## Mister - Newest Best in Show, Master Hunter, Qualified All-Age Chesapeake

As a breeder and/or owner, you often dream about your next Champion or Master Hunter, your next QAA or your next Best in Show dog. Once in a lifetime, you might dream of combining all of those accomplishments into one very special dog. Most of the time, it takes just that, a lifetime, for a dog to accomplish what Mister has, in only 5 years!

In spring 2017, Rae Lewis contacted me looking for a male Chesapeake and wanted a dog that could be competitive. Rae comes from a world of equine showmanship and has owned Chesapeakes in the past. The long talks Rae and I had on the phone and the relationship we built over a short period of time really wanted me to find something special for her.

In the summer of 2017, Mister was born and later that fall, Rae made the long trek from California to Minnesota to pick him up. We came up with a plan for training and showing, and young 8-week old Mister and Rae headed home to grow up and enjoy being a young, rambunctious puppy.

When Mister turned about 5 months old, he and Rae made the trip back to Next Generation where he would start training. Training came pretty naturally to Mister, flying through his basics and shining in the field. He took 2 weeks off from field work and went with Devon to his first show cluster and quickly showed us that he could shine in the ring as well, picking up multiple majors from the puppy class. He finished his 2nd weekend out.

In spring 2018, Mister started his hunt test career where he quickly earned his AKC Junior Hunter title, going 4 for 4. Before going home for a little break, he went to his first ACC National Show Specialty in Ohio, as a young 11-month old Special. He made the cut at the National and went on to win Best Of Breed at the ACC Supported Entry the following day.

Mister came back for more training on the winter trip of 2019, for advanced work with Next Generation trainer, Andrew Barbouche. He quickly showed he had the brains, drive and desire to really push forward in the field. That summer, he ran 8 hunt tests, passing all 8, to earn his AKC Senior Hunter title and his first 4 Master Hunter passes.

Before heading home for another break, he went to the ACC Field Trial Specialty in Ravenna, TX, where he earned his first field trial ribbon with a Qualifying JAM, handled by his good buddy, Edgar Johnson.

After about 5 months off of training, it was time to finish his Master Hunter title which he did in the summer of 2020. After that, Rae and I discussed what was next and decided to see how he can do in field trials. Mister was sent to Marc Patton at Green River Retrievers to train and run trials. Mister ended up either placing or JAMing in 8 out of 11 Qualifyings and JAMed his first All Breed Open to become Qualified All Age.

In February of 2022, as a mature male, we started Mister's Specials career where he has completely exceeded expectations, in true Mister form. As of printing, Mister has won or placed in over 50 groups, won 9 Reserve Best In Shows and 2 Best In Shows. He's won multiple ACC Supported Entries and is currently the Number 6 Sporting Dog and Number One Chesapeake, All Breed and Breed (AKC and Canine Chronicle Stats, as of June 30, 2022). We are excited to continue to watch this boy's career and his offspring, as they get started.

Mister's success would not be possible without his primary owner, the woman who sacrifices her time and resources to give him every opportunity possible, Rae Lewis - thank you for all you do for Mister! Andrew Barbouche, thank you for recognizing and stoking Mister's talent in the field with your expert training and handling. Devon Kipp-Levy, there's no one else who can present and show off a dog in the ring like you can - thank you for loving Mister and your expert handling skills. Also, a HUGE thank you to the entire team and everyone who cheers for and supports Mister on this journey - you're the best Squad in the game!


## American Kennel Club Gazette (the official publication of the American Kennel Club)

Waiting to hear the whispered words “Ready? Go”, Connor explodes forward launching himself high into the air while the gallery holds its collective breath. A solid grab and splash landing and he turns for the pool's exit ramp to deliver the bumper to hand amid cheers from his admirers. What fun he has! Athletic Connor took to air retrieve jumping like he conquers everything else he attempts, earning his North American Diving Dogs (NADD) / AKC Air Senior titles last year and his Air Master titles at the beginning of this jumping season. Additionally, he received a United Kennel Club (UKC) Senior Fetch It title. Just this past June, Connor finished his Air Master title by making his grabs at an amazing 18'. 

On Sunday, 44 dogs were entered with Sam Houston McDonald judging Breed and 12 in Sweeps with Dawn Logan judging. There were five point majors for both dogs and bitches on both days.

We had a great team working on this show; as always, Mitchel Horowitz did the food, and Pat Krout and Ally and Tommy Middleton organized the raffle and helped me set up and decorate the room in a St. Patrick's Day motif. On Saturday, Harry Miller, whose company handles site control for most shows in this area told me that we had the most beautiful room set up that he had ever seen. Again this year, Cully Leck made our ribbons; I opted for a St. Patrick's Day theme this year. His ribbons wowed a lot of people and hopefully he got some new business from our show. # Nominating Committee Slate

*Attention all members – Please refer to the club Bylaws for a complete description of the club's nomination and election process. Below is an excerpt that outlines the next steps of the process.*

From the ACC Bylaws page 16-17, Section 7, Elections, B. Nominations, Subsections 2 and 3

“(2) Additional nominations of eligible members may be made by written petition addressed to the Secretary and postmarked on or, before August 1st, signed by five (5) percent of the current membership or 50 signatures, of members in good standing, whichever number is lower, and accompanied by the written acceptance of such additional nominee signifying his willingness to be a candidate. No person shall be a candidate for more than one position, and the additional nominations which are provided for herein may be made only from among those members who have not accepted a nomination of the Nominating Committee.

