be too rigid to do its job....”



In conclusion I have received additional information by contacting judges who had attended Dr. LaHam's seminars in the past. When you look at the accompanying diagram of the Vertebral Column, it is easier to understand the concept of the "knick". It is pronounced "kuh-nick" – the first "k" is pronounced as a syllable. It is another word for hinge or connection. The knick is the shortest spine that points straight up, known technically as the anticlinal vertebra. It is where the vertebra change direction which creates the dip behind the withers. Although the spelling appeared as "kinnick" in several publications - the correct word is "knick".

# Vertebral Column



The above drawing shows the parts of the vertebral column, which is the same in all dogs except for the number of coccygeal vertebrae. Some writers (Brown, p 43; Armistead) discuss the **anticlinal vertebra**, which is the **shortest spinous process** (bony spine) in the vertebral column, and the point where the **power from the rear is passed on to the front**.

When a dog has a **dip in its back**, it may also show up in this area. It is always desirable to have **muscle fill-in in the anticlinal** vertebra area. (Armistead)





DC AFC Mount Joy's Mallard Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Amateur competition. The trophy was donated by Mrs. E. C. Fleishman and was first awarded in 1962. Winner: AFC Fireweed's The King Of Cool owned by Tom Ivey and Linda Harger

CH Storm Cloud CD Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Amateur competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated by Eloise Heller in 1966. Winner: Linda Harger

DC AFC Tigers' Cub CD Memorial Trophy Awarded annually to the amateur handler whose Chesapeake earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Open and Amateur competition. (The Open points must be earned by an amateur handler.) The trophy was donated to the ACC by Eloise Cherry in 1979 in memory of her dog Tiger's Cub. Winner: Linda Harger

FC Tiger of Clipper City Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Qualifying competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. Winner: Church Creek Abigail Von Duckslayer CD SH owned by Frank Pittelli

FC/AFC Meg's Pattie O'Rourke Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition. The trophy was first awarded in 1961. Winner: Rocky Hooks JJ's Play It Again owned by Marston Jones

The Louis Traung Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member Derby competition in the West Coast states and Idaho. The trophy was donated to the ACC by Mrs. Louis Traung in 1962 and was originally a West coast trophy. Idaho was later added when several dogs were sold to Idaho residents who were supposed to trial them. (This addition was noted in a letter for Eloise Cherry that was received by the ACC many years later.) Winner: Not Awarded

FC AFC CFC CAFC Chesdel Chippewa Chief Trophy Awarded annually to the Chesapeake owned by an ACC member that earns the most points in AKC licensed and member field trial Derby competition in the Central and Eastern Time zones. The trophy was donated by Alex Spear in memory of his dog Chip. Winner: Rocky Hooks JJ's Play It Again owned by Marston Jones

**A:** one (1) point will be recognized for each offspring tested for ALL of the following health areas - DM, PRA, EIC, Hips/Elbows, Eyes