(3) If no valid additional nominations are received by the Secretary on or before August 1st, the Nominating Committee's slate shall be declared elected, and no balloting will be required. The new officers and directors will take office on October 1st.”

## American Chesapeake Club 2022 Nominated Slate for the Board of Directors

**Tim Carrion (MD) - President** - I was recently elected President in the fall of 2021. Previous to being President, I served as the ACC's Delegate to the AKC for 7 years and currently remain an AKC Delegate for the Swamp Dog Club. I have been elected, and reelected to the Standing AKC Delegate Committee for Hunt Test and Field from 2014 to the present.

**Marlene Drag (MO) - Vice President** - My husband and I bought our first Chesapeake in 1985. We had been introduced to the breed during our time as veterinary students. Our primary intent for our first dog was for waterfowl hunting, but we did not want a Labrador or Golden. We brought Ian home at 9 weeks. My husband's assistant at the clinic volunteered her husband to help us train, because he trained Golden Retrievers for field trials. We trained with George and at his urging, entered a puppy stake when Ian was 4.5 months old. When Ian got fourth place, this was the start of a time-consuming and fun hobby. At just 6 months of age, Ian passed his WD. Then, at the urging of others, we also began to compete in conformation. Ian finished his Championship quickly, became Qualified All Age, and had all age points. With our first dog, we made a lot of mistakes but also learned a lot about the breed.

My primary interest is still retriever field trials. Bruce and I have had numerous all-age qualified dogs, and currently are running all-age stakes with one dog and recently received a second in the Qualifying with our young female. Finding time away from the field is hard, but over the years we have had a Champion - Master Hunter, and another Champion all-age qualified dog. I have been a member of the ACC Health Committee and served on numerous ACC Field Trial Specialty Committees. I am a member of the Mississippi Valley Retriever Club and the Missouri River Retriever Club. Since serving on the ACC Board of Directors and as Vice President for the past year, I feel that through my association with other members, I have a better working knowledge of goals of the ACC. The ACC should

be proud that it has dedicated members that are constantly striving to ensure the success of the Club and are committed to preserving Chesapeake Bay Retrievers as an all-purpose breed.

**Brian Newman (KY) - Treasurer** - In the Fall of 1989, as a 14 year-old boy, my parents and I were looking for our next family pet, and what would be my first hunting dog. After hours of research, I kept getting drawn back to the Chesapeake Bay Retriever. It took all of the money I received for my birthday that year, but I bought what would be my greatest birthday present to myself - a 10 week-old Chesapeake Bay Retriever. We've had one on my family farm ever since. For many years, they were both house and hunting companions, but then one day I was introduced into the world of conformation showing and hunt test. After having shown horses for over 25 years, we seemed to take to it naturally, and the rest is history. I've been blessed to compete in conformation shows as an owner handler and have had success in the field as well. We have won multiple regular Sporting group placements and wins along with an Owner Handler Best in Show and a Reserve Best in Show. We have Master Hunter passes, and multiple field trial placements in our field work. Some of the proudest moments I've had is earning many of these ribbons, with dogs that I've both bred and trained myself. I've chaired ACC supported shows, and I've served as part of the ACC nominating committee in the past. Now I seek the office of treasurer for the American Chesapeake Club. To serve in the office of treasurer for the ACC, and represent the hundreds of members across the US and world, it takes more than just passion for our breed and I feel like I bring the skills necessary to fulfill this leadership position. My educational background is well rounded. I received a Bachelor of Science in Agricultural Business and Animal Science from Western Kentucky University in 1998 and a Master of Science in Agronomy from Western Kentucky University in 2002. **Gina Downin (MD) - Secretary** - I've shared my life with Chesapeake Bay Retrievers for 20 years. We breed the occasional Weatherdeck Chesapeakes litter in Maryland. Rather than focusing on my dogs in this bio, I'll share a bit about my work for the club.

I've been an active ACC volunteer for 19 years. In that time I have:

- Chaired and served on committees (Rescue, Show, JBEC, Electronic Communication, Data, Nominating)
- Co-Chaired 2011 National Show Specialty
- Co-Chaired a WD/X/Q
- Regional Director for Maryland offering:
  - training/fun days
  - seminars
  - Info sessions at hunt tests
  - local events to educate the community about the breed and show our pride in our native Maryland dog

- Judged a WD/X/Q
- Judged Sweepstakes: Kennel Club of Philadelphia Supported Show and 2019 NSS
- Provided ringside mentoring at Supported Shows and National Show Specialties as an ACC approved Breed Mentor.

I have served for three years as a Director of the club and I am currently in my second year as Secretary. I focus on projects that document and preserve the history of our dogs and our club and that make that information available in a useful format for the Board, our members, and the public. Major projects include the club database and the new website. I'm excited about the potential for these projects to "tell the story" of our breed and our club. Less visible tasks include the work of modernizing the Board's use of technology in the ways we collect, archive, and access important club documents. I'm currently working on a project to begin use of cloud storage and collaboration tools to improve communication between the Board, Committees, and Project Leaders. Also, we are working to shift to video conferencing for meetings. In addition, I'm also working with some other Board members and Committees to consider some ideas for providing more benefits to our members in the future. Another goal of mine has been to invite more people into the work of the club. Dog clubs are powered by volunteers and we need to think creatively about new and interesting ways to get people involved. In addition to my membership in the ACC, I am a member of the Chesapeake Bay Retriever Club in the UK and the Canine Training Association.

**Todd Adams (AK) - Director** - I have sat on the Board for 1 year now as a Director for the ACC and have enjoyed the position. I would be honored to serve another year. About me: I made the move to Alaska in 1995 and my journey with Chesapeakes started shortly thereafter. I grew up in West Tennessee where waterfowl hunting was my favorite past time. Dogs, of course, came along with those pursuits and yes, I started with Labs. Life took me to Georgia, but the waterfowl hunting was too strong to avoid for long. We started hunting Arkansas every chance work would allow and eventually started guiding in flooded timber and rice fields. A friend of mine contacted Mary Howley of Candlewood kennels to help me get a "real dog" but I had to promise him I would never go to a field trial if my children were in school. Apparently, Don Strait knew my personality better than me. I brought that dog with me to Alaska when he was 8, he was well trained and did everything I ever ask of him but you could tell from his age, the cold water here affected him. That was the primary driver for me getting involved with Chesapeake Bay Retrievers. I bought my first Chesapeake in 1999, and my education began. I got involved with hunt tests and entered a few Derbies with her. I was able to get her Senior title and passed Master test before starting to see her dragging her back feet. A local vet in Fairbanks suspected Degenerative Myelopathy. At the time, no test was available that we were aware of. When we saw her life turn miserable, we had a necropsy ran and worked with the University of Pennsylvania to help with DNA testing for the disease. I was still impressed with the abilities and aptitudes of the breed and continued trying to figure them out. I had successes in hunt test and minor field trial stakes over the years with different dogs and currently have 2 males competing in all-age stake field trials. I have them with a pro in the winter and bring them back to Alaska in the summer for our field trial season.

Both of my competing males also have their conformation titles, and that is what I want to see the breed maintain as it moves forward. The breeding and training techniques have evolved over the years to include the athletes that can work and show.

**Laurea Griggs (GA) - Director** - I got my first Chesapeake in 1997 and have been in love with the breed ever since. I have trained, handled and competed with multiple dogs, to include multiple Bred-By Champions, Sporting Group wins and placements, NOHS Group wins & Best in Show. I compete in multiple disciplines- Conformation, Field Trials, Hunt Tests, Obedience, Rally and Agility- and I feel that my participation in a wide range of dog sports will help me understand and serve the needs of the Club and its members from many angles. I currently serve as a Director, Program Director for the Working Dog Program, and have served on that committee since 2013. I serve on the Electronics Committee (2019), and am also an Administrator for the ACC Facebook Page. I have been fortunate to be able to attend and compete in many National Specialties and Field Trial Specialties, and I've volunteered at most of those events, to include Hospitality, Donations and Auction Chair for the NSS in Ohio. In addition to ACC membership since 2011, I am an active member of the Newnan Kennel Club, Old South HRC Club and Fall Line Retriever Club. For many years I rode, bred and showed horses, and was involved with multiple regional and national organizations in that field, as well as being a licensed Sporthorse judge.

**Carolyn Johnson (FL) - Director** - I am proud to continue on the Board as a Director for the American Chesapeake Club. I assist the Board with Public Relations/Education and ACC Rescue. All types of animals have been a part of my life since I can remember, including dogs, cats, birds, and various reptiles and amphibians. I have bred, trained, handled, owned and shown many Chesapeakes to championships, wins and placements across multiple sports. We have titled many Master Hunter Chesapeakes along with breeding multiple Champion/ Master Hunters with Field Trial Placements. It is my pleasure to also call my titled and competition dogs, personal gun dogs during hunting season. Calling upon my diverse experiences from the show ring to the field, I believe this gives me a unique perspective to best serve the ACC and to represent and understand the membership needs.

**A. QUALIFICATIONS AND RIGHTS OF MEMBERSHIP**

**(5) Election to Membership**
